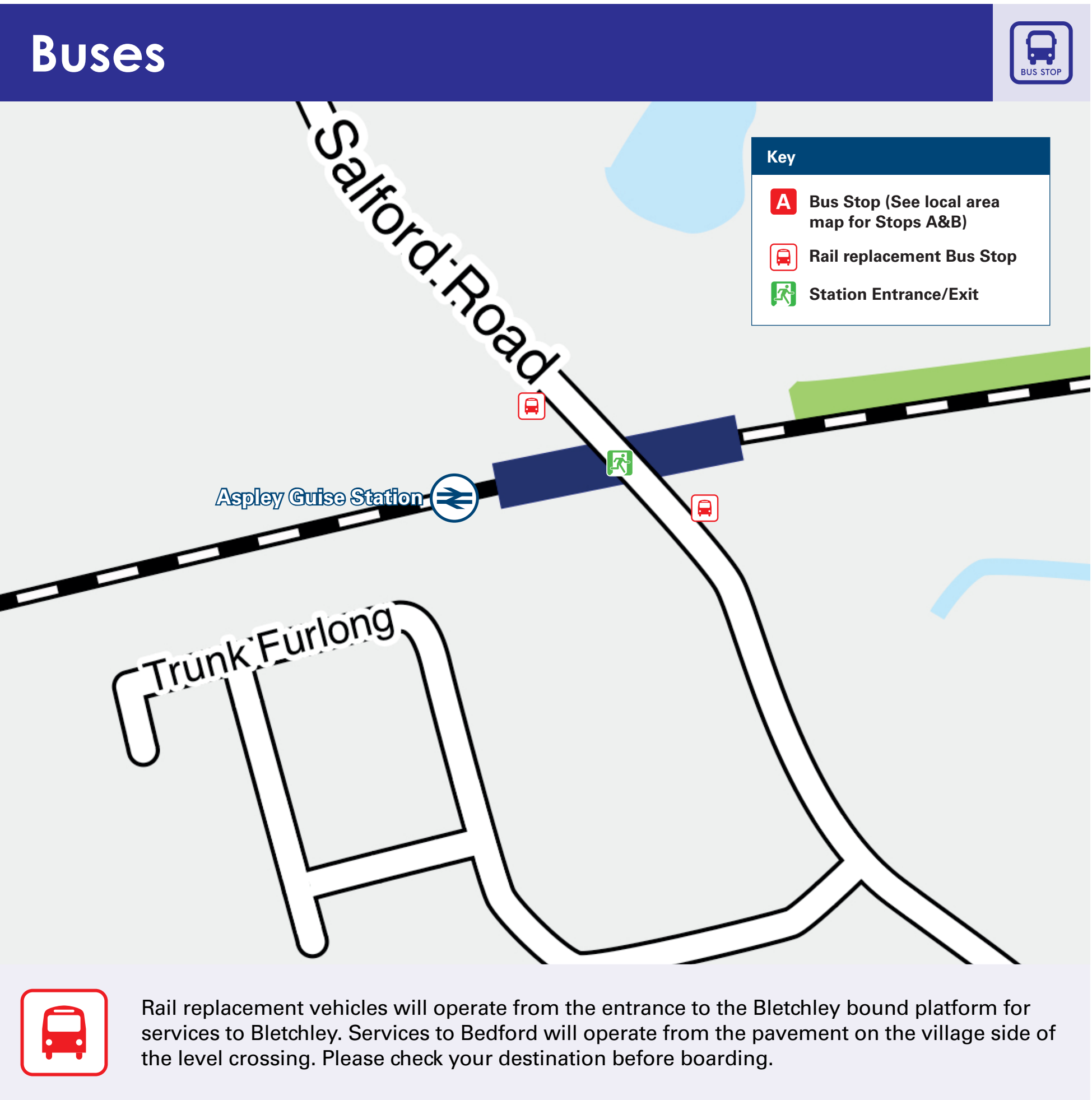

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING ASPLEY GUISE RAILWAY STATION

It's a 15 - 20 minutes walk from this station to Aspley Guise Village The Square for bus stops **A** and **B** on the Local area map.

Bus route 47 operates Tuesdays only at 09:56 to Woburn and Leighton Buzzard; and at 13:55 to Woburn, Eversholt and Toddington.

Bus route 134 operates Mondays and Fridays only from stop **A** at 10:29 to Woburn Sands, Kingston Centre, Milton Keynes Hospital and Central Milton Keynes (The Point).

Bus route 134 operates Mondays and Fridays only from stop **B** at 13:24 to Ridgmont, Ampthill and Flitwick.

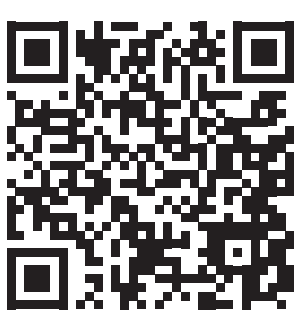
