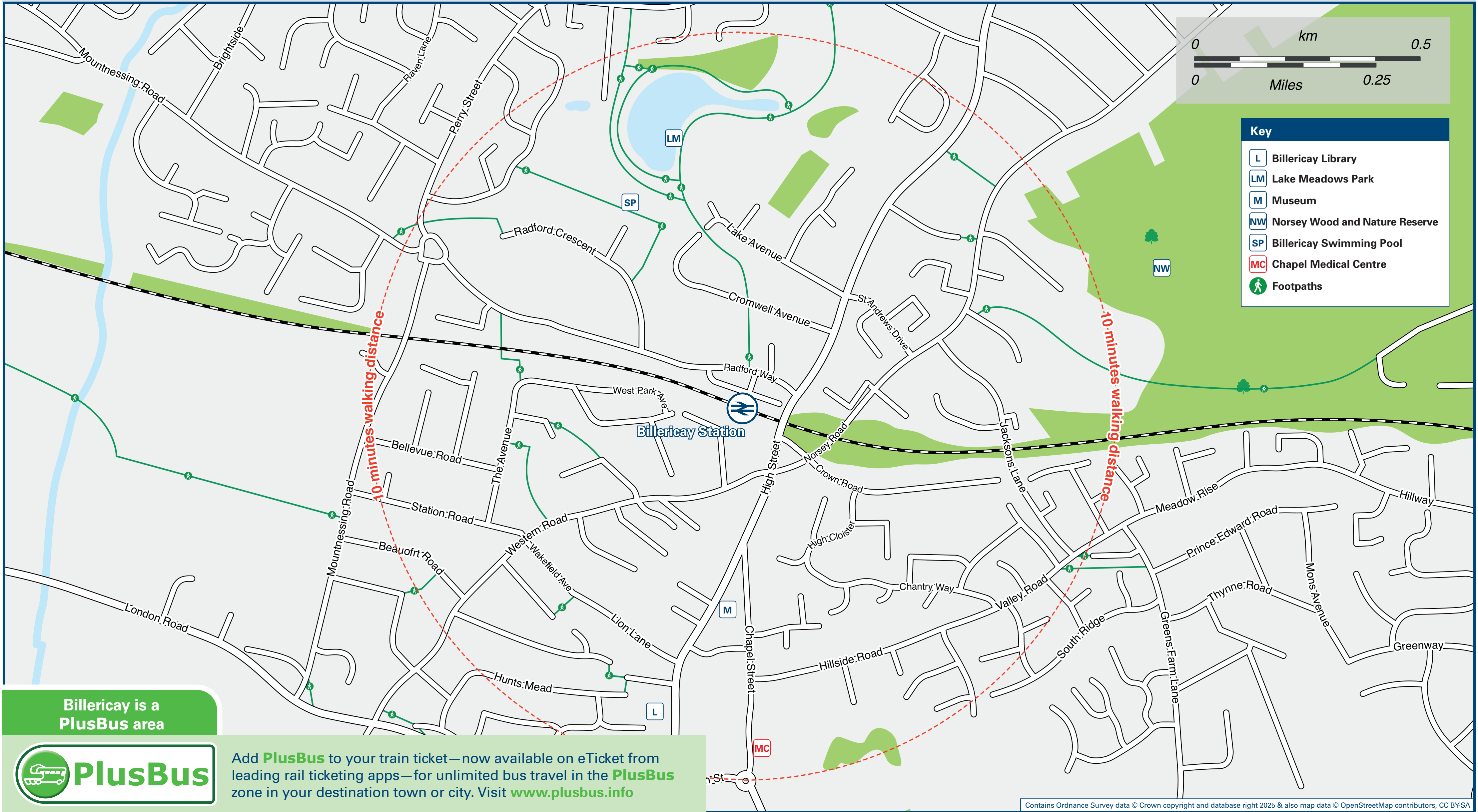

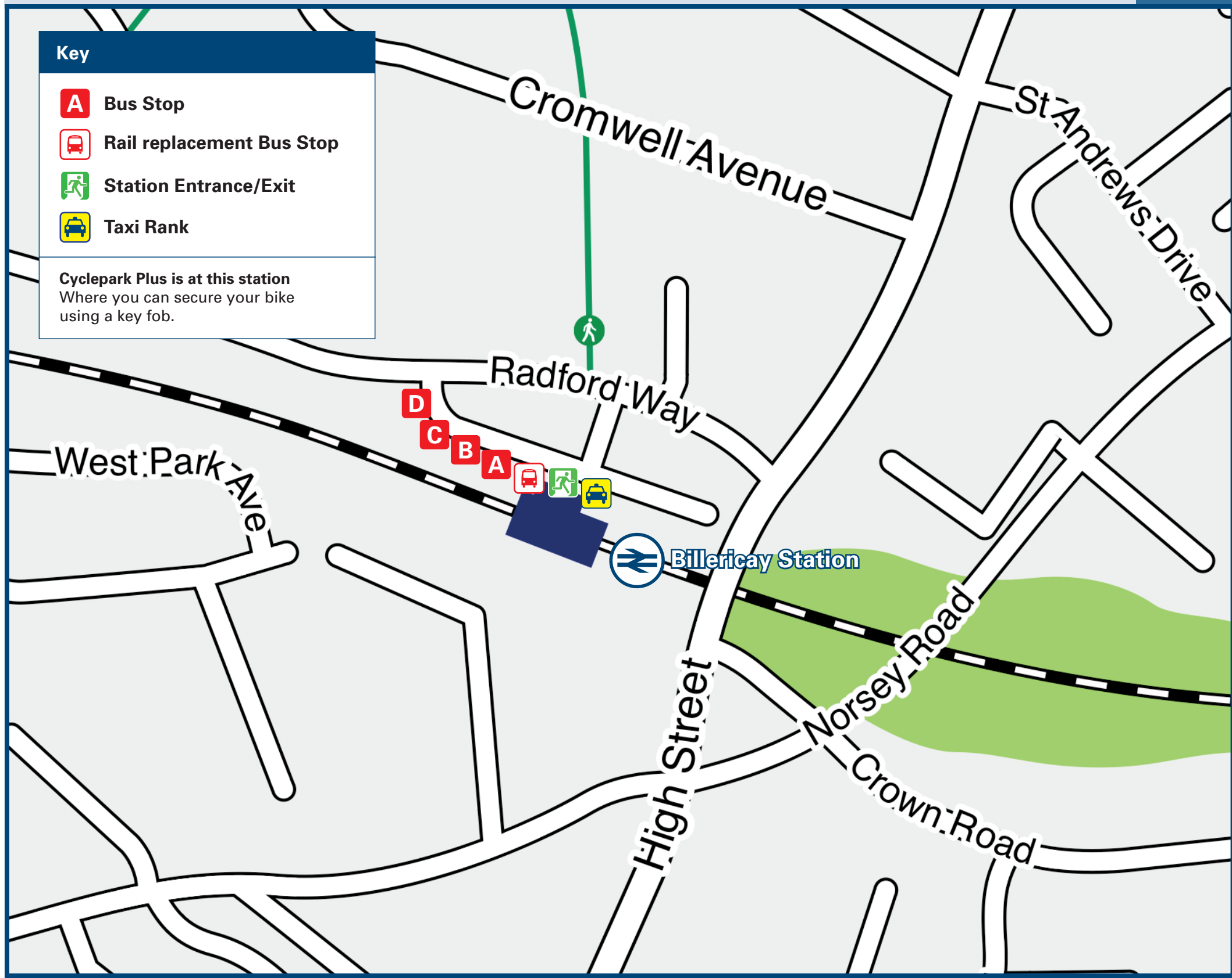
Local area map
