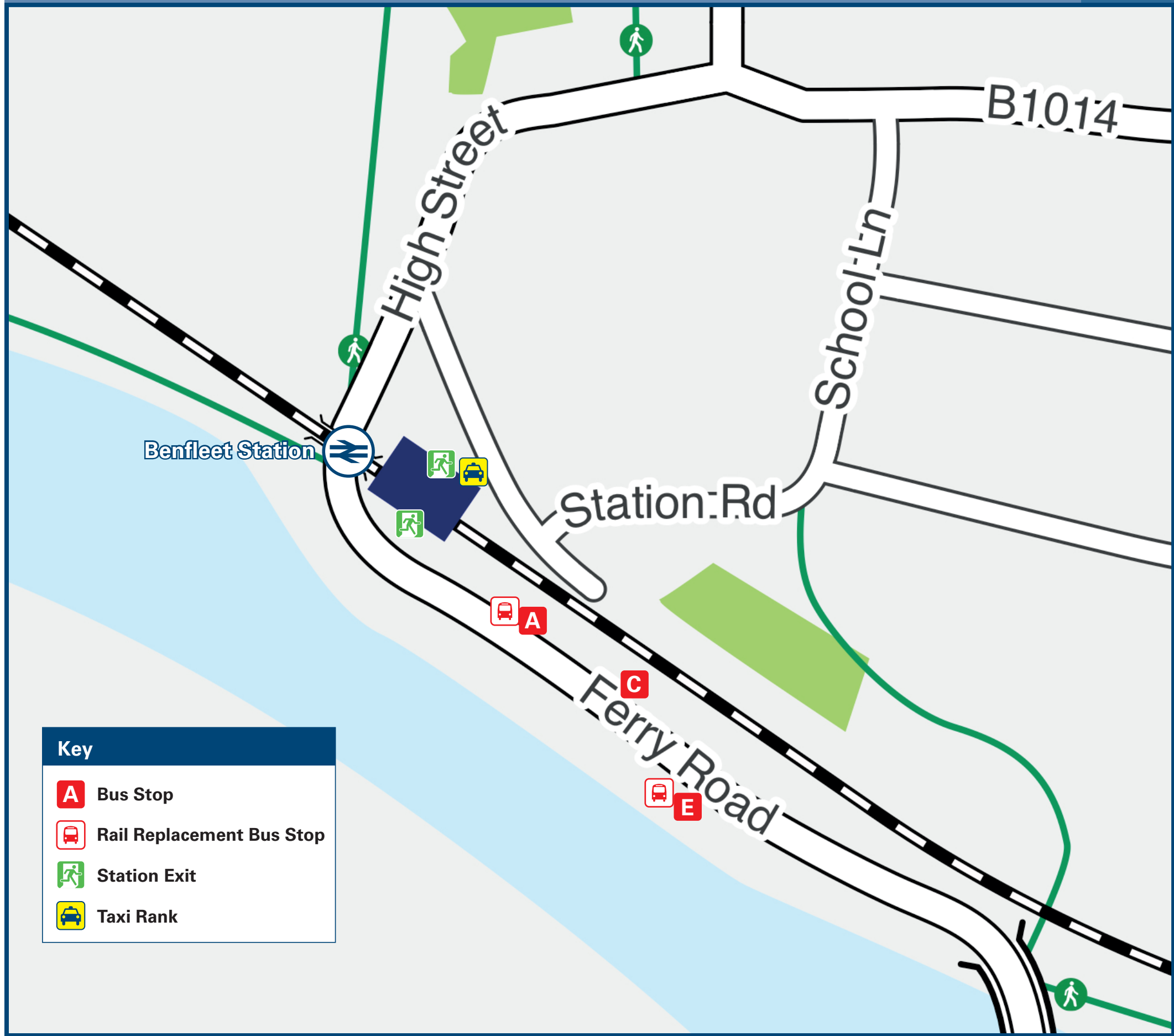




# Benfleet Station
