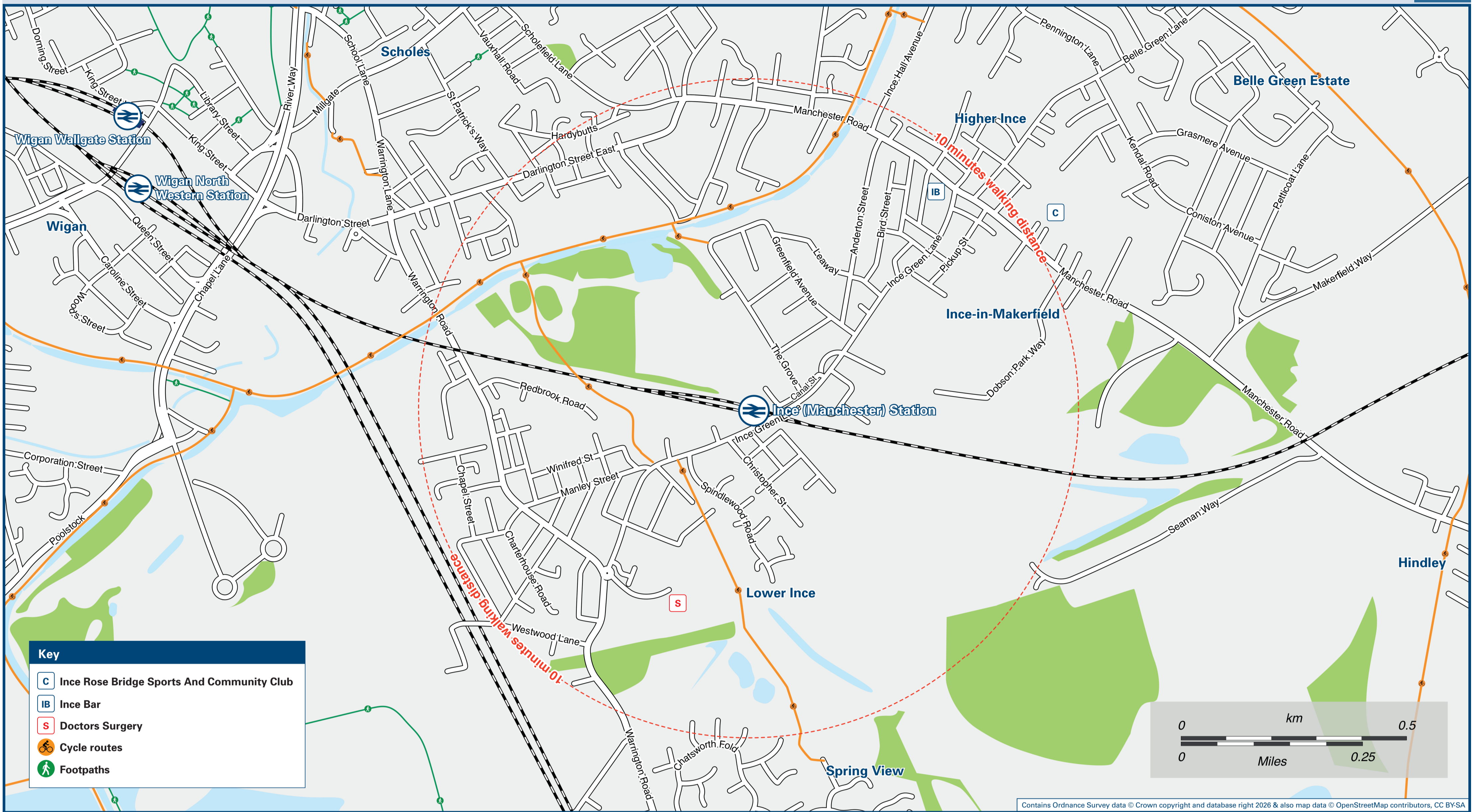




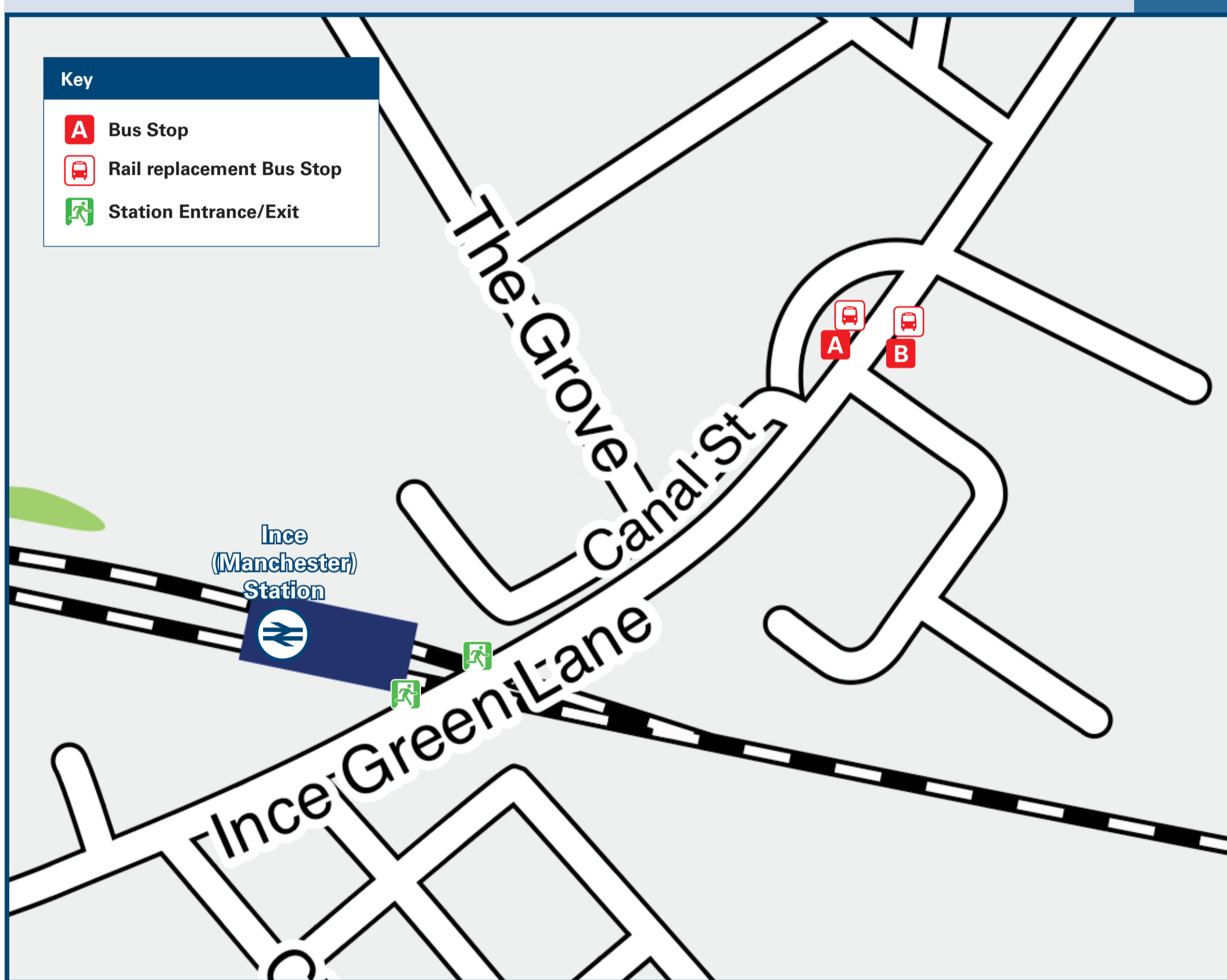
# Ince (Manchester) Station

Rail replacement buses Pick Up / Drop Off turn left at station entrance, 200 yards along Ince Green Lane at the service bus stops outside Ince Green Store.
