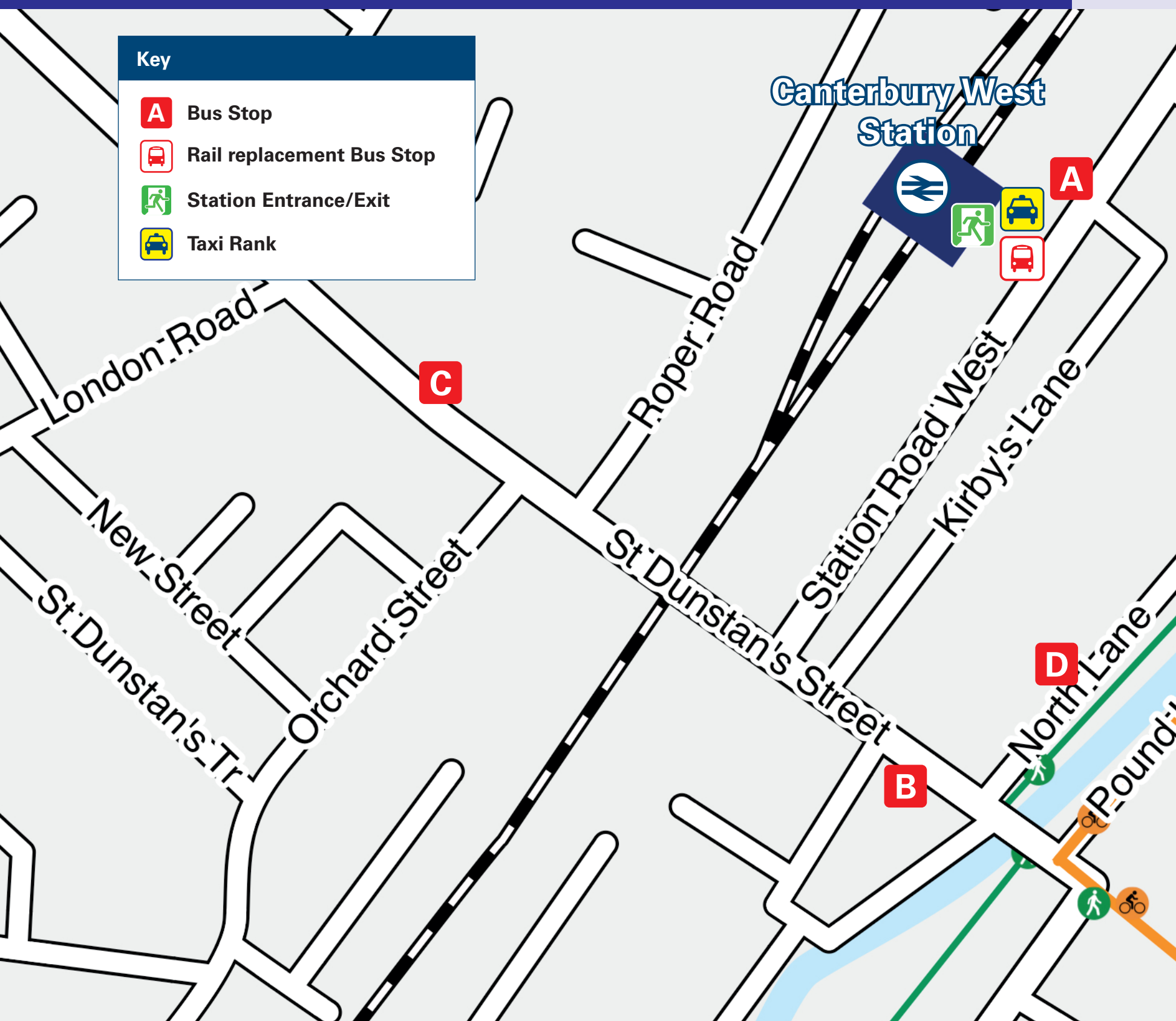

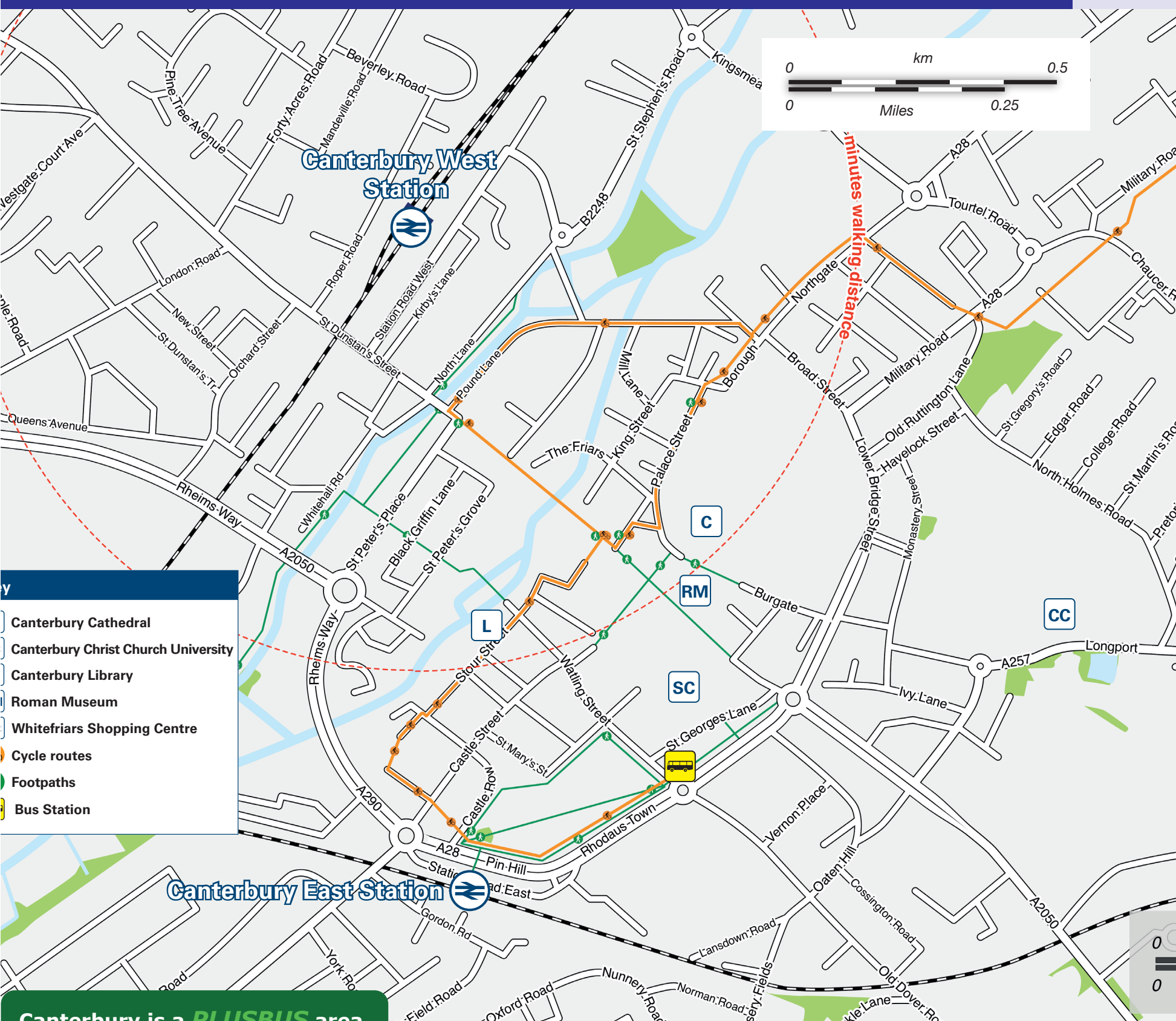

- Bus route Uni1 & Uni2 operate on Mondays to Saturdays, only. No Sunday services.
- Further bus services around Canterbury are available from Canterbury Bus Station, a 20 minutes walk from Canterbury West Railway Station.

- Direct trains operate to this destination from Canterbury East station.
- It's a 15 to 20 minutes walk from this station to Canterbury East Station and Canterbury Bus Station, see Local area map for walking routes.
- # Bus route 21 operates limited daytime services on Mondays to Sundays, only. No evenings service.
- ~ Bus route 400 changes to route 600 at Greenhill to Herne Bay, same bus no need to change.
- ## To this destination bus route 400 operates a mornings and late evenings service Mondays to Saturdays, and an all day service on Sundays.
