



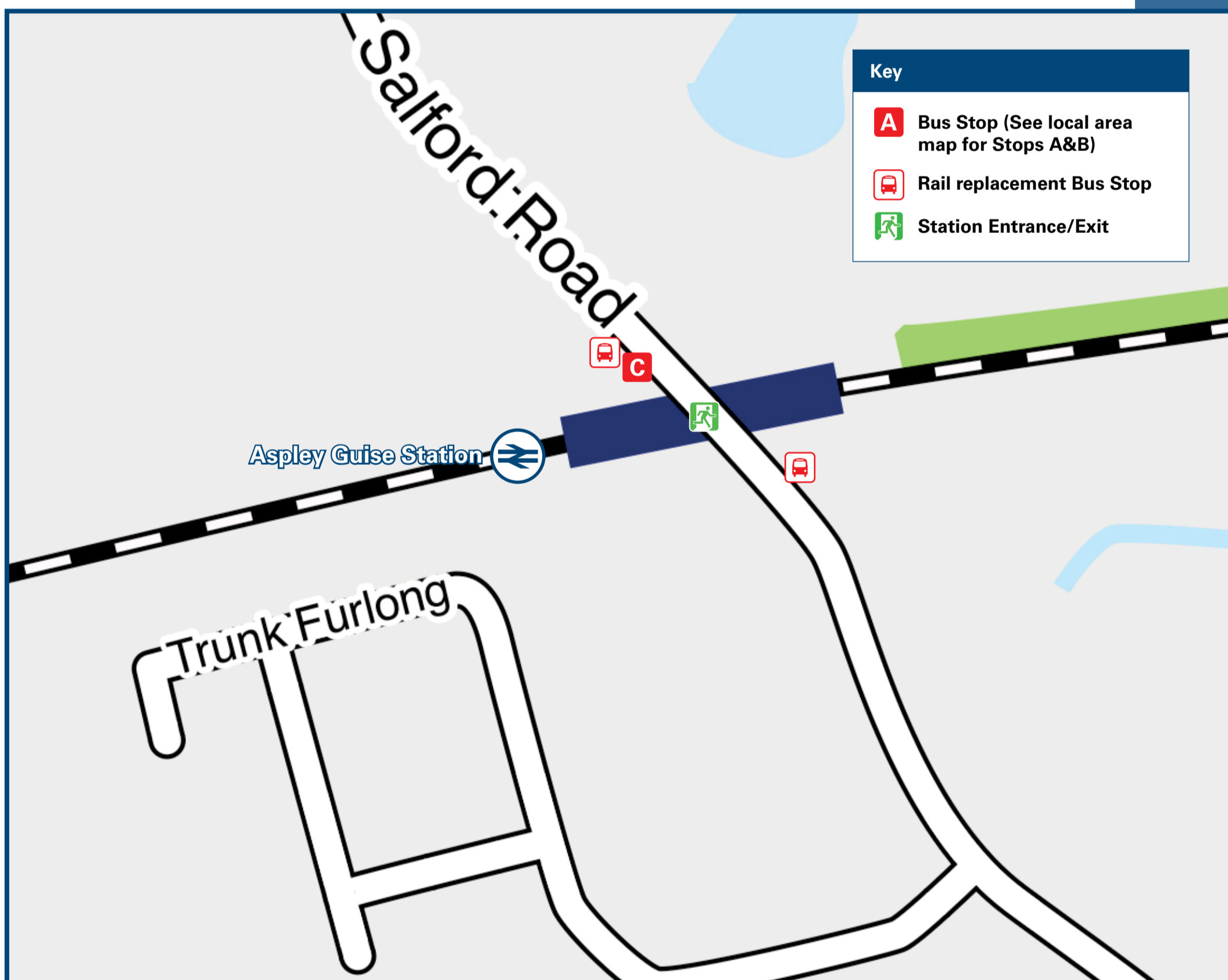

**THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING ASPLEY GUISE RAILWAY STATION**

It's a 15 minutes walk from this station to Aspley Guise Village The Square for bus stops **A** and **B** on the Local area map.

**Bus service information:**

Bus route 47 operates Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays from stop **B** at 09:37 and 14:59 to Husborne Crawley, Ridgmont village and Brogborough.

Bus route 47A operates Thursdays only from stop **B** at 09:37 and 14:59 to Husborne Crawley, Ridgmont village and Brogborough.

Bus route 47 operates Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays only from stop **A** at 10:00 to Woburn and Leighton Buzzard and at 15:20 to Woburn, Eversholt and Toddington.

Bus route 47A operates Thursdays only from stop **A** at 10:00 to Woburn and Dunstable and at 15:20 to Woburn, Eversholt and Toddington.

Bus route 134 operates Mondays and Fridays only from stop **A** at 10:29 to Woburn Sands, Kingston Centre, Milton Keynes Hospital and Central Milton Keynes (The Point).

Bus route 134 operates Mondays and Fridays only from stop **B** at 13:24 to Ridgmont, Amptill and Flitwick.

Bus route D operates on the 1st Monday of the month from Aspley Guise railway station (stop **C** on map) at 09:52 to Central Milton Keynes (The Point), booking is advisable.
