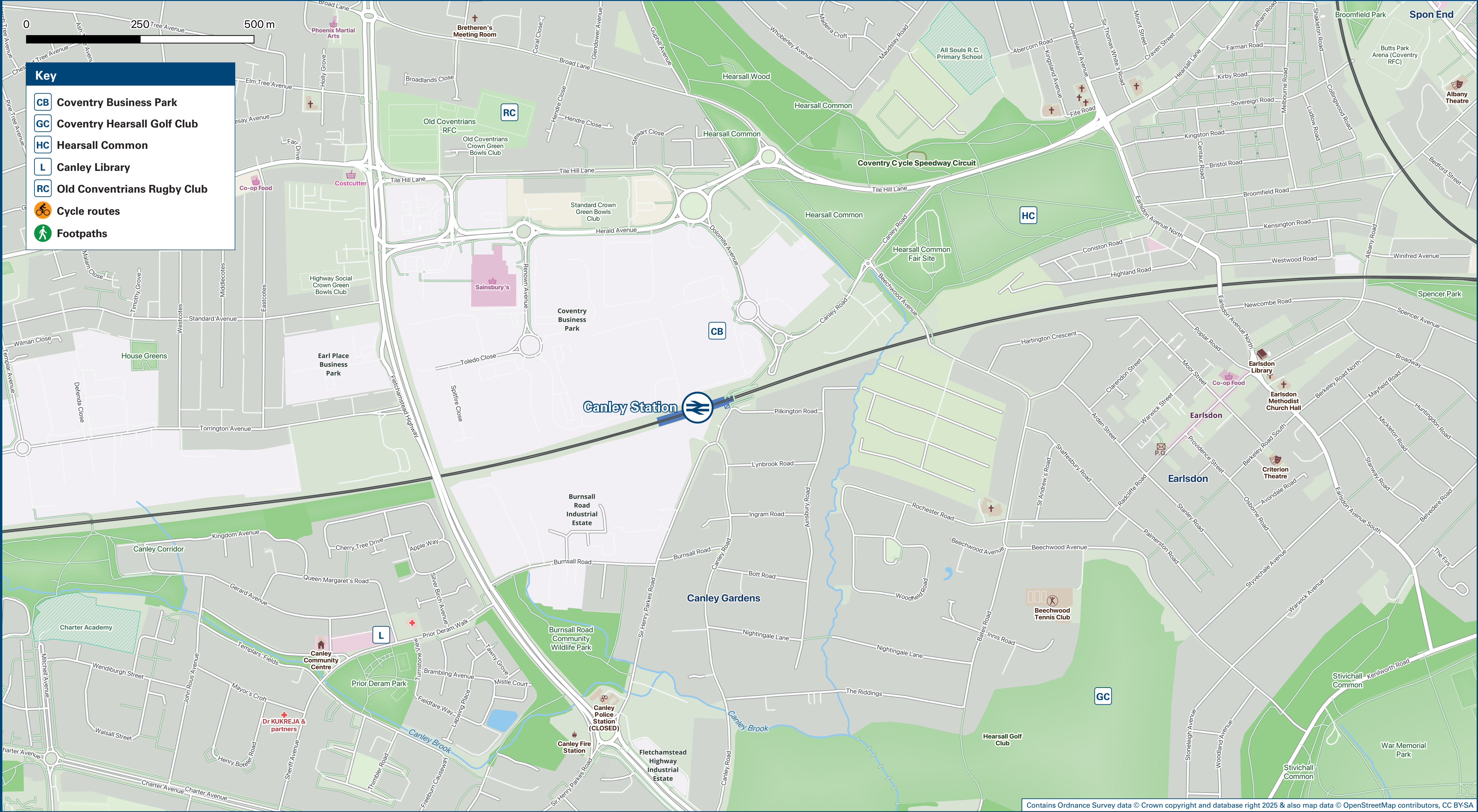




Canley Station
