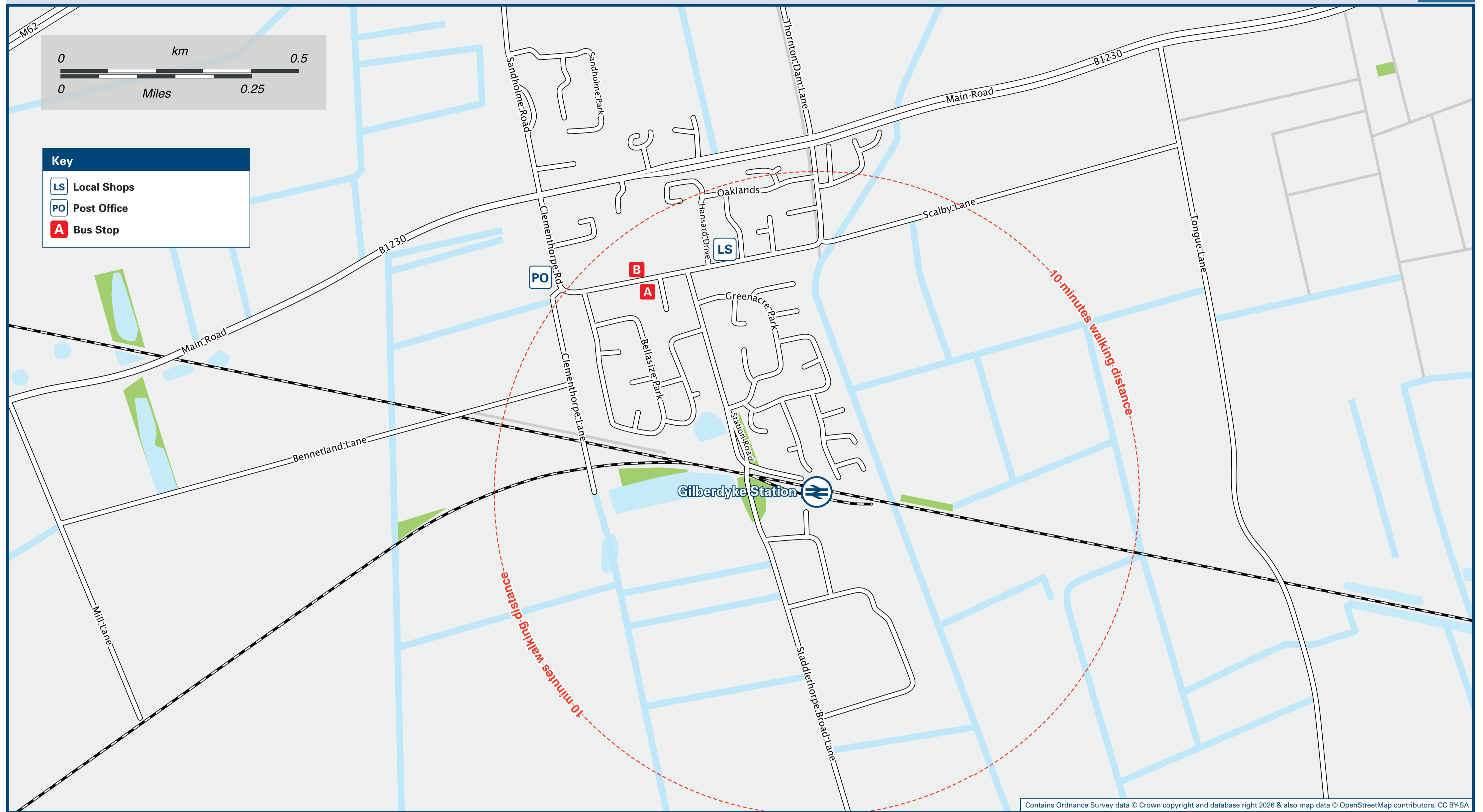




Gilberdyke Station

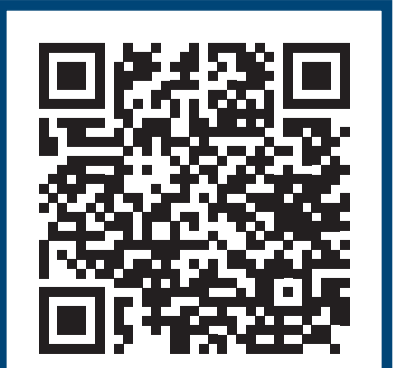
