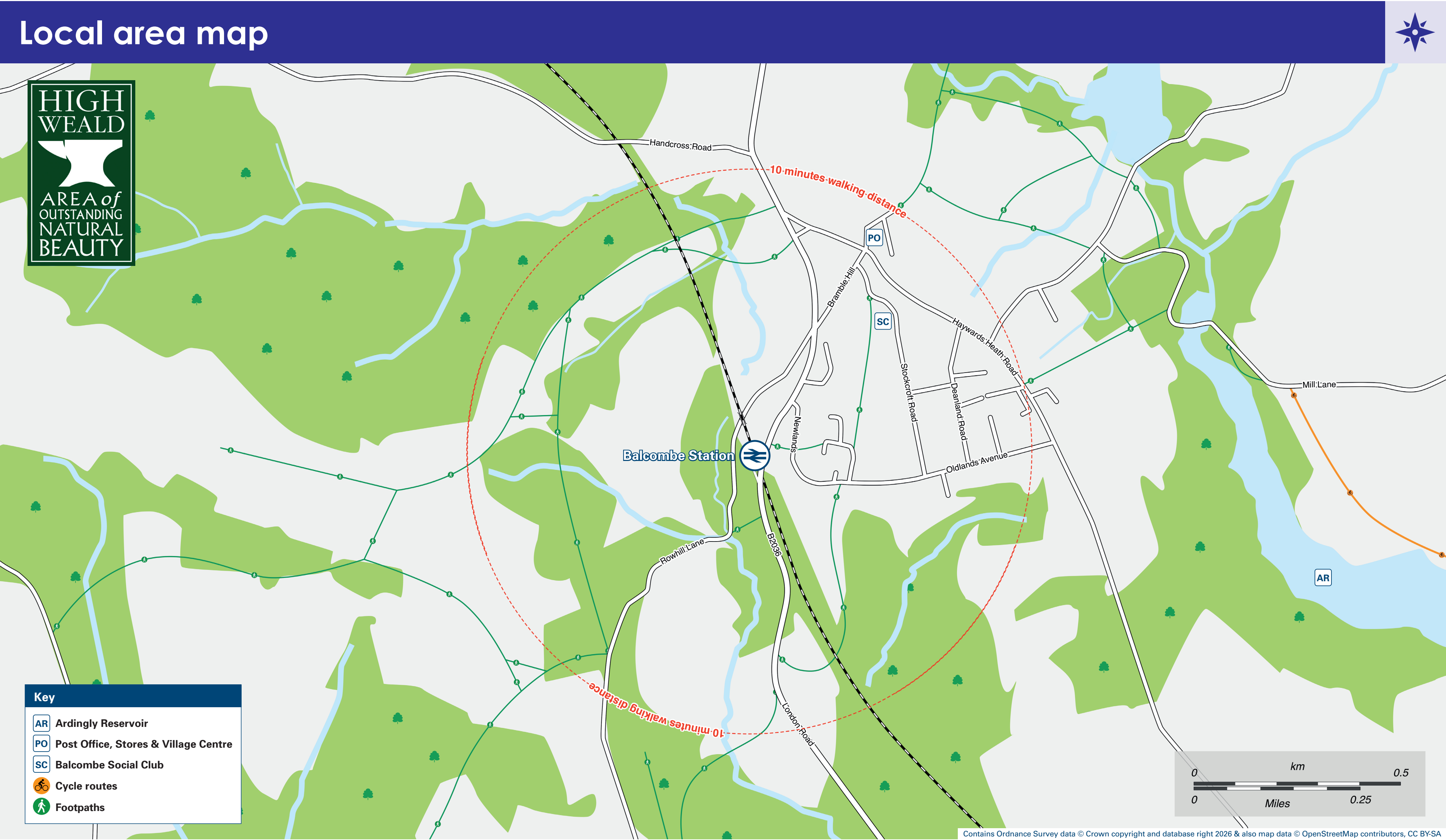




Onward Travel Information

Rail replacement buses towards Haywards Heath will depart from London Road (stop unmarked); towards Three Bridges buses will depart from London Road (stop unmarked). From stop A towards Three Bridges; and from opposite the station at unmarked public bus stop B towards Haywards Heath.

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING THIS RAILWAY STATION.

Bus route 62 runs a very limited daytime Mondays to Fridays service, only. Calling at Pound Hill, Three Bridges Station and Crawley Bus Station; and to Whitemans Green, Cuckfield, Haywards Heath, Princess Royal Hospital and Franklands (Reed Pond Walk).
