



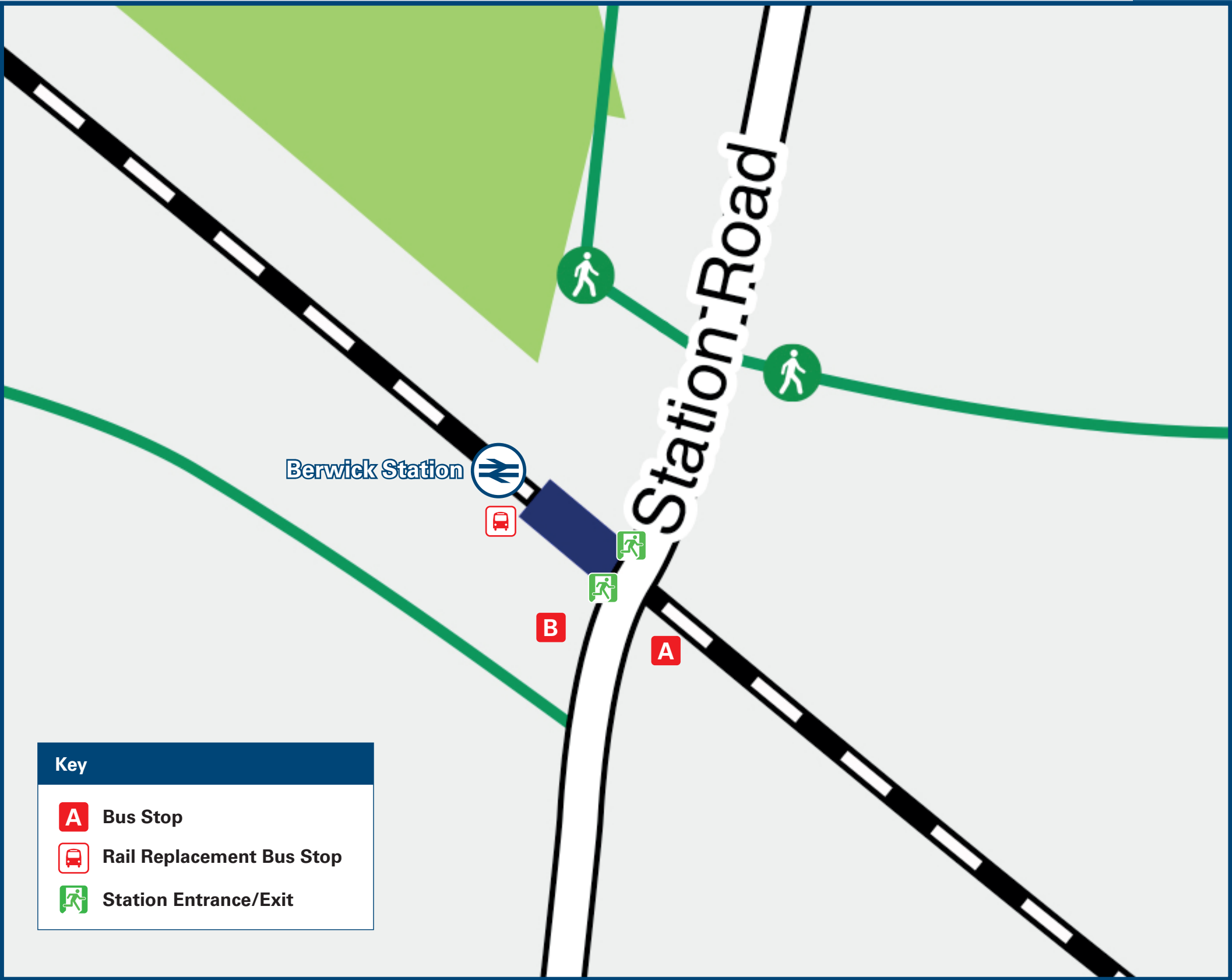

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES AVAILABLE FROM BERWICK RAILWAY STATION.

Bus Information from Berwick Railway Station:

Flexibus is an on-demand bus service that operates in this area which must be booked in advance. For more information call 01273 078 203 or visit www.eastsussex.gov.uk/roads-transport/public/flexibus

Bus route 25 runs a very limited Saturdays only service to Berwick Village, Selmeston, Firle, Glynde, Ringmer and Lewes.

Bus route 26 runs a very limited Sundays and Bank Holidays only service to Wilmington, Polegate and Eastbourne.

Bus route 36 runs a very limited Saturdays only service to Langney Shopping Centre, Pevensey Bay and Beachlands.

Bus route 40 runs a very limited Tuesdays and Fridays mornings service to Wilmington, Litlington, Seven Sisters Park Centre and Seaford.

Bus route 42 runs a very limited Wednesdays service to Hailsham.

Bus route 43 runs a very limited Mondays service to Langney Shopping Centre and Eastbourne.

Bus route 44 runs a very limited Tuesdays service to Langney Shopping Centre and Eastbourne

Bus route 44A runs a very limited Thursdays service to Langney Shopping Centre and Eastbourne

Bus route 47 (Ramblerbus) runs hourly from 10:00 to 17:00 on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays during British Summer Time to: Drusillas Park Zoo, Alfriston, Seaford, Seven Sisters Park Centre, Friston Forest, Litlington and Wilmington then back to Berwick Station (these buses connect at Berwick station with trains to & from Brighton, Lewes and Eastbourne).

Bus route 126 runs a very limited Mondays to Saturdays service to Berwick (Drusillas Corner), Alfriston and Seaford.

Bus route H1 operates one early morning bus on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays to Hailsham.
