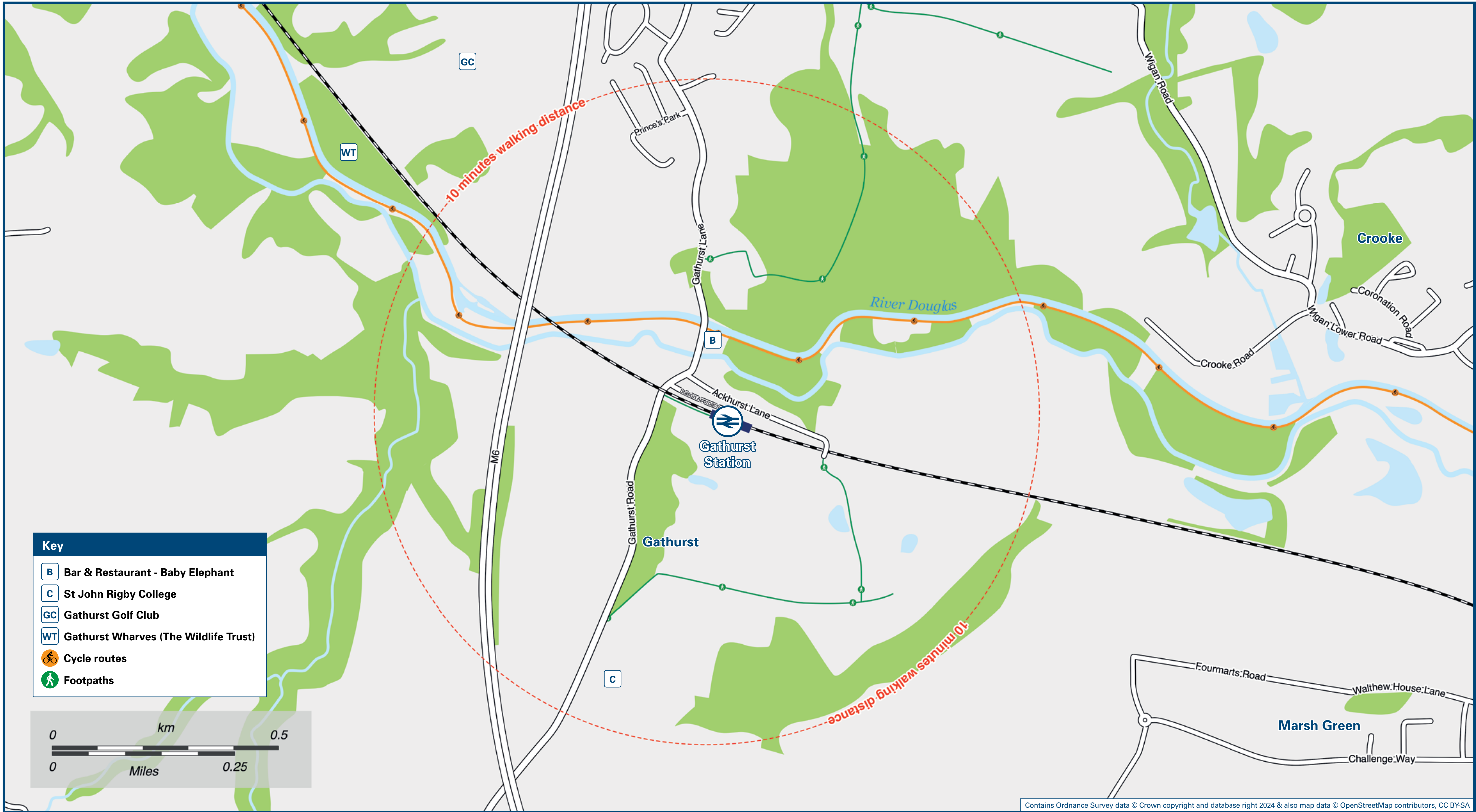




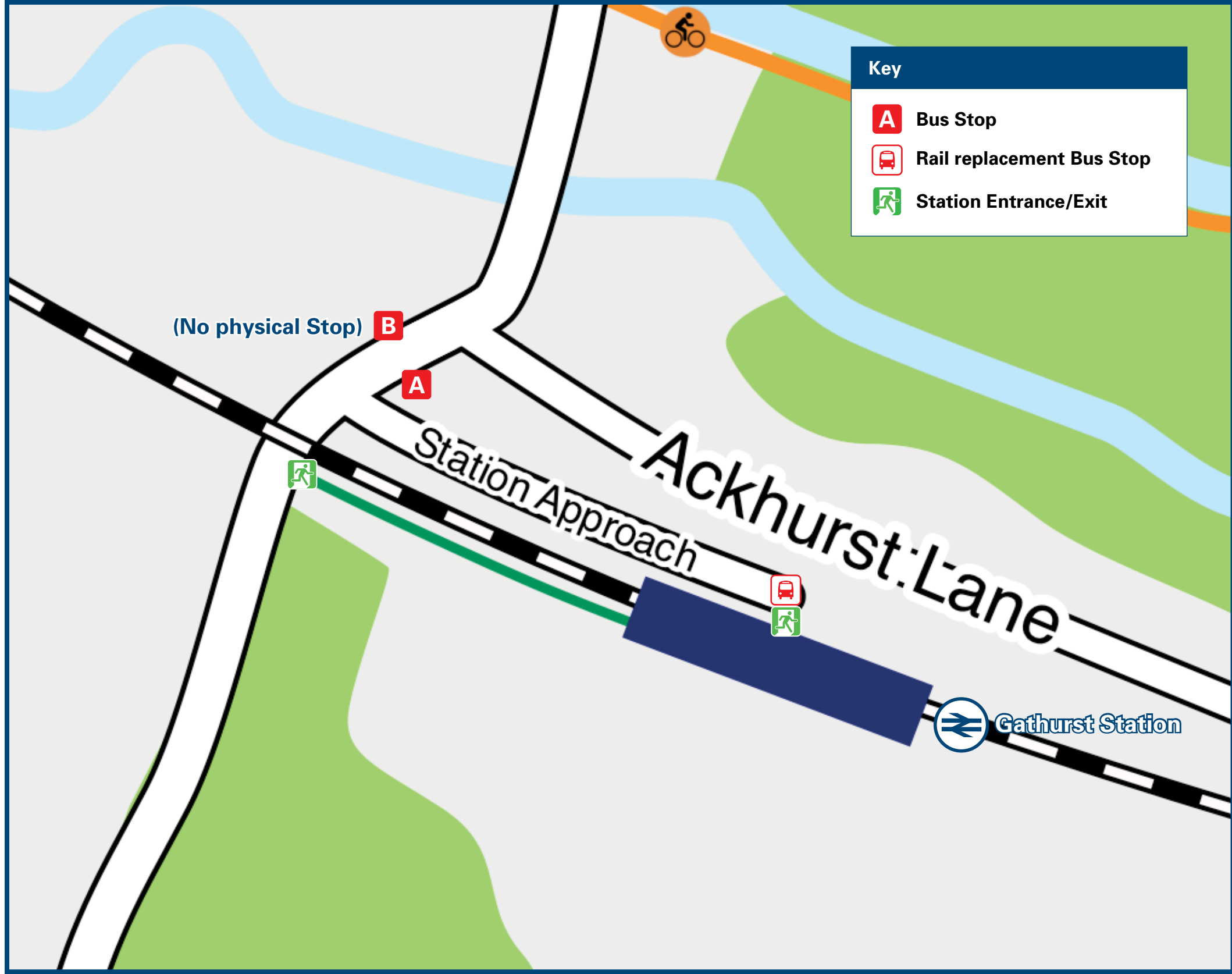
Gathurst Station

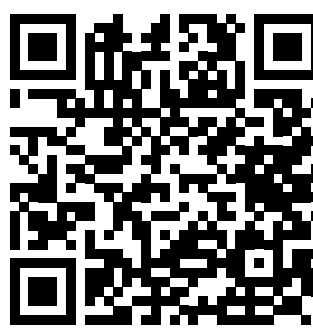
