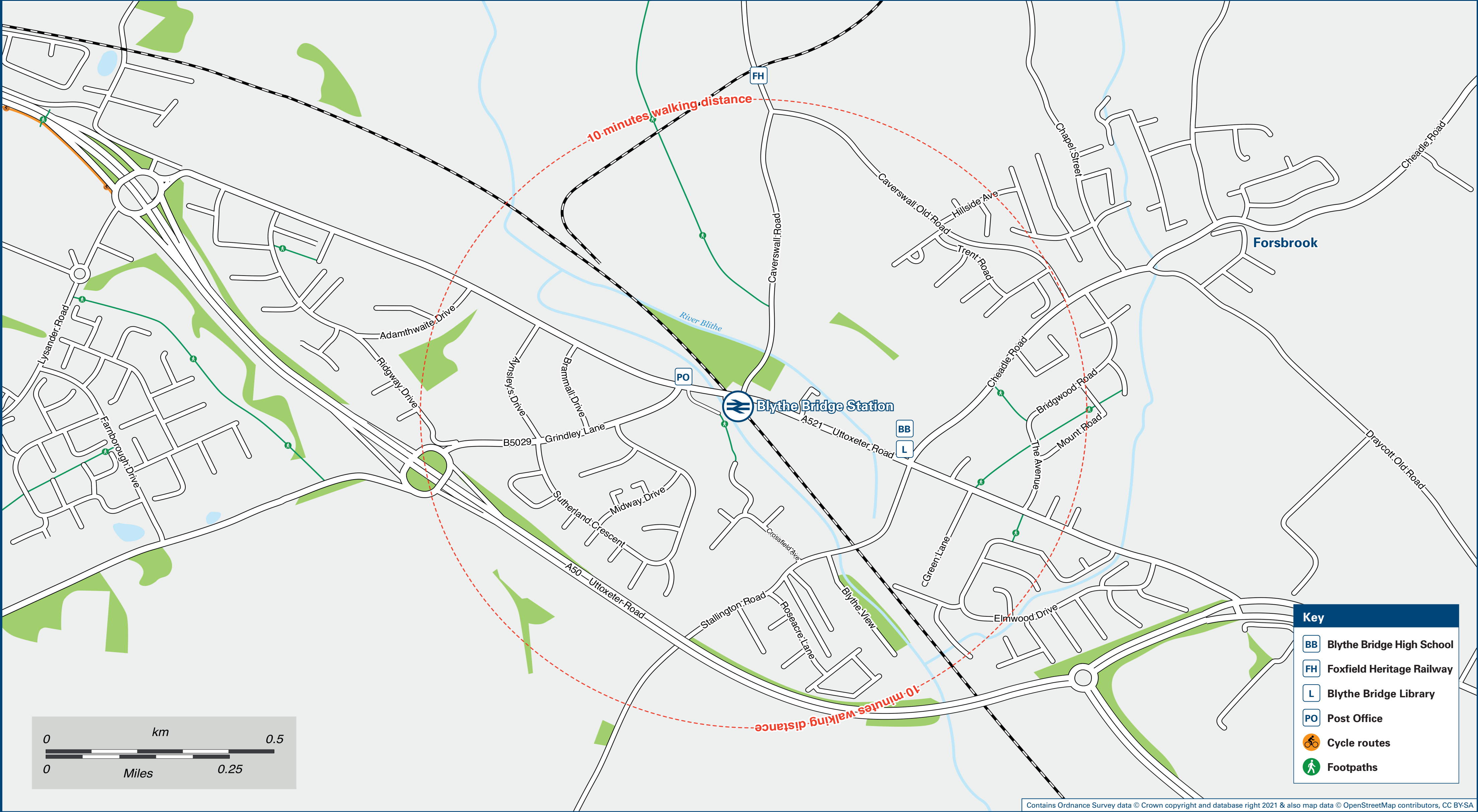




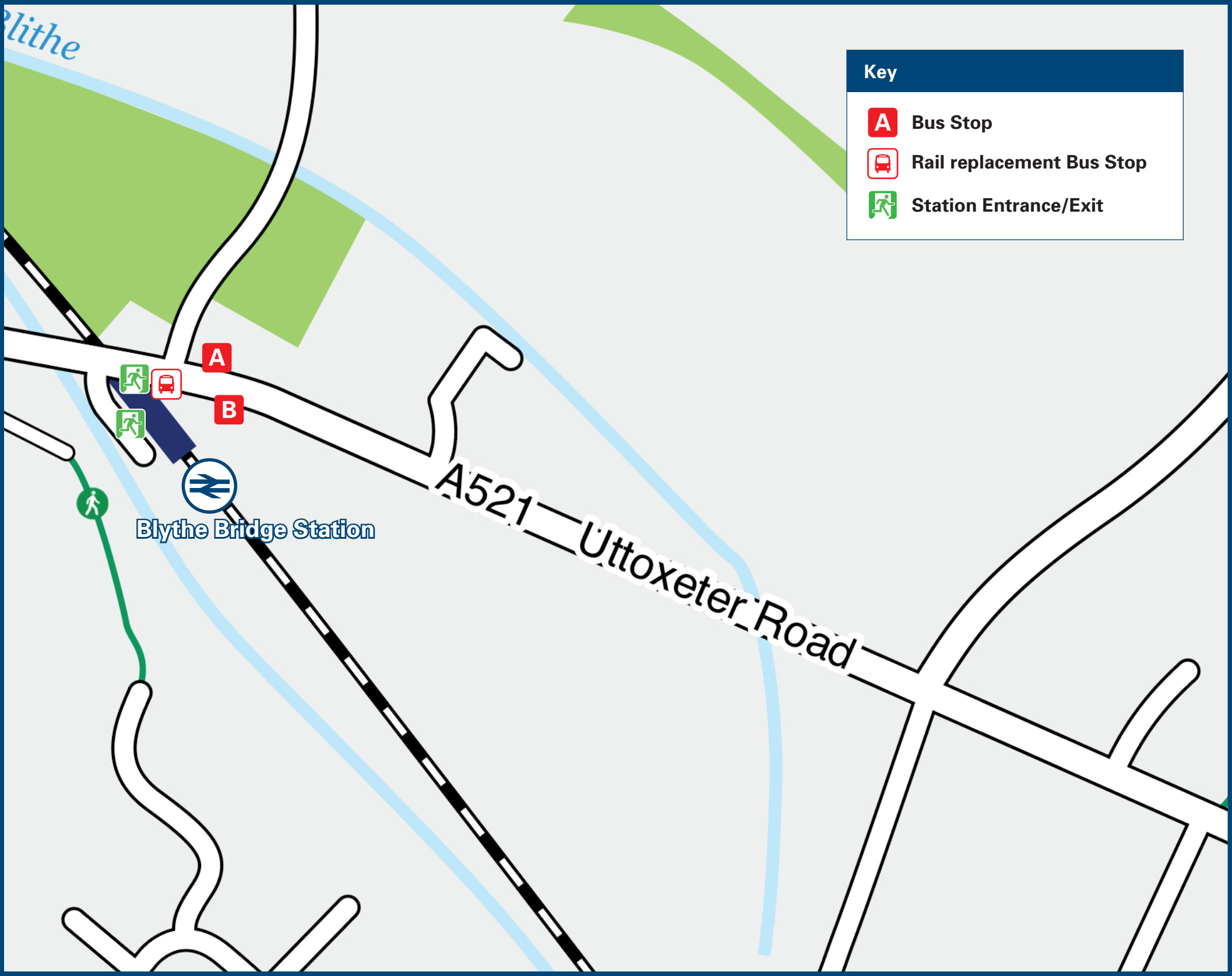
Blythe Bridge Station
