

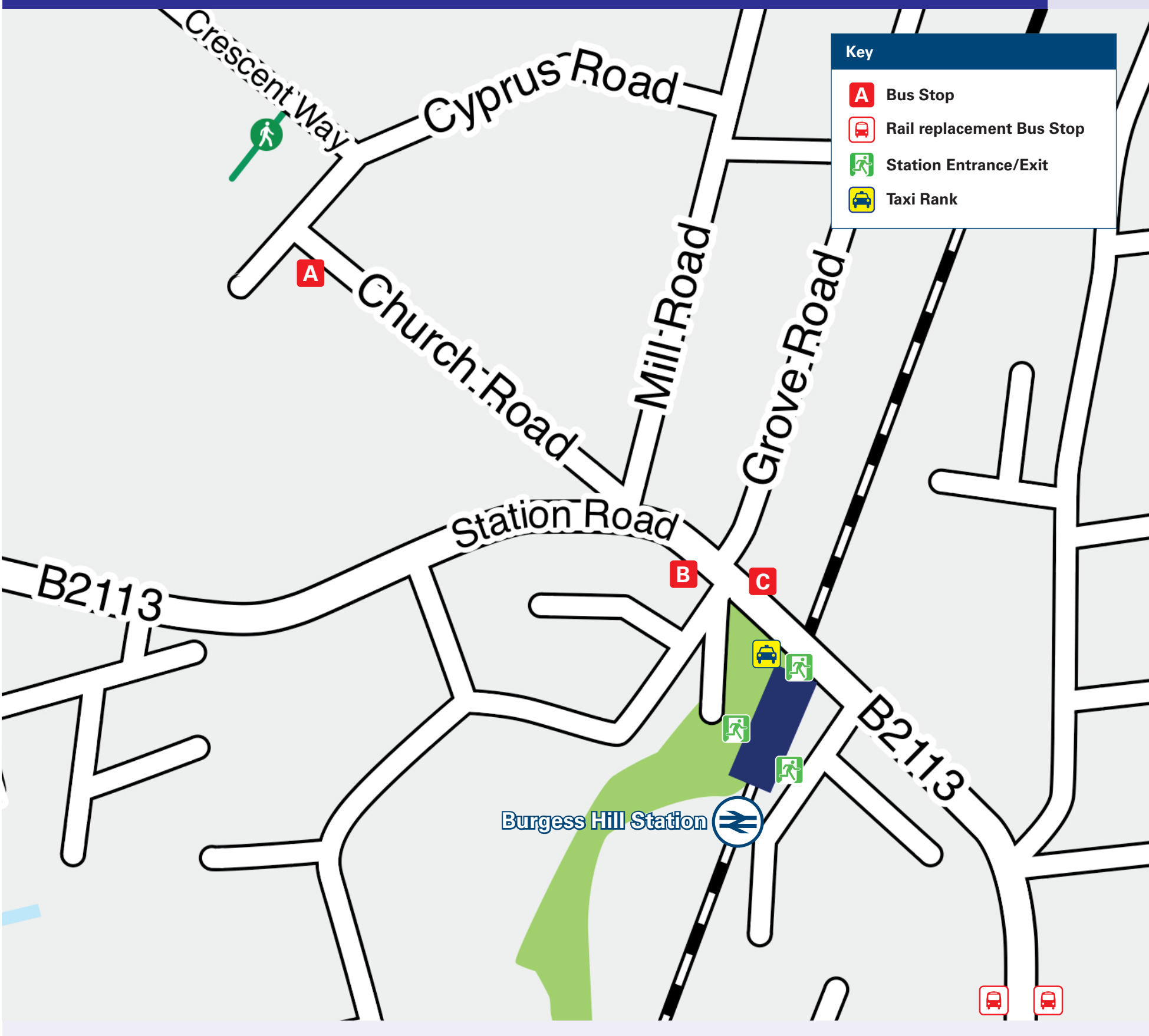

Key

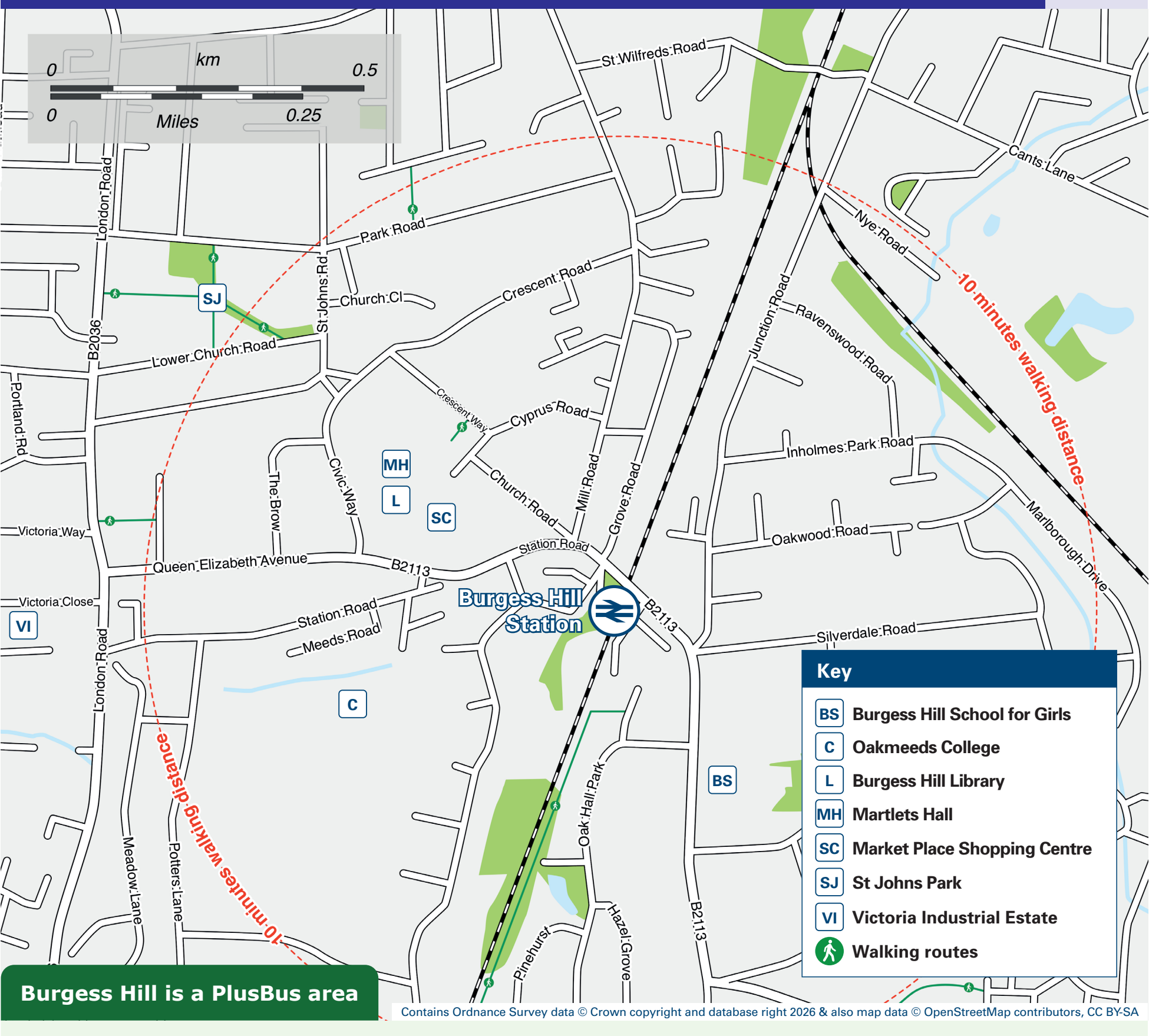

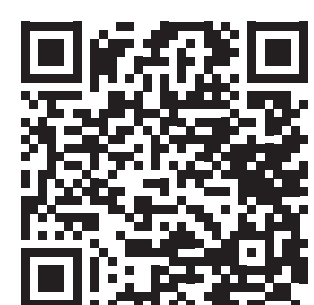
