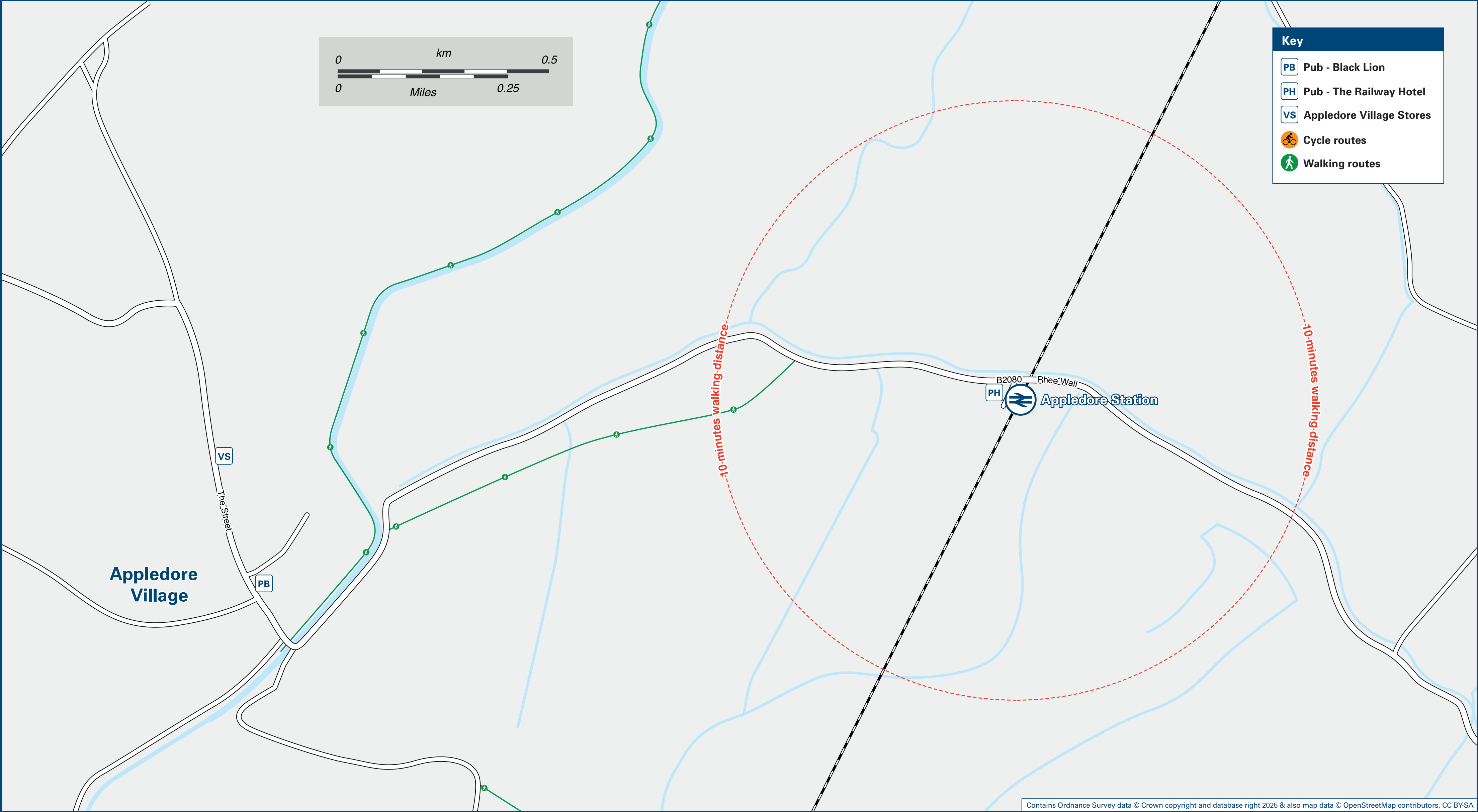




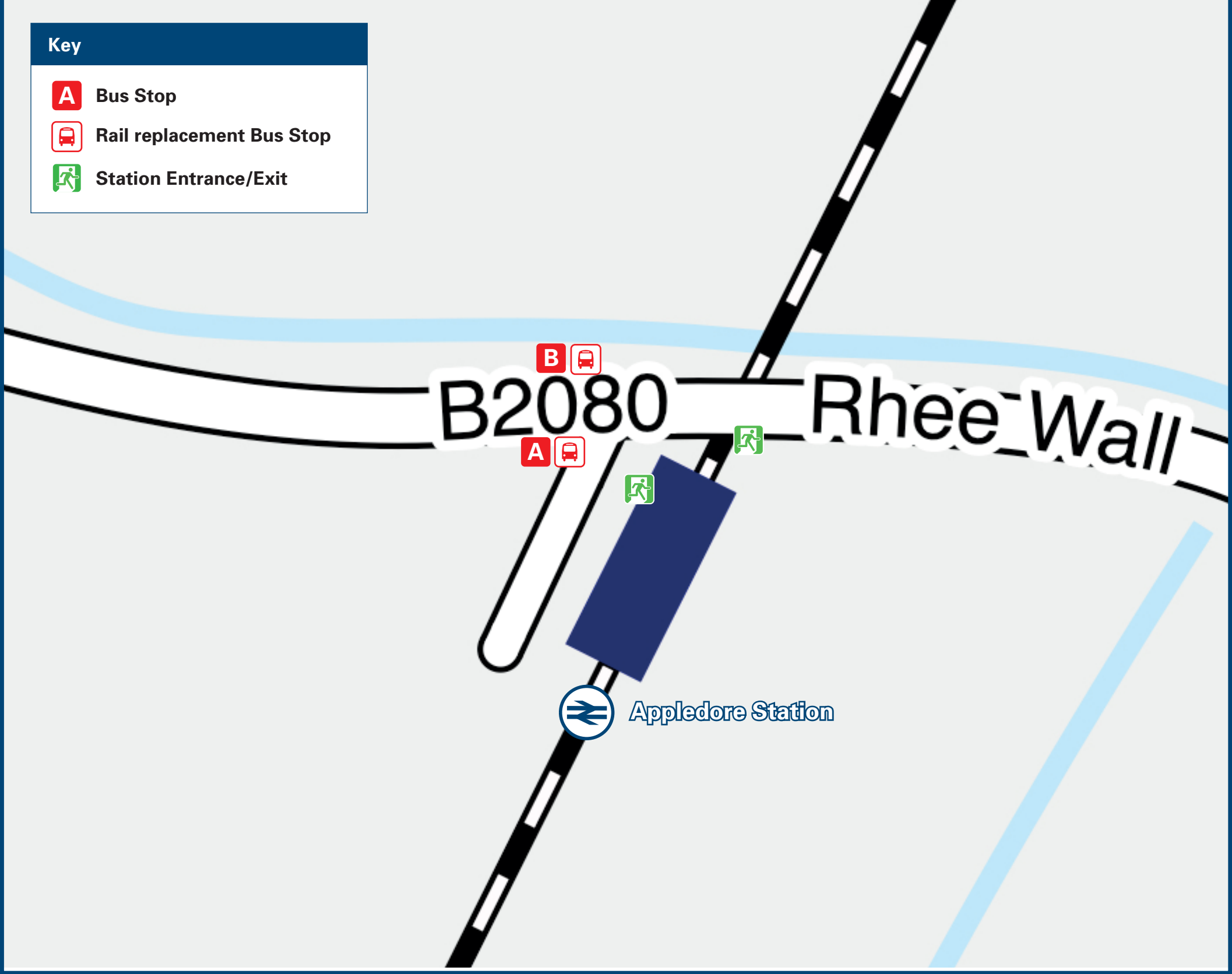

THERE ARE NO FREQUENT BUS SERVICES SERVING APPLIEDORE RAILWAY STATION

Bus route 511B operates a very limited daytime service from this station, on Mondays to Saturdays only, and at the following times:

From stop **A (station side) at 10:23 (Mondays to Saturdays) and at 17:36 (Mondays to Fridays only) to Appledore village, Appledore Heath, Kenardington, Warehorn, Hamstreet, Bromley Green, Kingsnorth and Ashford.**

From stop **B (opposite station) at 14:17 to Snargate, Brenzett, Brookland, Ivychurch, Old Romney and New Romney.**
