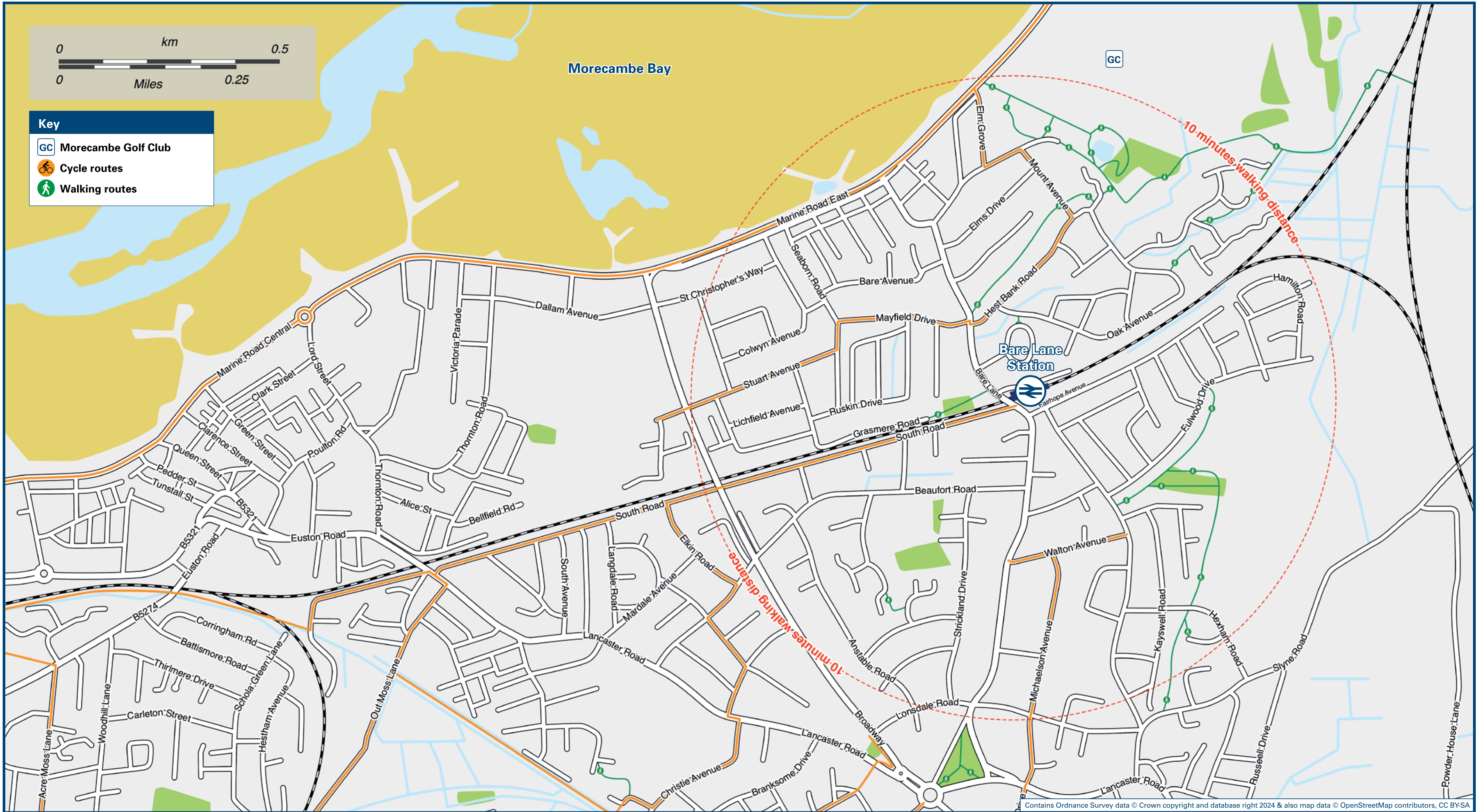




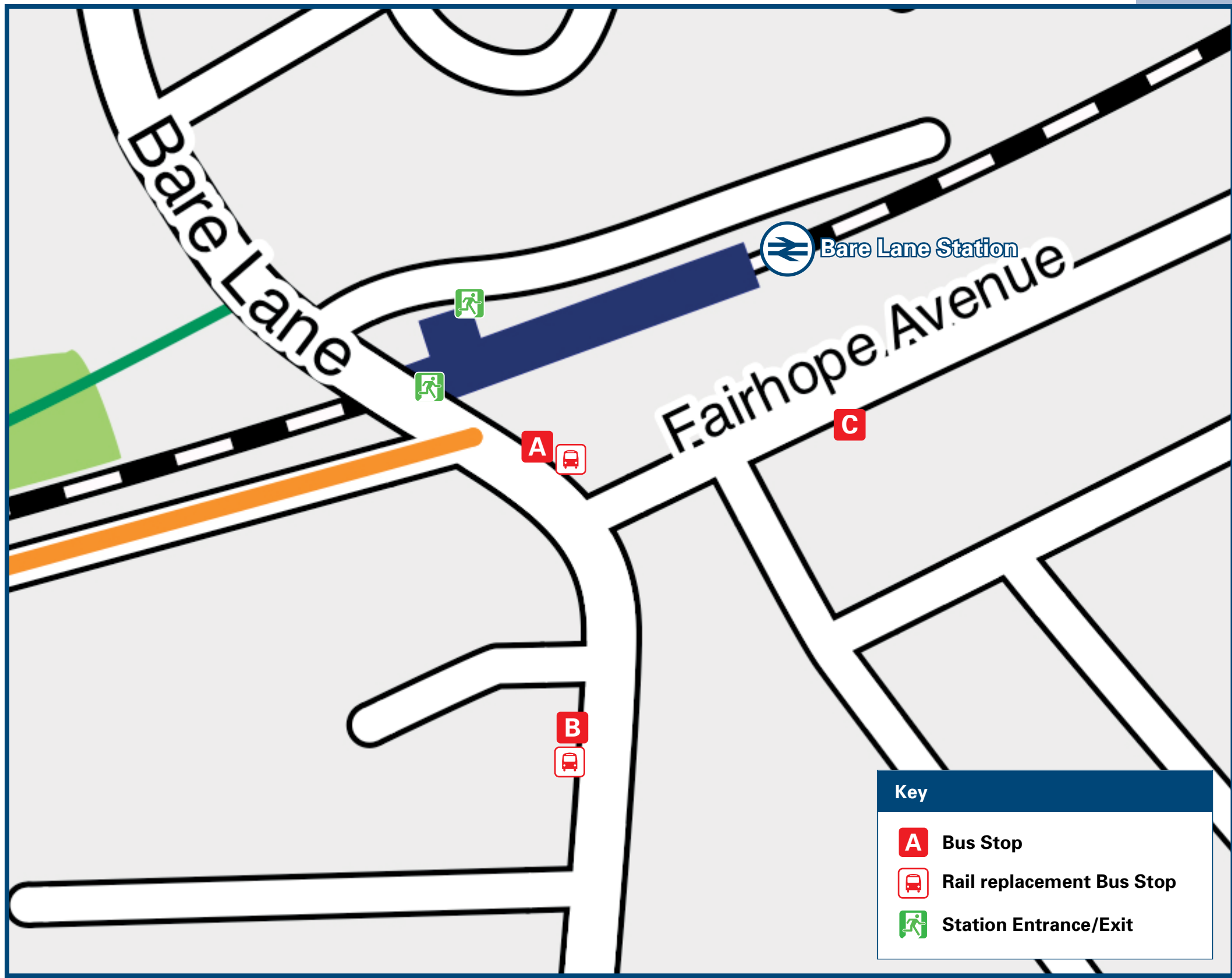
Bare Lane Station
