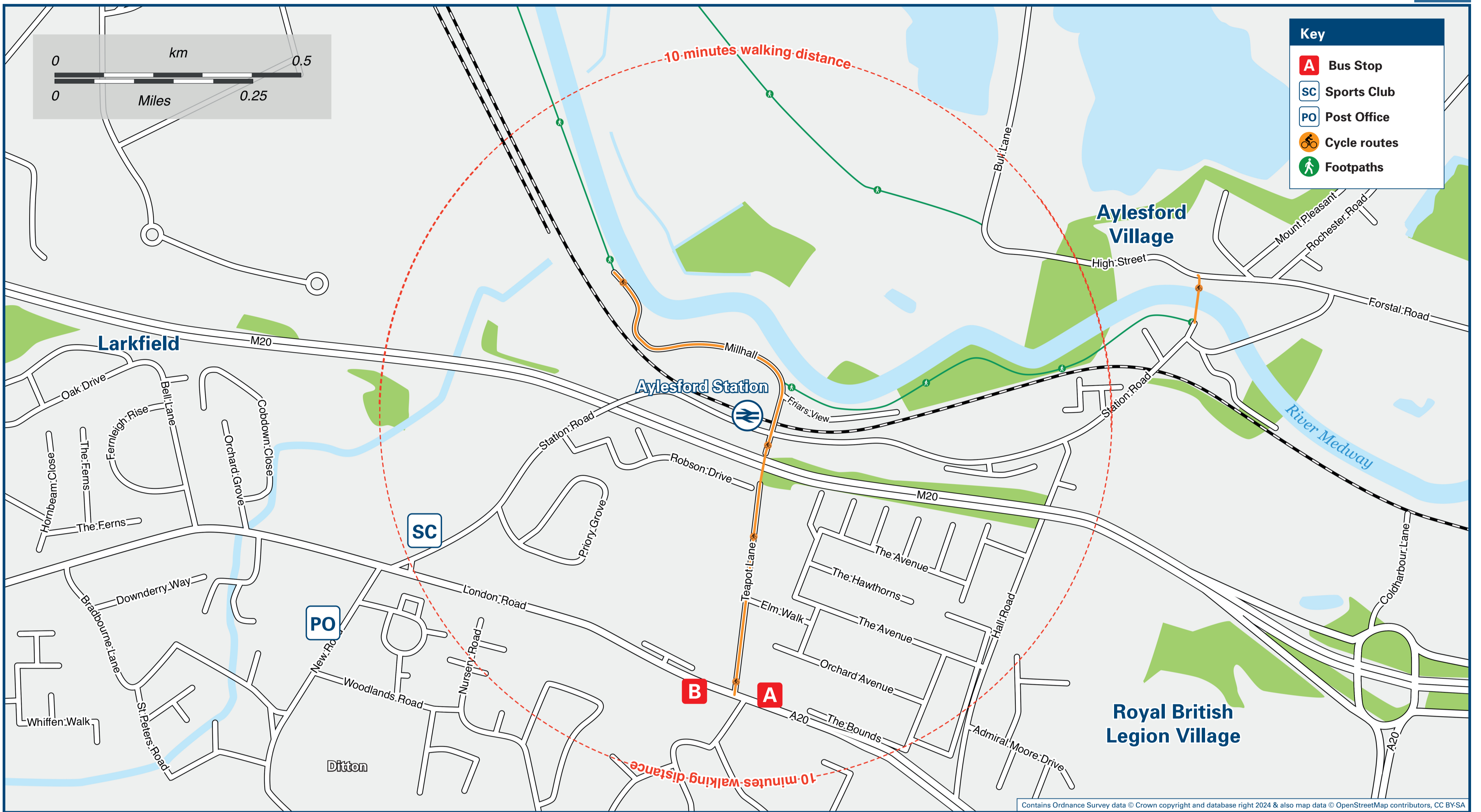




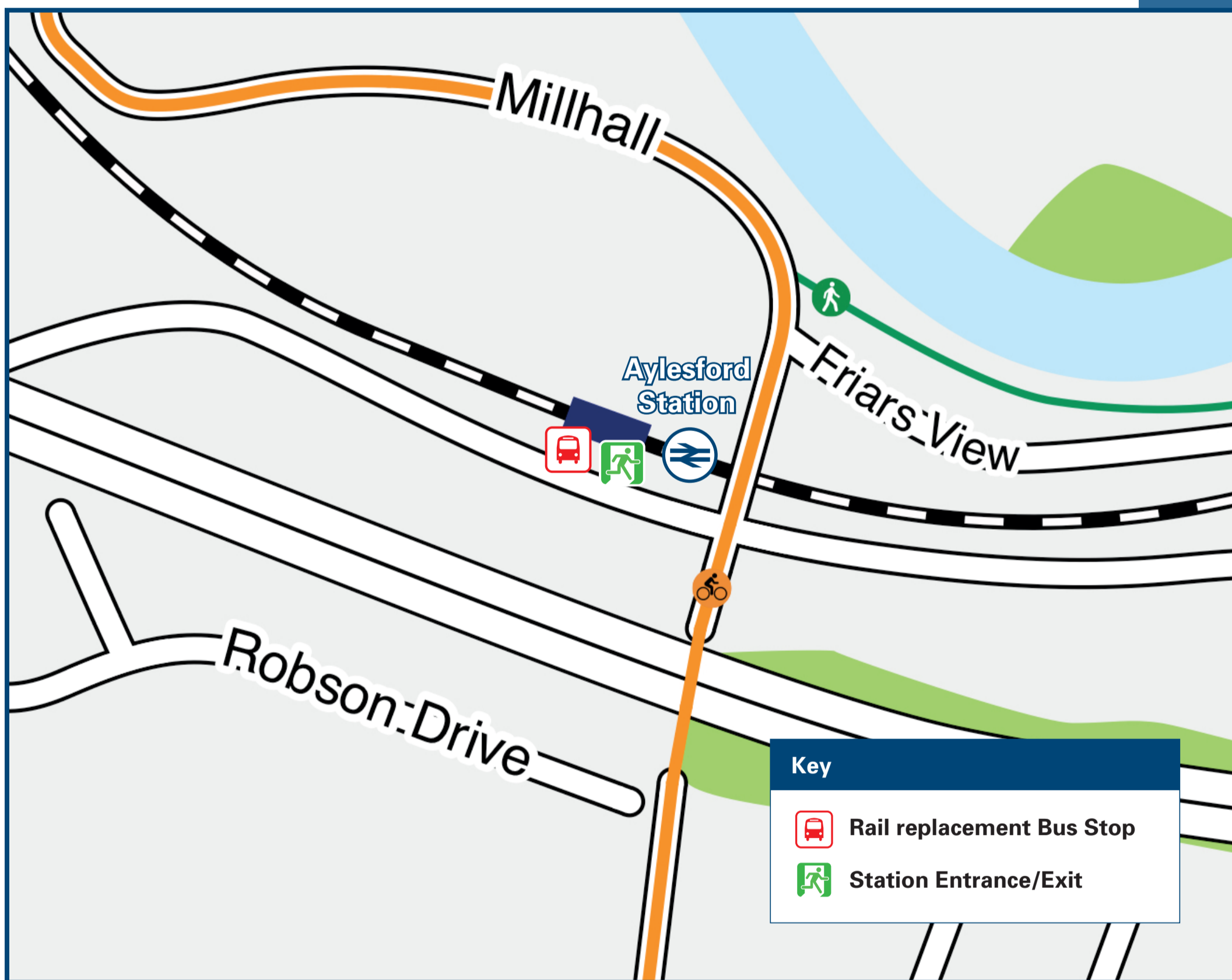

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING AYLESFORD RAILWAY STATION

 Bus route 71 operates daily.  
 Bus route 72 operates Mondays to Saturdays only.
