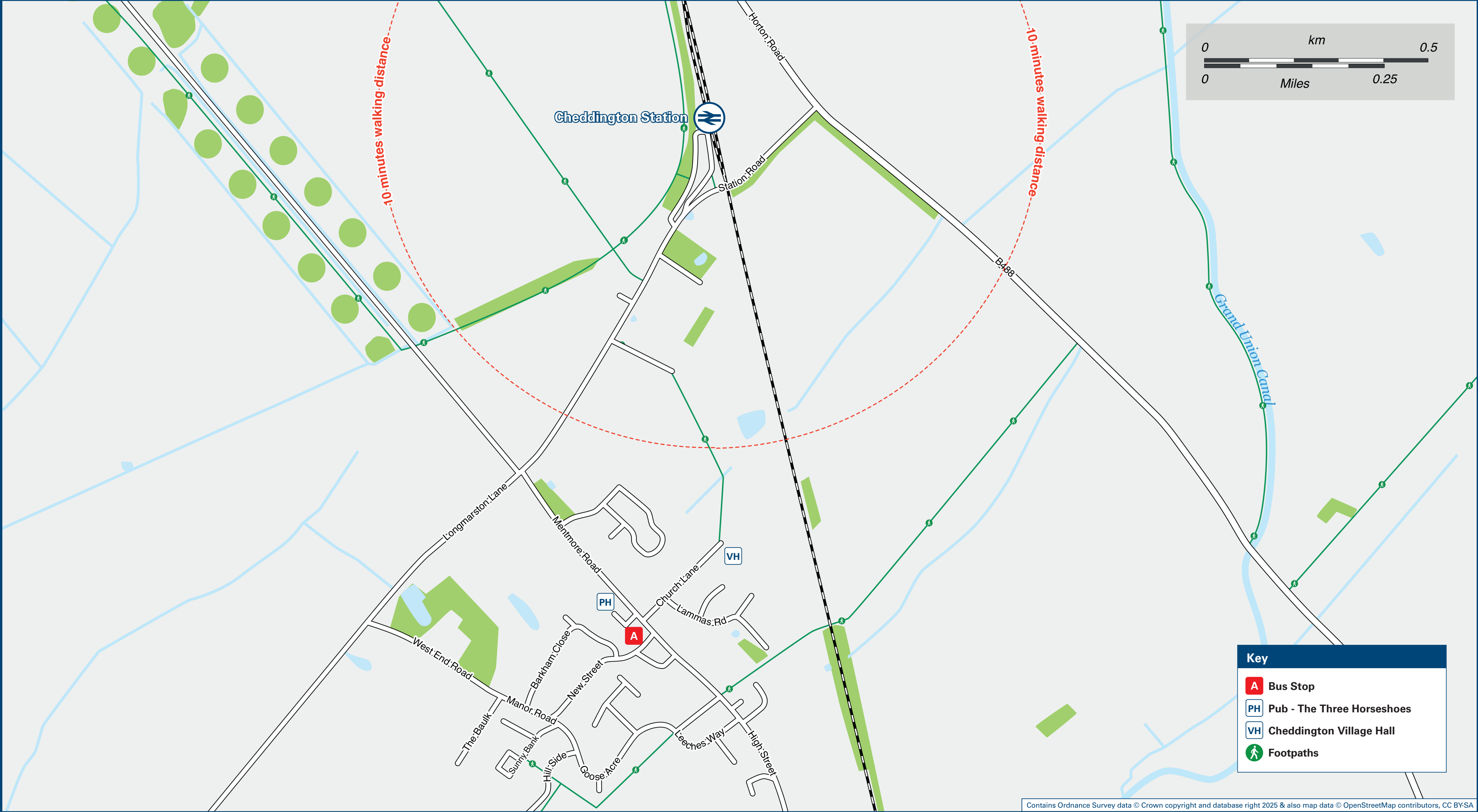




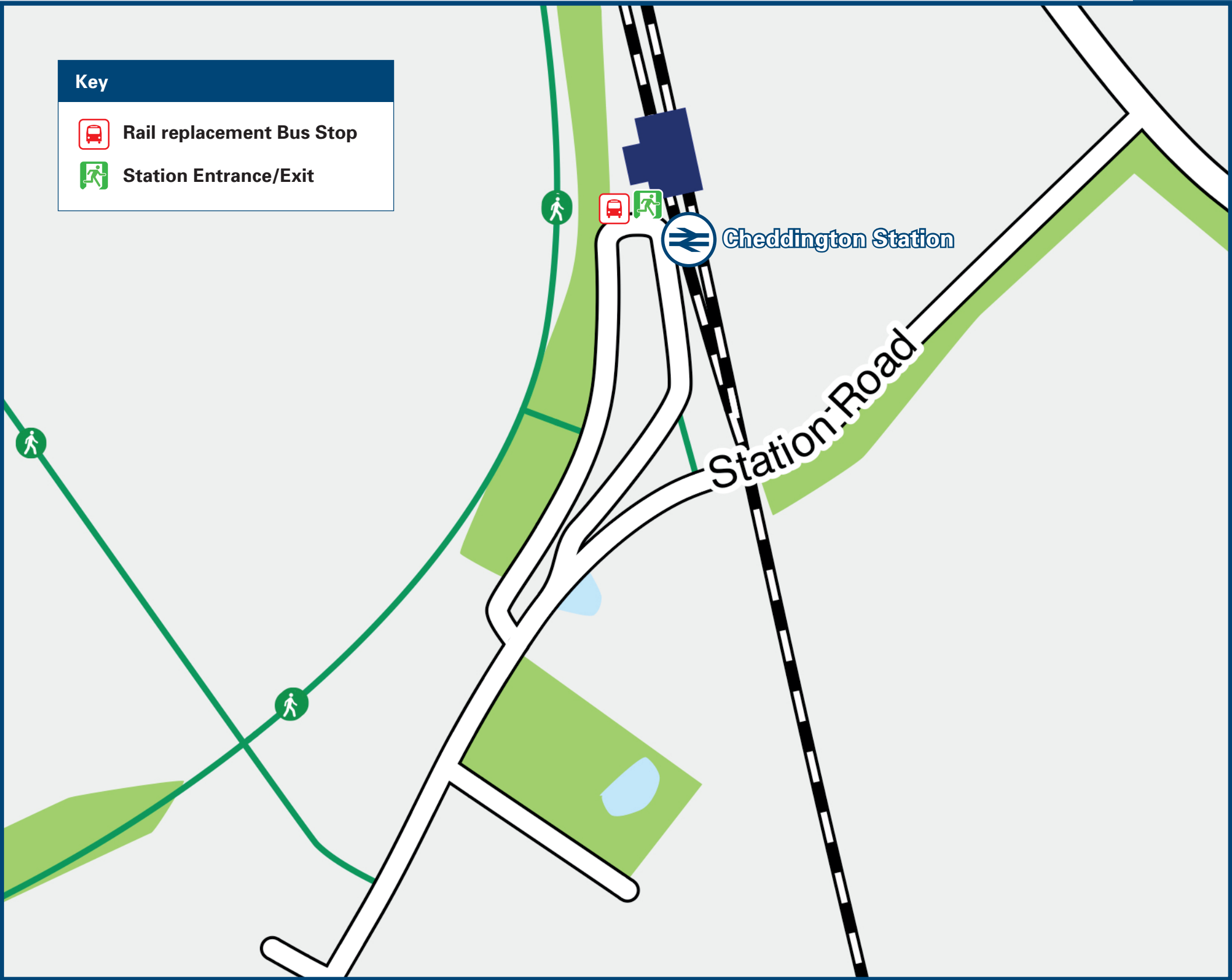
Cheddington Station

Rail replacement vehicles will operate from the junction of Station Road and Bye Road for services to Bletchley. Services to Bedford will operate from the bus stop on Station Road, near the junction with Hudson Close (approximately 120 yards from the level crossing). Please check your destination before boarding.

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING CHEDDINGTON RAILWAY STATION

Bus services operate from Cheddington Village bus stops (The Green & the High Street) approximately 20 minutes walk from Cheddington Railway Station.

Bus service 62 operates to New Mill, Tring, Aston Clinton and Aylesbury, on Mondays to Saturdays, only. No service on Sundays or Bank Holidays.

Bus service 63 operates to Pitstone and Tring, and Tring Railway Station, on Mondays to Fridays, only. No service on Saturdays, Sundays or Bank Holidays.
