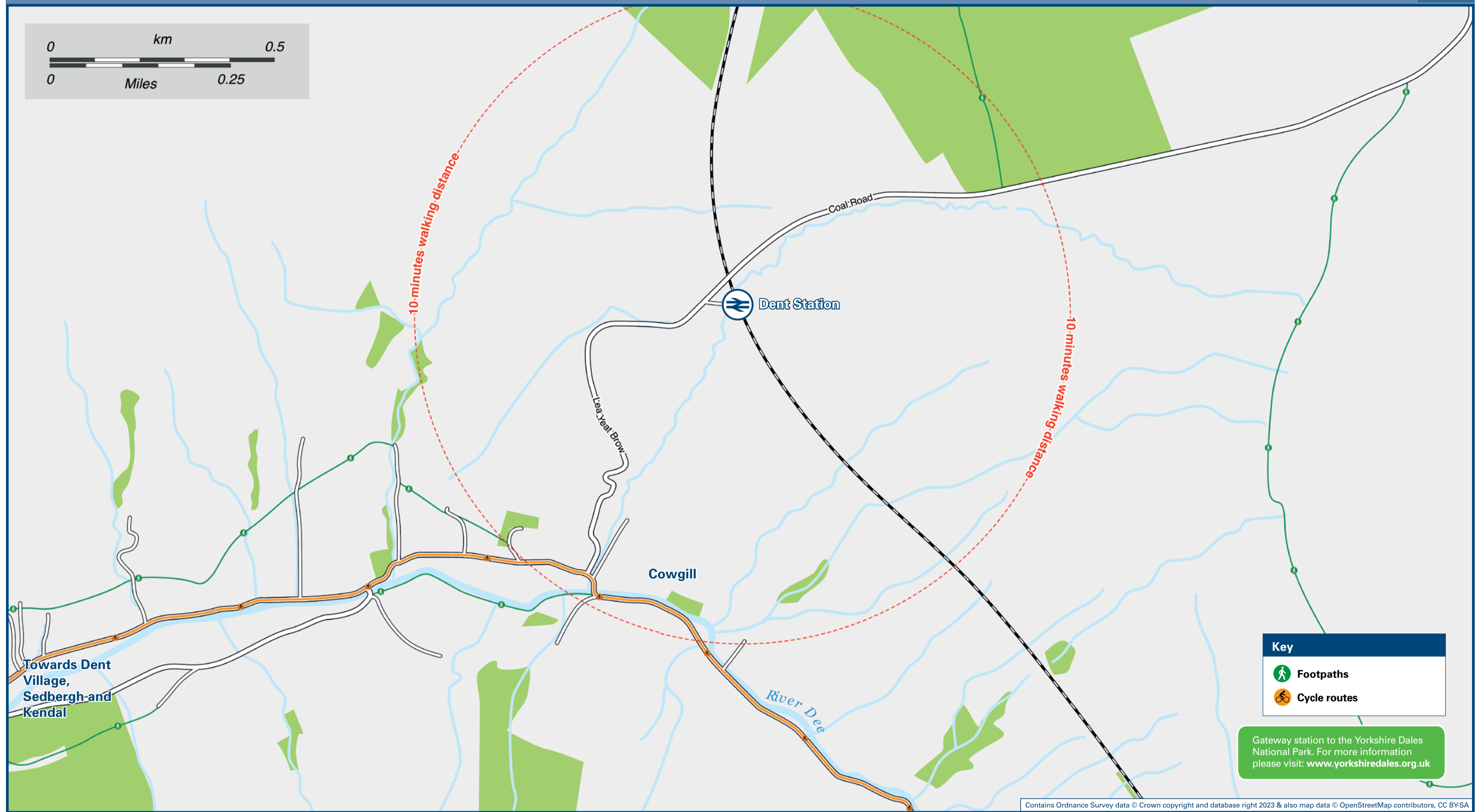

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUSES SERVING DENT STATION

Taxis are usually arranged for passengers requiring Rail Replacement services.

Dent village is approximately 5 miles from Dent Station.

Bus route S1 runs a limited service on Saturdays only from Dent Station stop {A} to Dent Village, Sedbergh, and Kendal.
