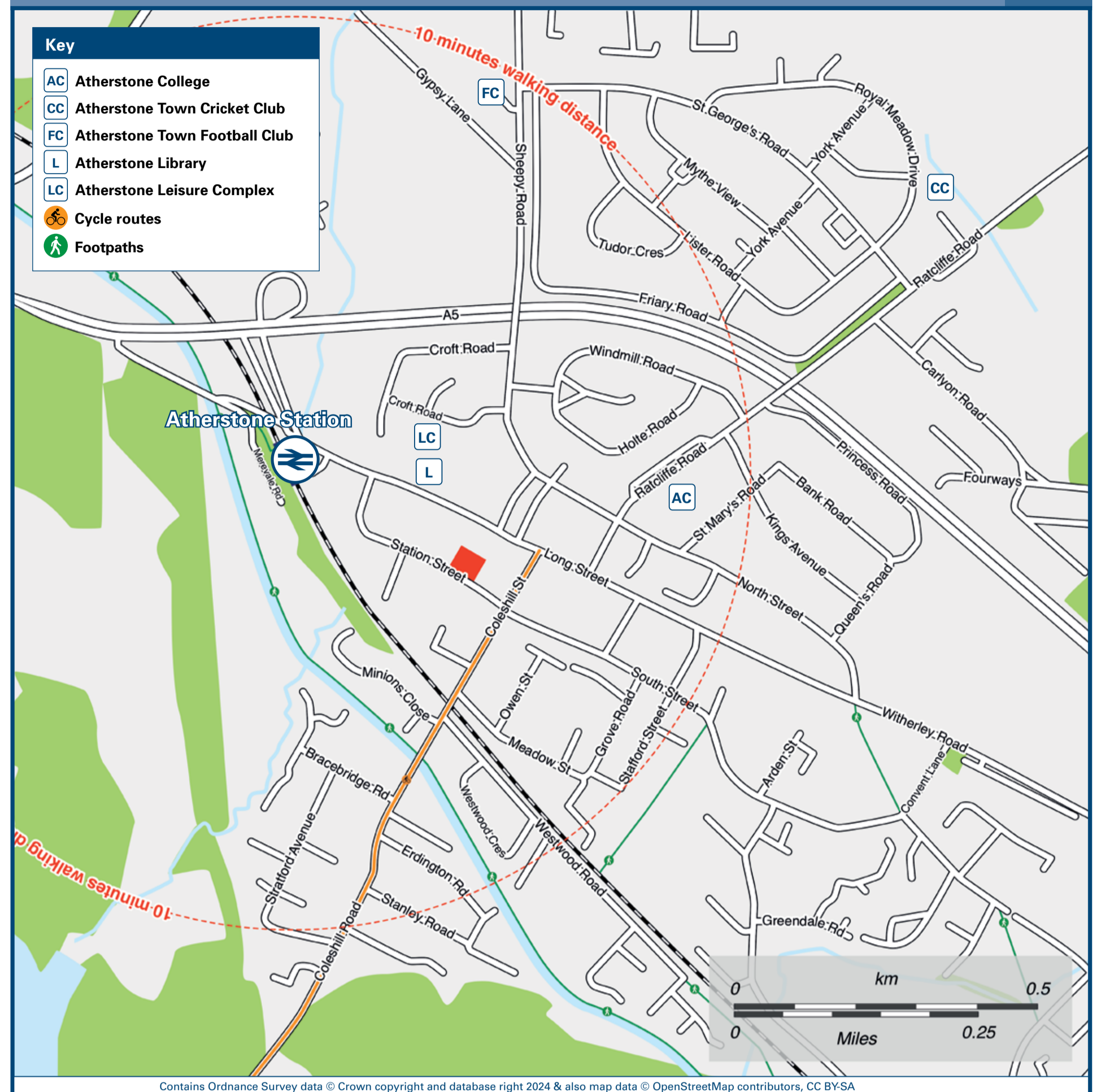

Direct trains operate to this destination from this station.  
\* Bus routes 7, 762 and 767 run a limited service Mondays to Saturdays only.  
\*\* Bus route 7 runs one bus on Saturdays and Mondays to Fridays in School Holidays only at 10:12 to Twycross Zoo (returning from Twycross Zoo at 15:29), otherwise take a taxi from this station (15 minutes taxi journey).  
+ Bus route 748 runs Sundays and some Public Holidays only.
