#### THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING ASPLEY GUISE RAILWAY STATION

Bus service information, it's a 15 minutes walk from this station to Aspley Guise Village The Square (for stops **A** & **B** on the Local area map):

Bus route 47 runs Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from Aspley Guise, The Square stop **A** at 10:51 to Leighton Buzzard.

Bus route 47 runs Tuesdays from Aspley Guise, The Square stop **A** at 09:28 & 10:51 to Leighton Buzzard.

Bus route 47 runs Thursdays from Aspley Guise, The Square stop **A** at 10:29 to Dunstable.

Bus route 47 runs Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from Aspley Guise, The Square stop **B** at 13:34 to Woburn.

Bus route 47 runs Tuesdays from Aspley Guise, The Square stop **B** at 13:34 to Woburn (& bookable only to Eversholt and Tingrith)

Bus route 47 runs Thursdays from Aspley Guise, The Square stop **B** at 14:03 to Dunstable.

Bus route D runs the 1st Monday of the month from Aspley Guise railway station stop **C** at 09:52 to Central Milton Keynes. Booking is advisable, please telephone 01234 841654.
