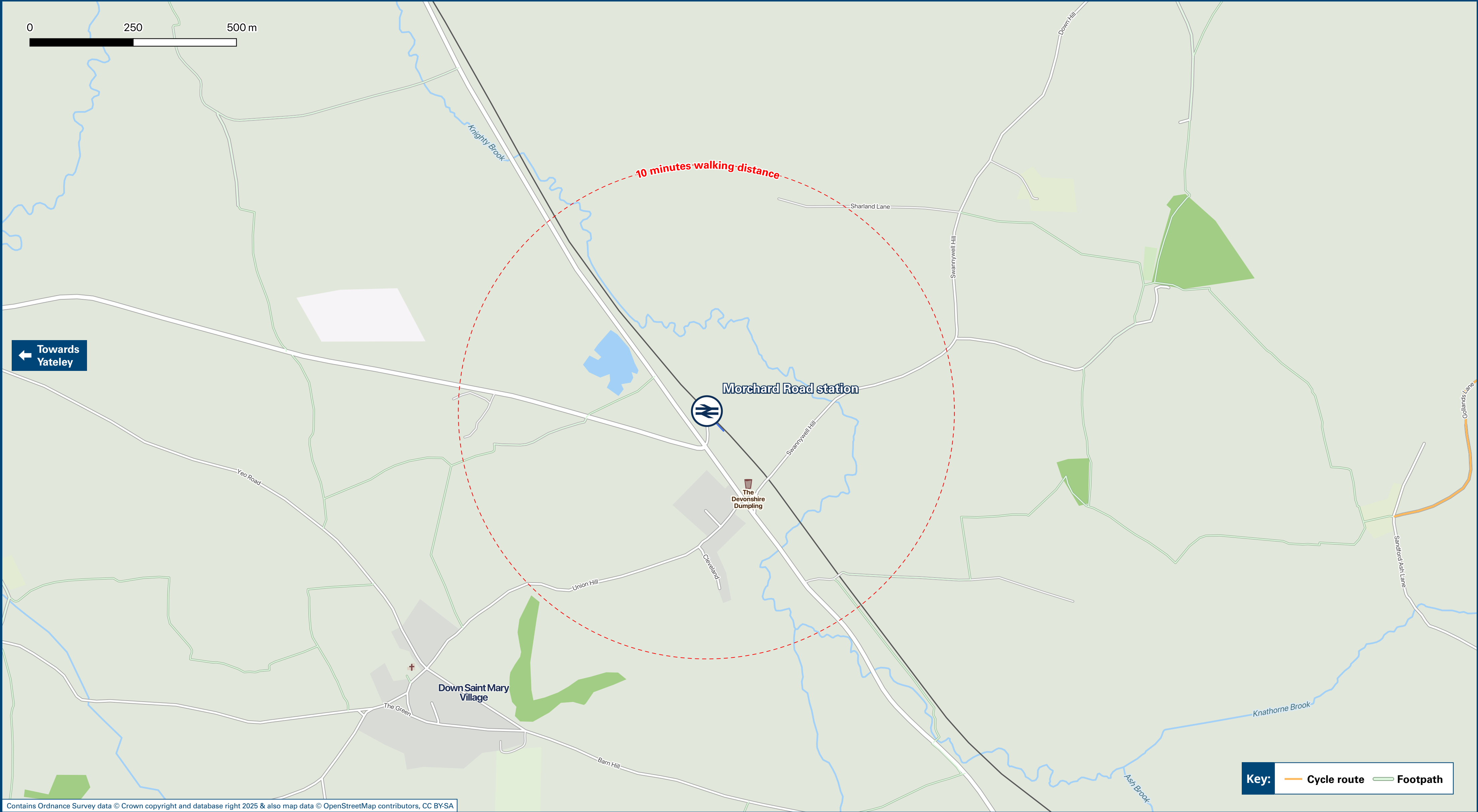




# Morchard Road Station

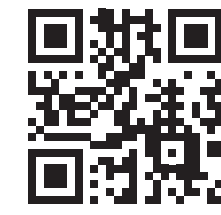
