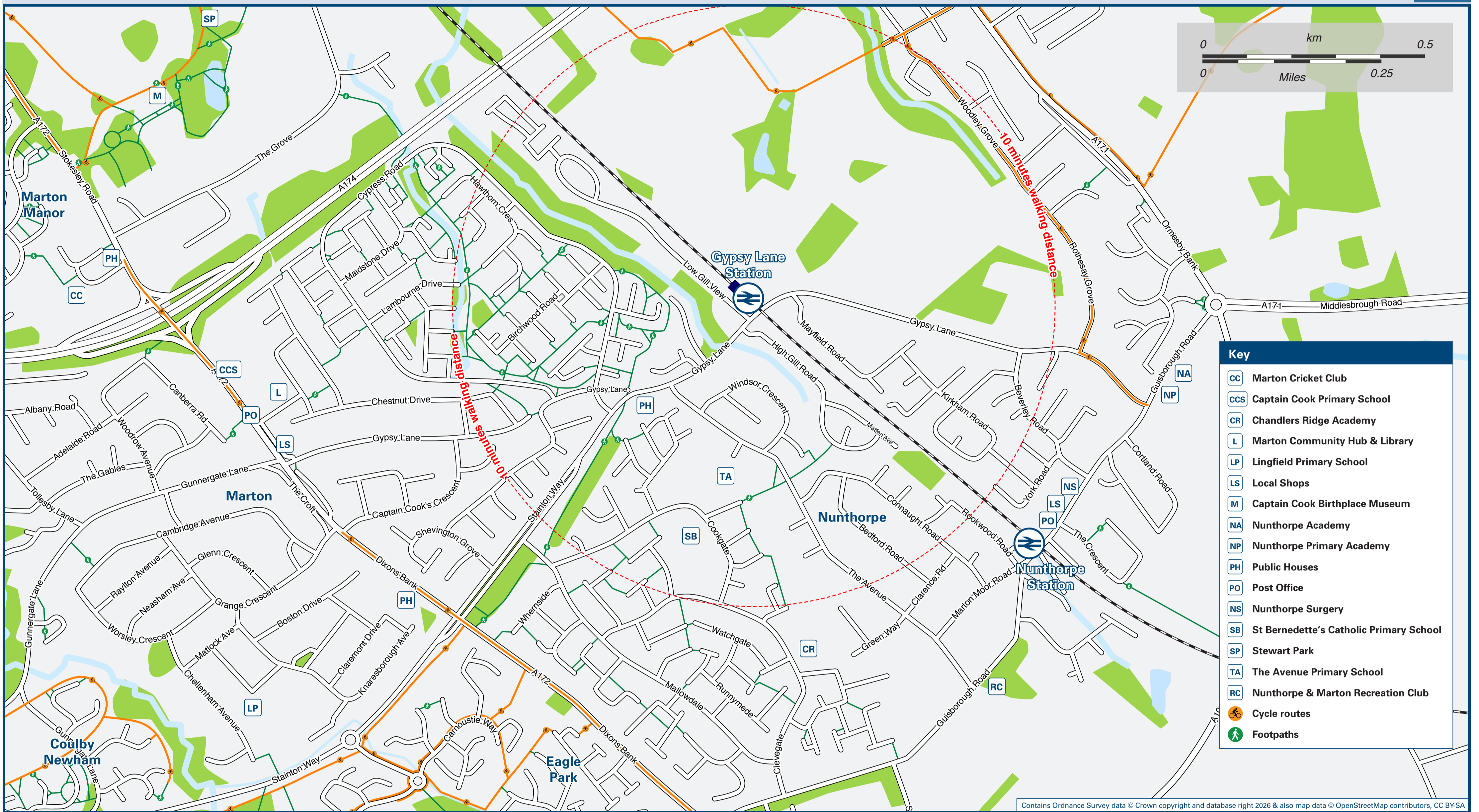




Gypsy Lane Station
