




# Thatcham Station

**Notes**

Bus routes 1a and 1c operate Mondays to Saturdays.  
Bus route 1 (jet black) operates a frequent daily service from Thatcham Broadway.  
Additional Community Connect Bus services run a limited bus service on Mondays to Fridays to Cookham Park, Brimpton Village, Baughurst, Tadley, Aldermaston Village, Aldermaston The Wharf and stops to Calcot.
