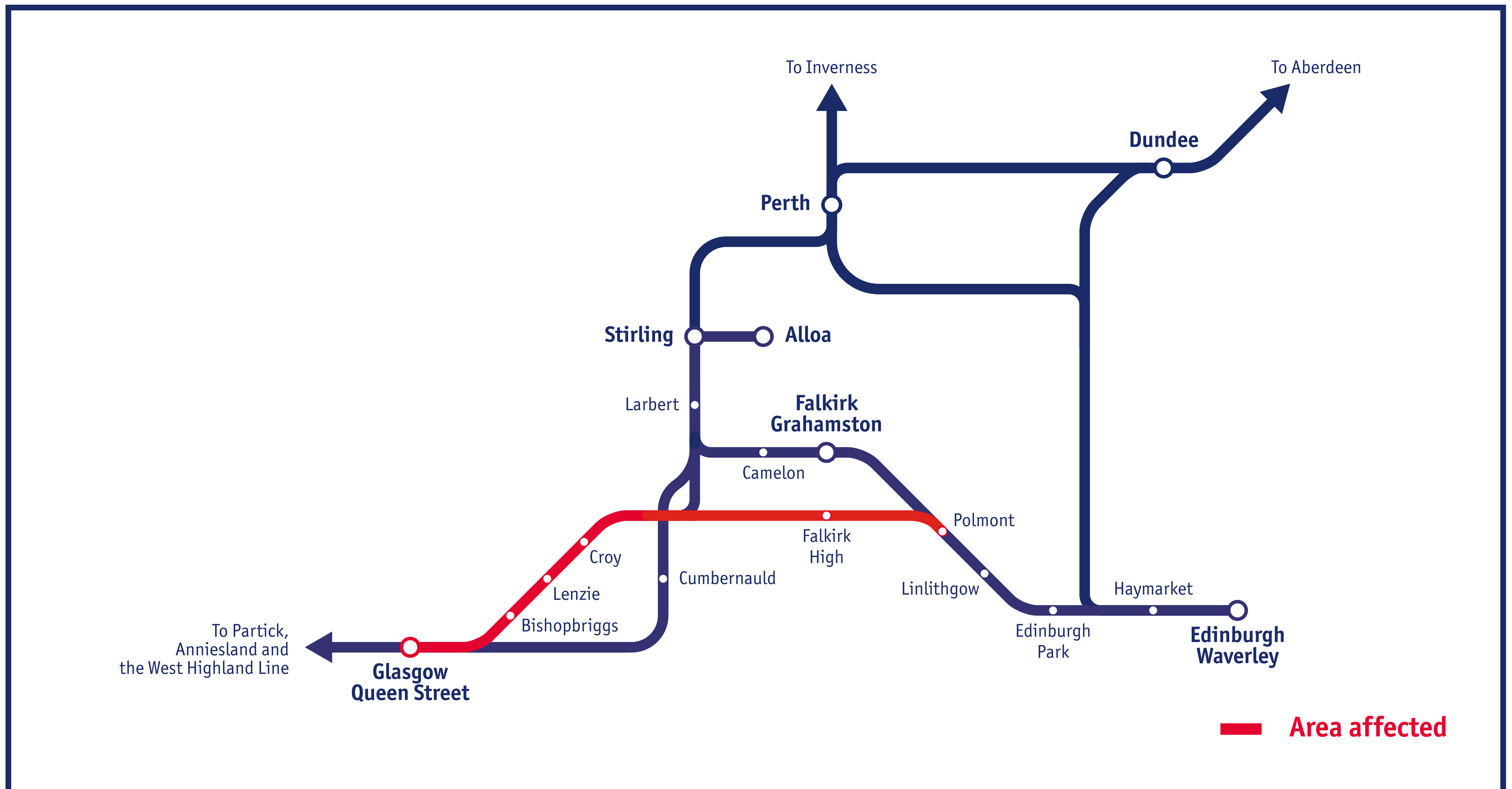


Service Alterations

Glasgow Queen Street to Polmont

Sunday 28 and Monday 29 June

Sunday 5 and Monday 6 July



If you travel to / from any of the stations marked in red above, your journey may be affected as follows:

Affected train services will not call at Bishopbriggs, Lenzie, Croy and Falkirk High. Train services will be diverted via Cumbernauld, with revised times at Glasgow Queen Street

Sundays 28 June & 5 July 2026

Glasgow Queen St – Aberdeen / Inverness / Elgin services

- Train services are diverted between Glasgow and Stirling

Glasgow Queen St – Edinburgh (via Falkirk High) services

- Train services are diverted, and call additionally at Cumbernauld and Falkirk Grahamston

Glasgow Queen St – Alloa services

- Train services operate between Glasgow Queen St and Stirling at revised times.
- A separate train service also operates between Stirling and Alloa.

Glasgow Queen St – Cumbernauld services

Train services operate at revised times, with most extended to Stirling.

Replacement Buses

Replacement buses operate as follows:

- Glasgow Queen St – Bishopbriggs – Lenzie – Croy – Cumbernauld (hourly all-day) (connecting with Glasgow Queen St to Stirling or Edinburgh trains)
- Croy – Cumbernauld (start & end of day only) connecting with Glasgow Queen St to Edinburgh trains

Mondays 29 June & 6 July 2026

Glasgow Queen St – Aberdeen / Inverness / Elgin services

- Train services are diverted between Glasgow and Stirling

Glasgow Queen St – Edinburgh (via Falkirk High) services

- Reduced to half-hourly frequency all day.
- Train services are diverted and call additionally at Cumbernauld, Camelton, and Falkirk Grahamston.

Glasgow Queen St – Cumbernauld / Glasgow Queen St – Stirling & Alloa Glasgow Queen St – Perth & Dundee

- An hourly, all-stop train service operates between Glasgow, Stirling, Perth and Dundee until early evening
- Trains thereafter operate between Glasgow and Stirling only
- A separate train service operates all-day between Stirling & Alloa only

Replacement Buses

Replacement buses operate as follows:

- Glasgow Queen St – Bishopbriggs – Lenzie – Croy – Cumbernauld (hourly all-day) (connecting with Glasgow Queen St to Stirling or Edinburgh trains)
- Croy – Cumbernauld (hourly from 0630 - 0930 & 1530 - 1830) connecting with Glasgow Queen St to Edinburgh trains

Journey times will be increased and replacement buses may arrive/depart earlier or later than advertised train times. Please visit www.scotrail.co.uk or download our app to check your own journey. **Passengers are required to have a valid train ticket to travel on rail replacement buses.**
