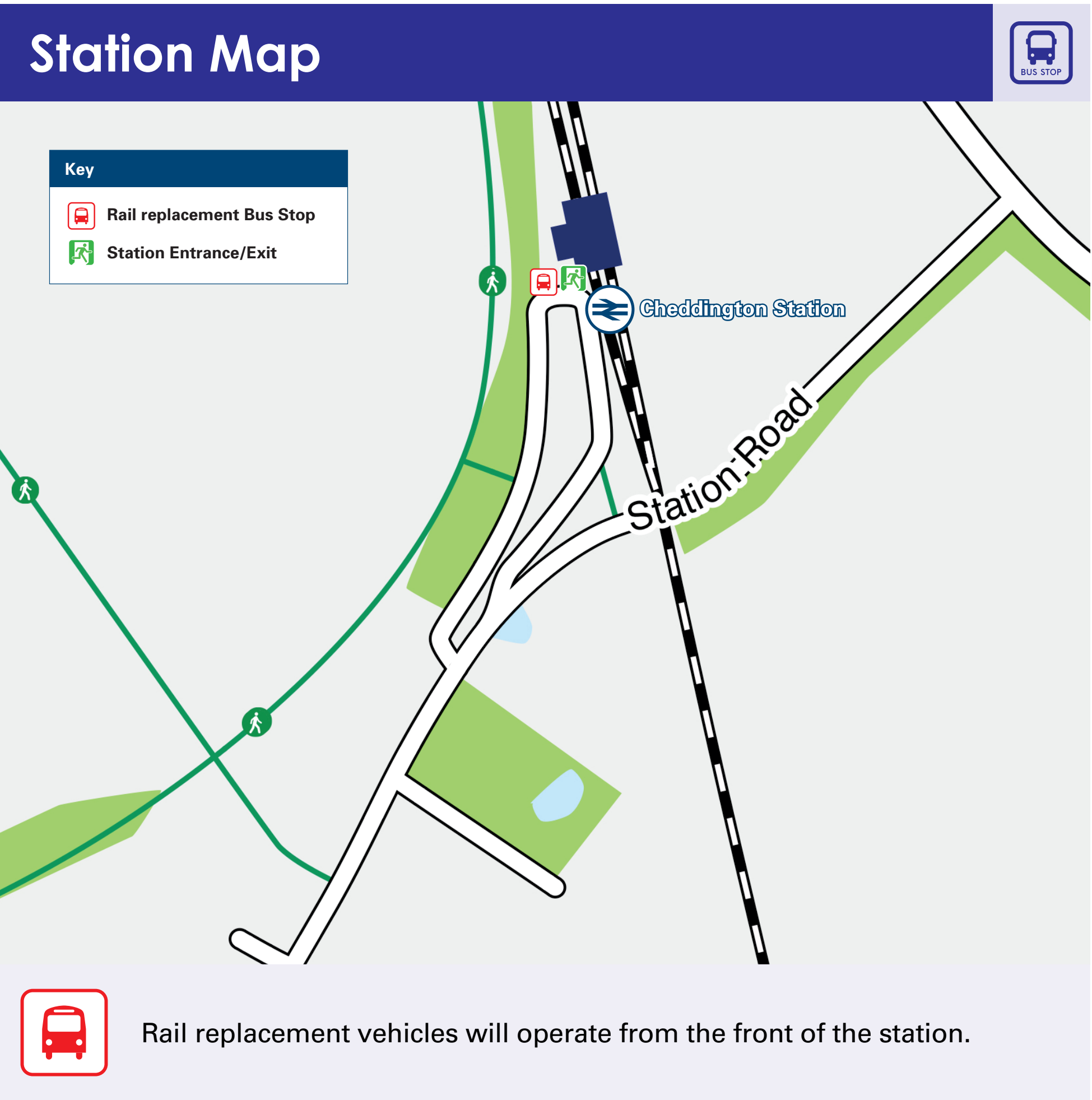
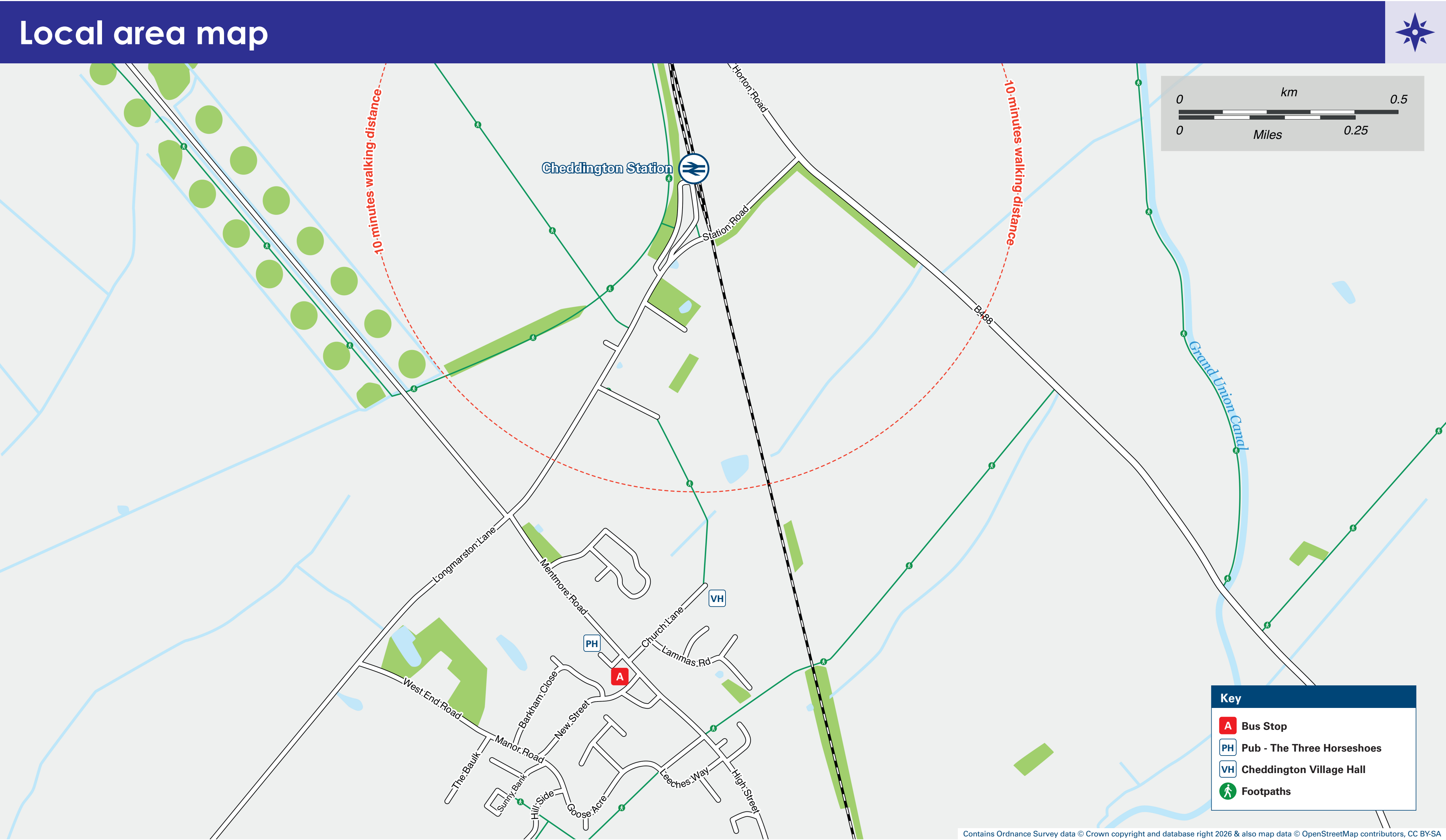

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING CHEDDINGTON RAILWAY STATION

Bus services operate from Cheddington Village bus stops (The Green & the High Street) approximately 20 minutes walk from Cheddington Railway Station.

Bus service 62 operates a service to Pitstone, Marsworth, Tring, Aston Clinton and Aylesbury on Mondays to Saturdays, only. No service on Sundays or Bank Holidays.

Bus service 62A operates a service to Pitstone, New Mill and Tring at 15.30 on Mondays to Fridays, only. No service on Saturdays, Sundays or Bank Holidays.

Bus service 63 operates a limited morning service to Pitstone and Tring, and Tring Railway Station, on Mondays to Fridays, only. No service on afternoons, evenings, Saturdays, Sundays or Bank Holidays.

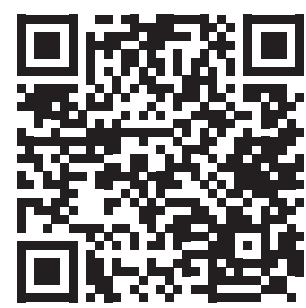
