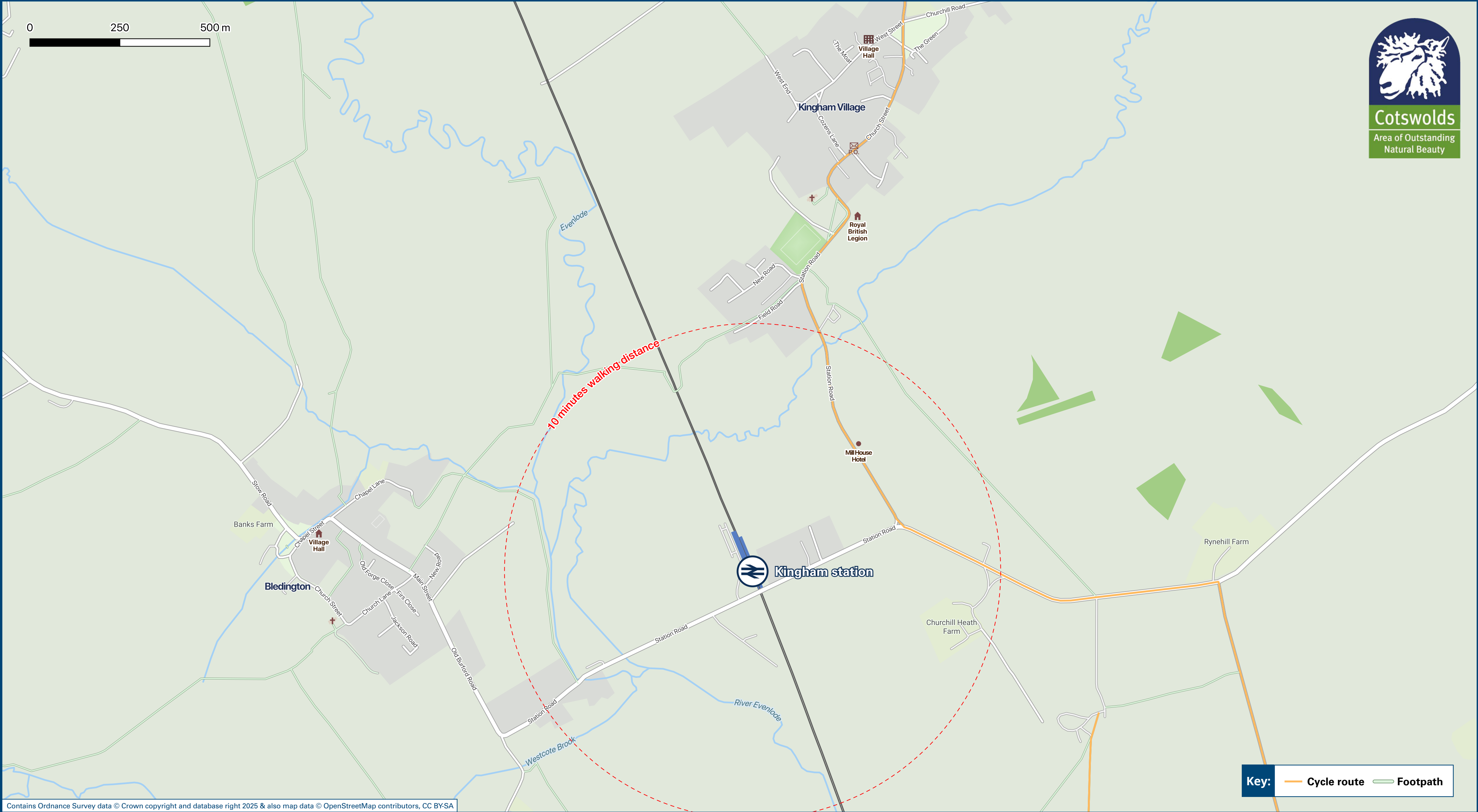

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES THAT OPERATE FROM KINGHAM RAILWAY STATION.

It's a 10 to 15 minutes walk from Kingham station to Bledington and Kingham village centres, see Local area map for walking routes.

Very limited bus route services operate on certain days only, from the unmarked bus stops on Station Road (B and C, please see bus map) to Chipping Norton, Stow, Witney, and other villages.
