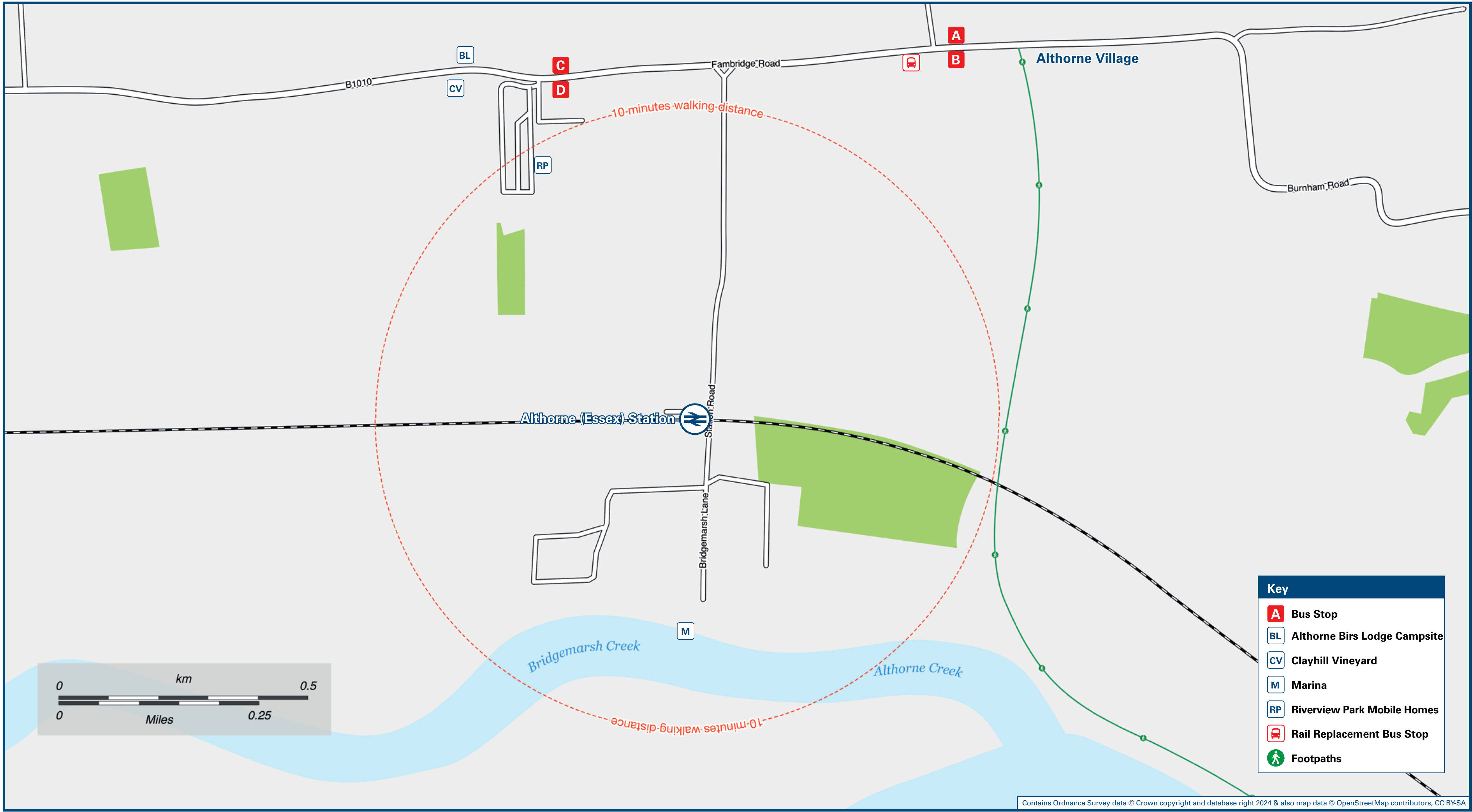




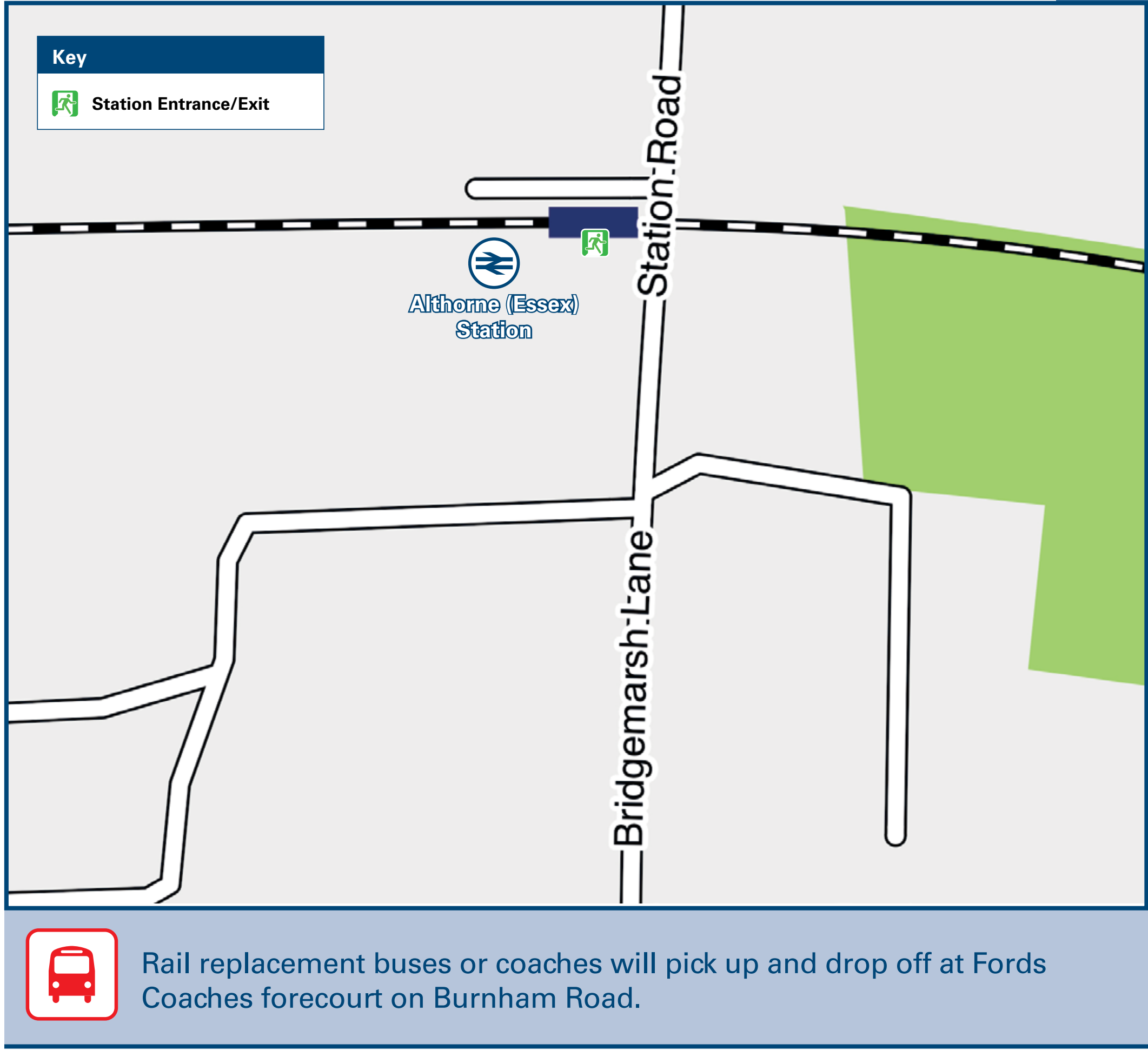

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING ALTHORNE RAILWAY STATION

Bus route 45 operates Mondays to Fridays only from Althorne stops **A** and **C** (see Local area map) to Burnham-on-Crouch, Southminster, Asheldham, Dengie, Tillingham and Bradwell-on-Sea.

Bus route 45 operates Mondays to Fridays only from Althorne stops **B** and **D** (see Local area map) to Cold Norton, North Fambridge, Stow Maries and South Woodham Ferrers.

Bus routes 31 and 331 operate Mondays to Saturdays from Althorne, Old Post Office (a 35 to 40 minutes walk from this station), to Burnham-on-Crouch, Southminster, Maldon and Chelmsford.
