- For connecting trains to Swindon, please change at Didcot Parkway station.
- It's approximately 10 to 15 minutes walk from Oxford station to Oxford city centre locations (see maps).

* This is a Night Bus and runs mainly on Friday and Saturday late nights between approximately 00:00 and 03:00. Some Night Buses run on other nights, please check timetables.

** This service departs from Gloucester Green Bus Station, 8 minutes walk from this station - see Local area map.

*** This service departs from Broad Street stop (BS), 12 minutes walk from this station - see Local area map.

+ Take bus ST2 to Headington Lime Walk bus stop, it's a 10 minutes walk to Churchill Hospital from there.

^ This service runs Mondays to Fridays only.
