JustGo North Lincs is an on-demand bus service for people travelling in North Lincolnshire (but not between any two points within Scunthorpe) and is available 7am-7pm Mondays to Fridays and 8am-6pm on Saturdays. To book download the JustGo App on the Apple Store or Google Play or by calling 01482 59 29 59.

Bus routes 96, 260 and 455 run Mondays to Fridays only.

Bus route 250 runs Mondays to Saturdays. No service on Sundays or Bank Holidays.

Bus route 350 runs daily, Mondays to Sundays.

Direct trains operate to this destination from Barton-on- Humber Station.

* Limited journey only, please check timetable for times.

From the 19th of February, 2024, bus route 260 will additionally call at East Halton, North Killingholme, South Killingholme and Immingham (2 trips per day) The remainder of the bus route will remain the same, calling-at: Barrow Upon Humber, Goxhill and New Holland (with frequency reduced)
