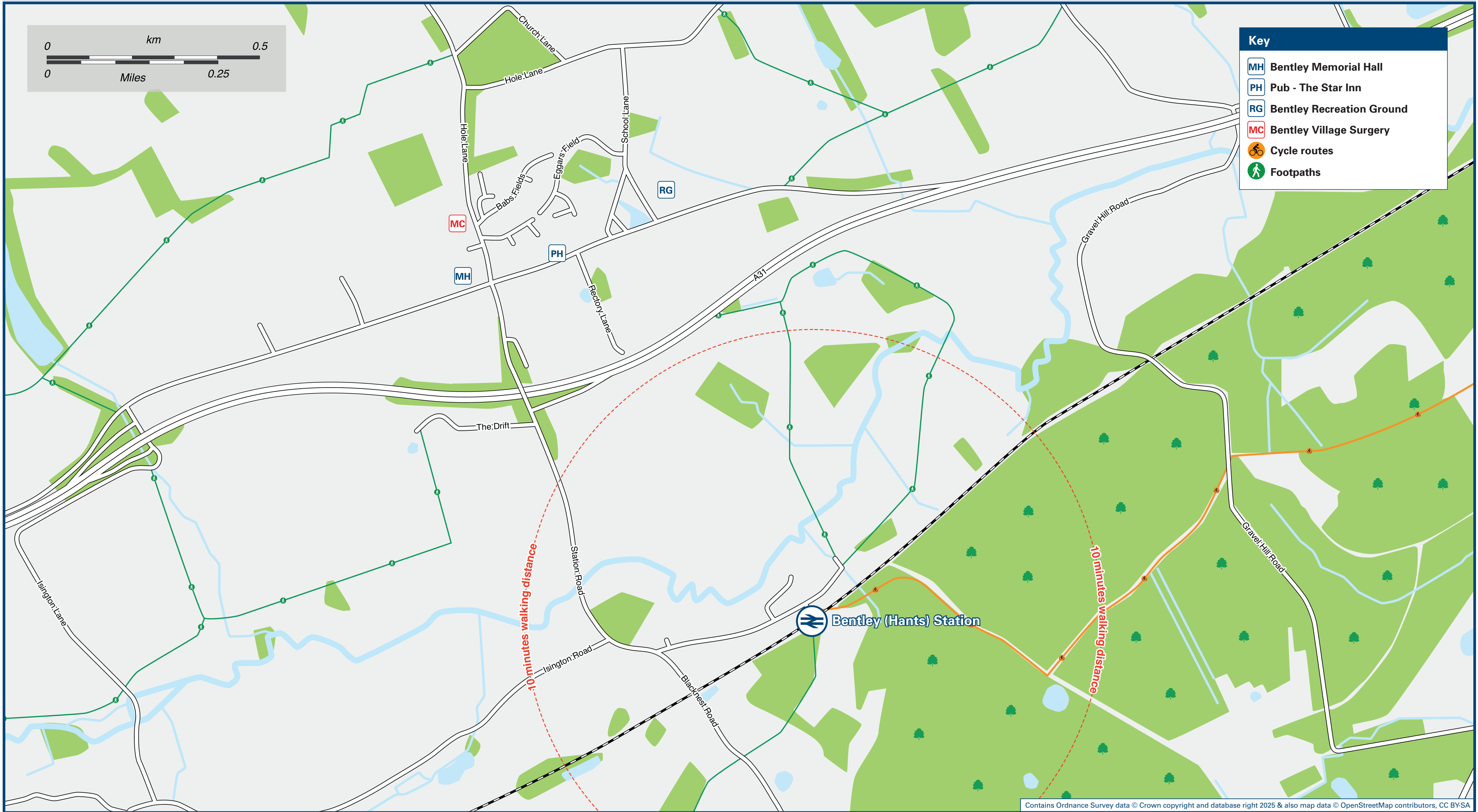




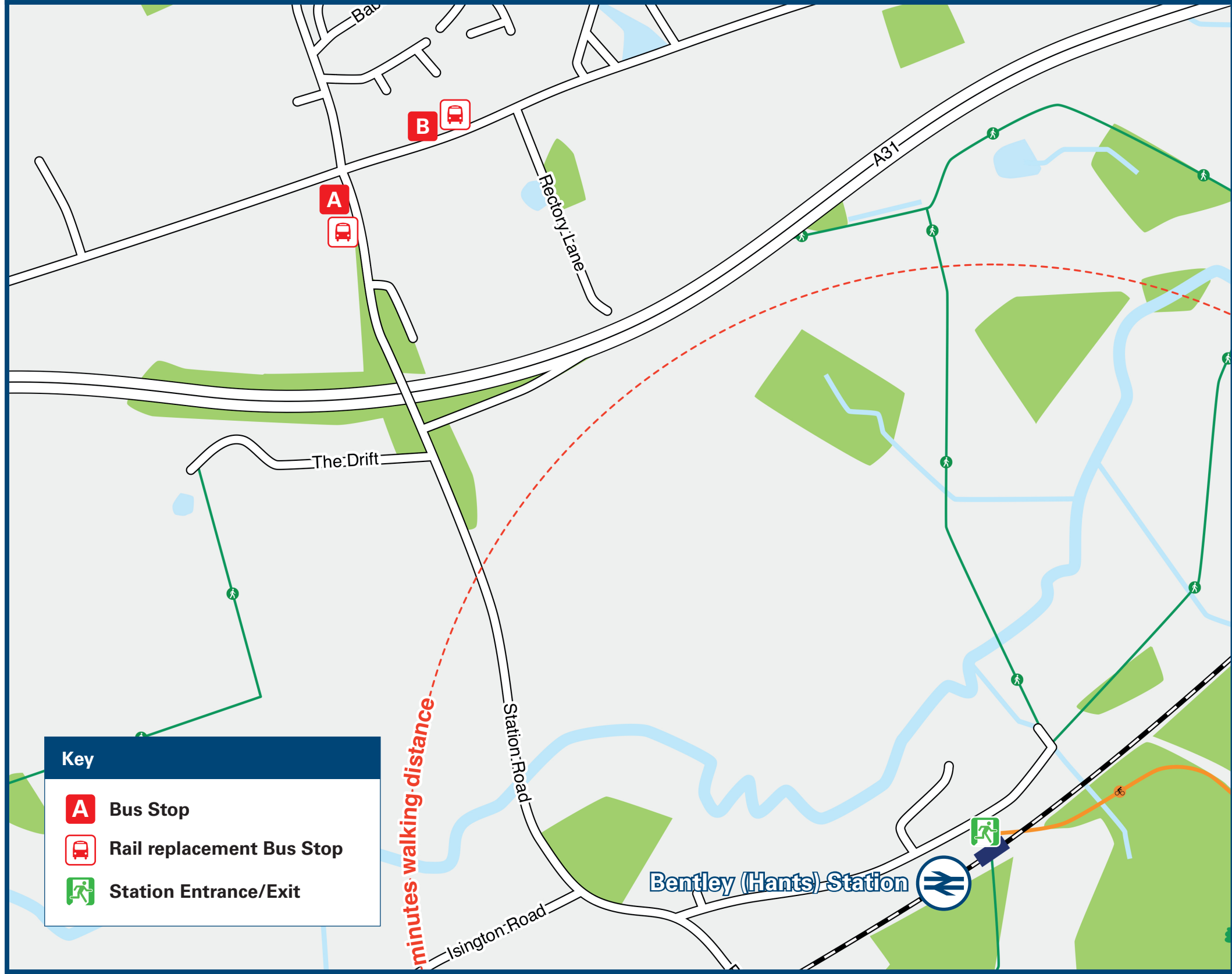

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING BENTLEY RAILWAY STATION.
The nearest bus stops and service are from stops (A) and (B) on the London Road, Bentley Village, which is a 25-30 minutes walk from Bentley Railway Station.
Bus route 65 operates daily, including Sundays and Bank Holidays.

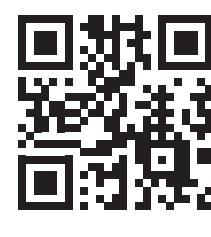
