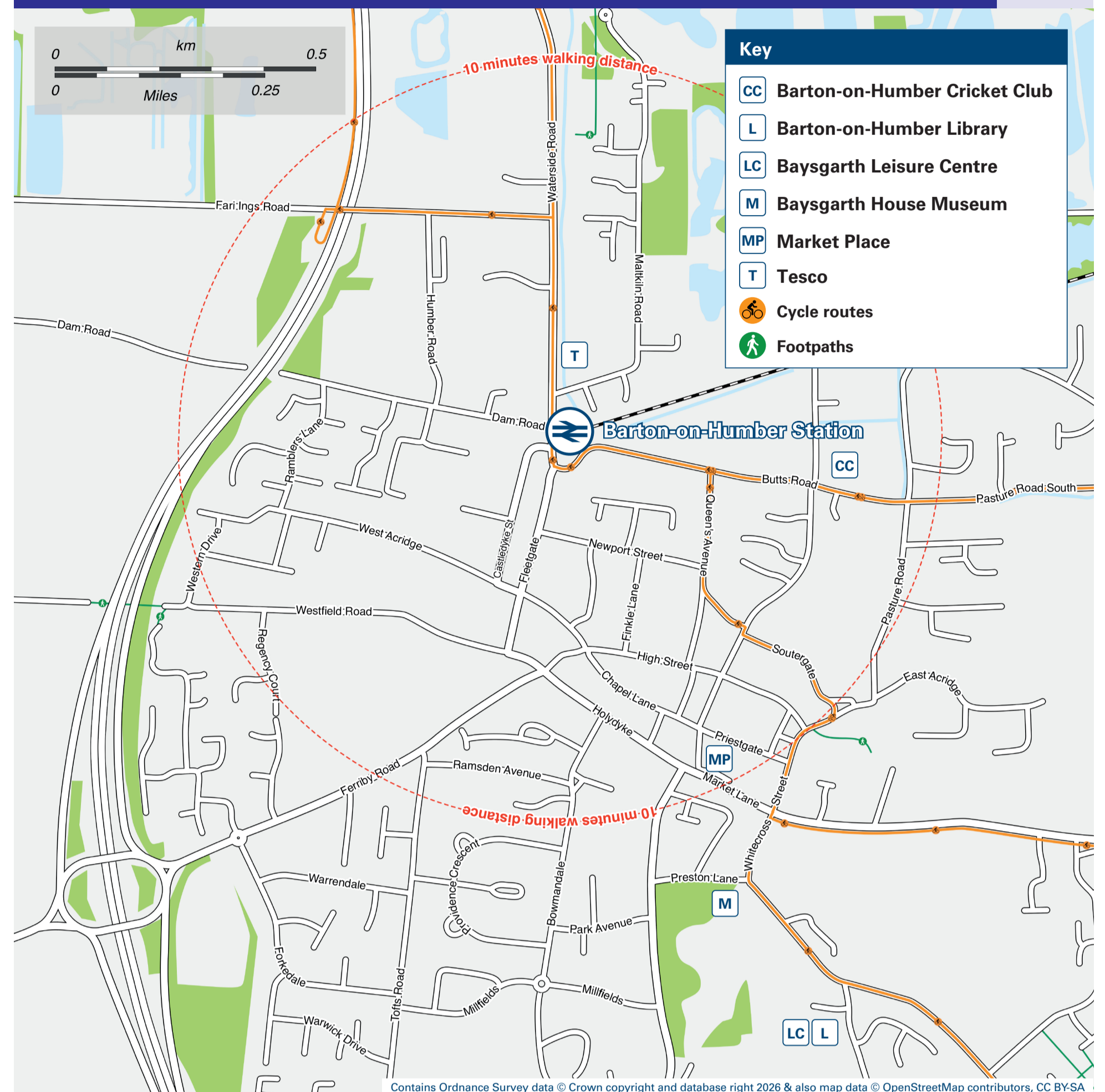
## Barton-On-Humber Station
