



Local area map

THERE ARE NO FREQUENT BUS SERVICES SERVING APPLEDORE **RAILWAY STATION**

Bus route 11B operates a limited service from this station Mondays to Saturdays only at the following times:

From stop [A] (station side) at 10:23 and 17:36(Mondays to Fridays) only) to Appledore village, Appledore Heath, Kenardington, Warehorn, Hamstreet, Bromley Green, Kingsnorth and Ashford.

From stop **B** (opposite station) at 14:22 to Snargate, Brenzett, Brookland, lvychurch, Old Romney and New Romney.

Bus route 11B is operated by Stagecoach South East, call 0345 241 8000 for more information or contact Traveline on 0871 200 22 33.

It's a 25 minutes walk from this station to Appledore village or prebook a taxi.
