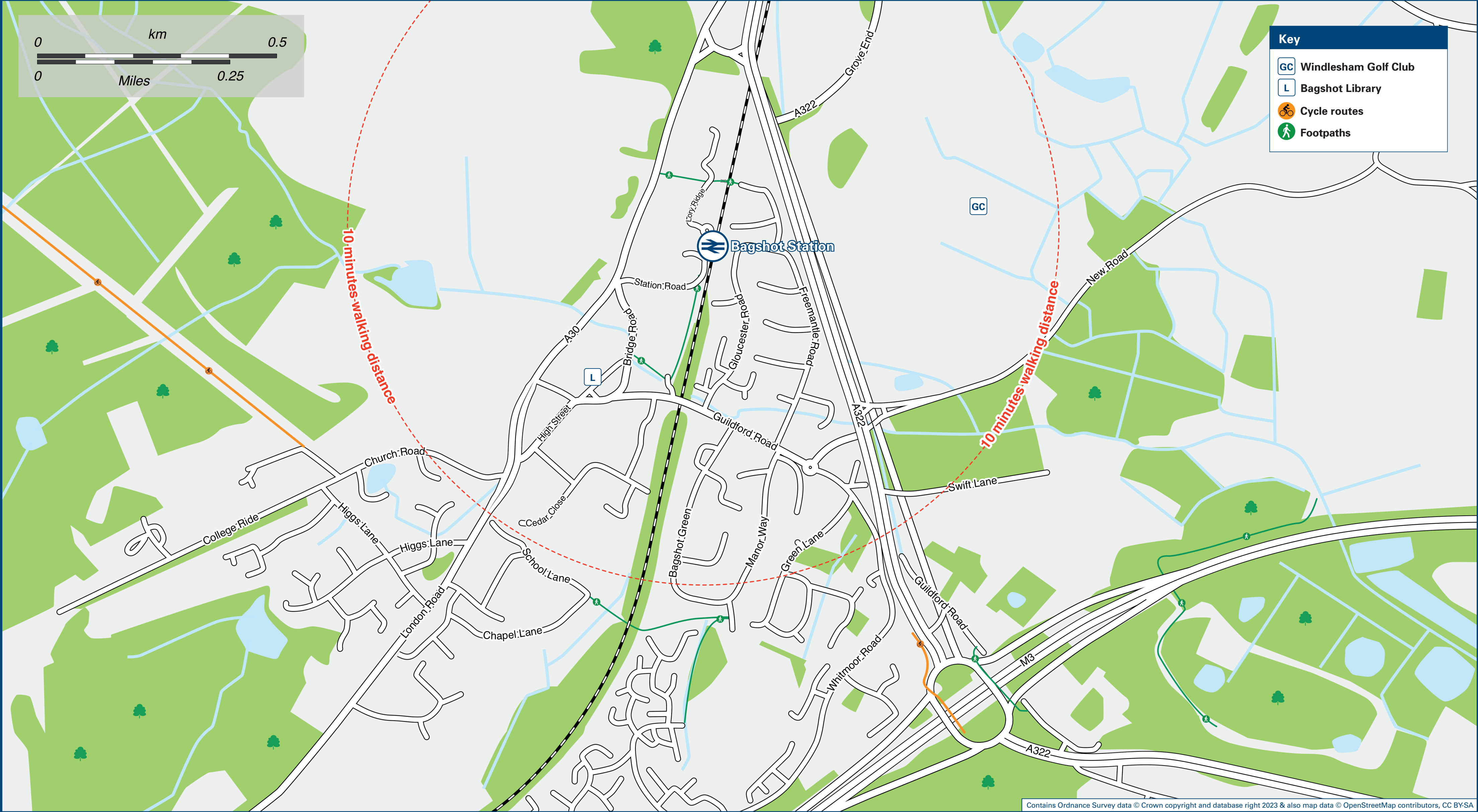




# Bagshot Station
