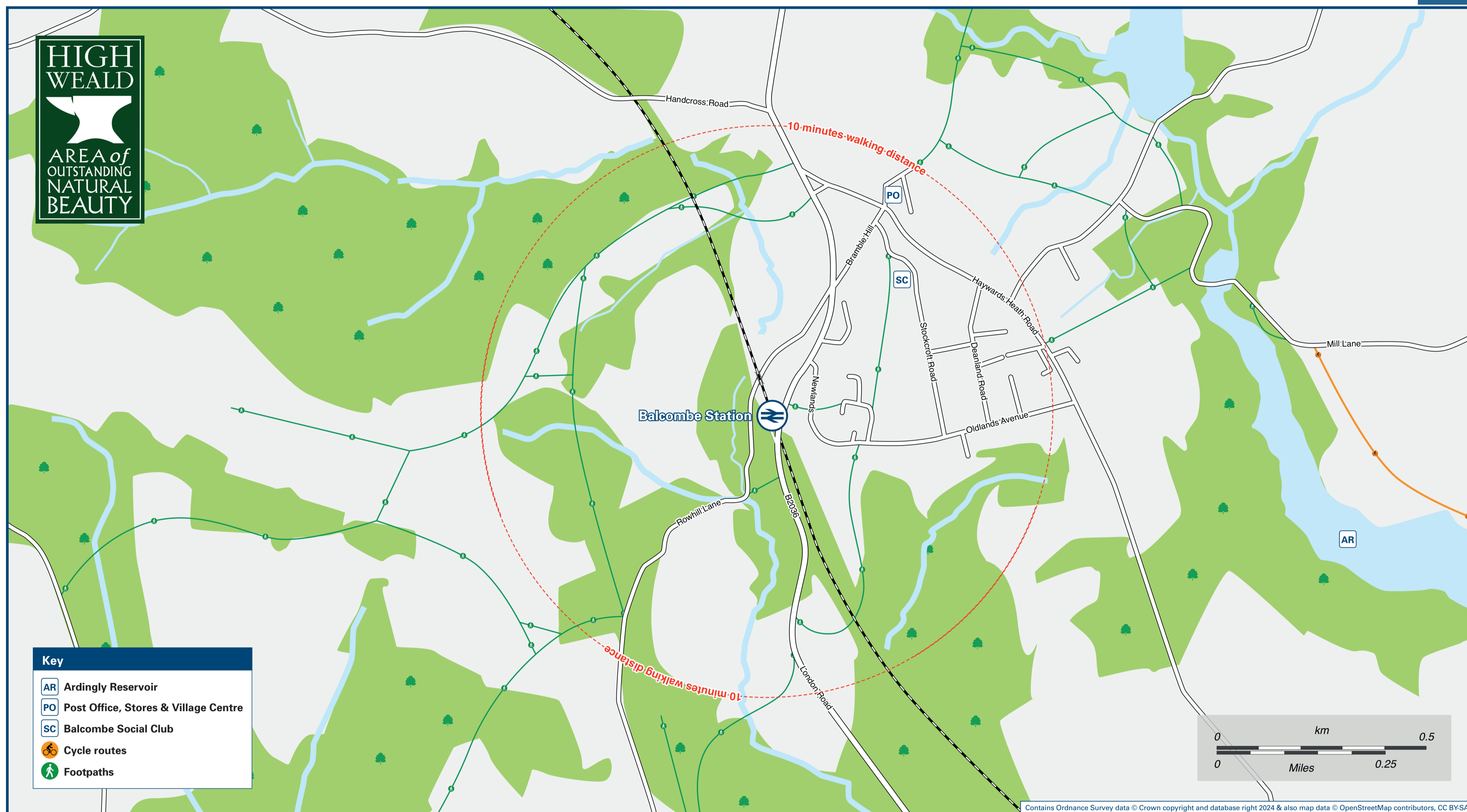




# Balcombe Station

Rail replacement buses will depart from bus stops outside this station, from stop {A} towards Three Bridges; and from opposite the station at unmarked public bus stop {B} towards Haywards Heath.

### Local Bus Information:

Bus route 62 runs a limited bus service Mondays to Fridays only from this station at the following times:

Mondays to Fridays from stop **A** at 08:58 to Balcombe village (Half Moon & The Cowdray Arms), Pound Hill, Three Bridges and Crawley

Mondays to Fridays from stop **B** at 08:18 & 15:07 to Cuckfield High Street.

Tuesdays and Thursdays only from stop **B** at 09:07, 11:23 & 13:38 to Whitmans Green, Cuckfield, Haywards Heath, Princess Royal Hospital and Franklands (Reed Pond Walk).

Tuesdays and Thursdays only from stop **A** at 10:09 & 12:24 to Balcombe village, Pound Hill, Three Bridges and Crawley.

Tuesdays and Thursdays only from stop **A** at 14:39 to Balcombe village (Half Moon)

Schooldays only from stop **B** at 08:18 to Cuckfield Warden Park School.

Schooldays only from stop **A** and at 15:27 to Balcombe village (Half Moon & The Cowdray Arms).
