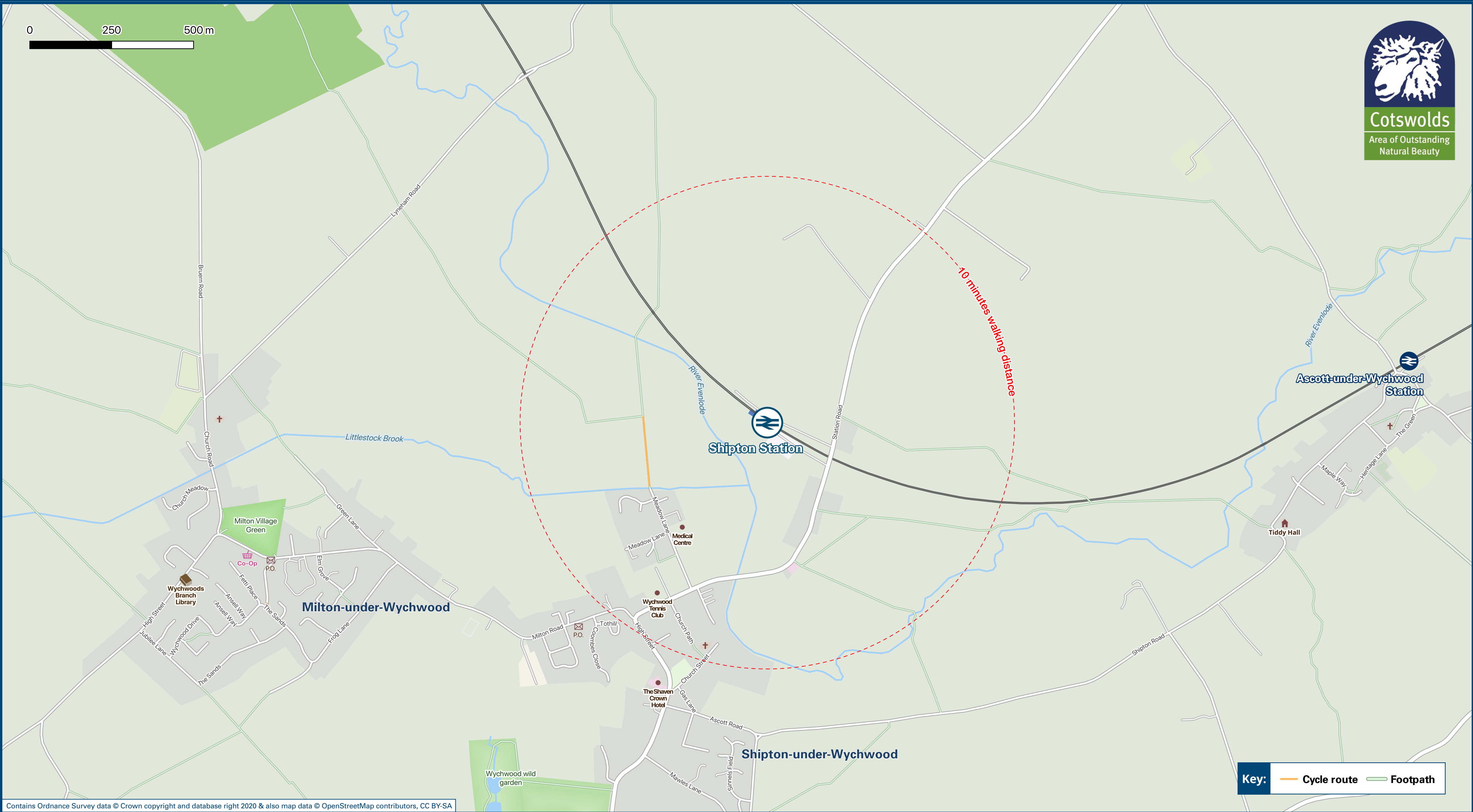




# Shipton Station
