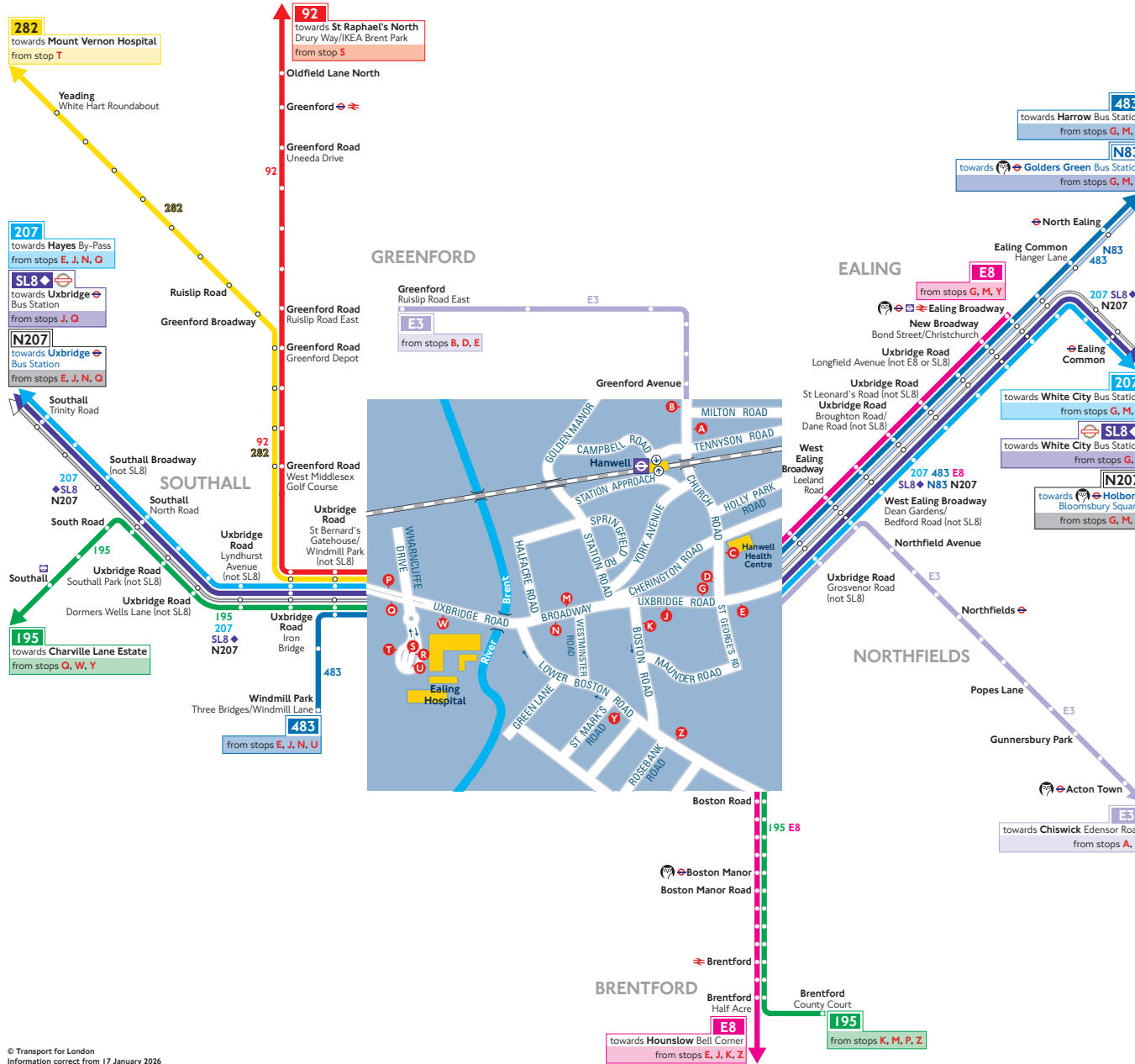

How to use this map

- Find your destination on the map
- See the coloured lines on the map for the bus routes that go to your destination
- Check the map (at the end of each coloured line) for the bus stops to catch your bus from
- Use the central map to find the nearest bus stop for your route
- Look for the bus stop letters at the top of the stop (see example for stop **A** to the right)

SUPERLOOP

Ways to pay

- Pay as you go with contactless (card or device) or an Oyster card – touch in to pay the correct fare
- Download the free TfL Go app to top up or buy a ticket anytime, anywhere, or visit tfl.gov.uk/Oyster. Alternatively, find your nearest Oyster Ticket Stop at tfl.gov.uk/ticketstopfinder or visit your nearest TfL station
- The Hopper fare offers you unlimited Bus and Tram journeys within the first hour of touching in for the price of a single fare (or for the price of one journey). Always use the same card or device when touching in
