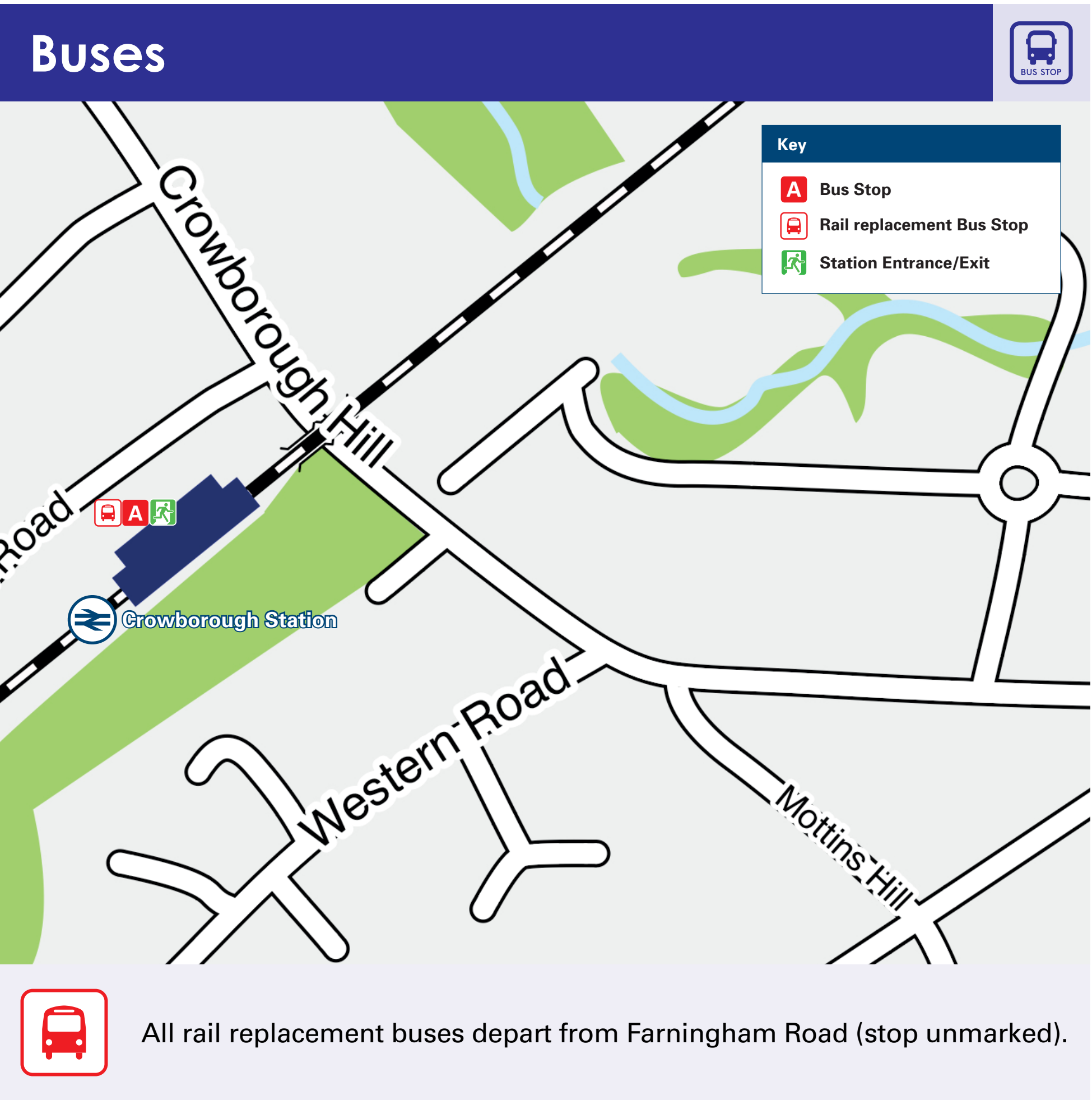
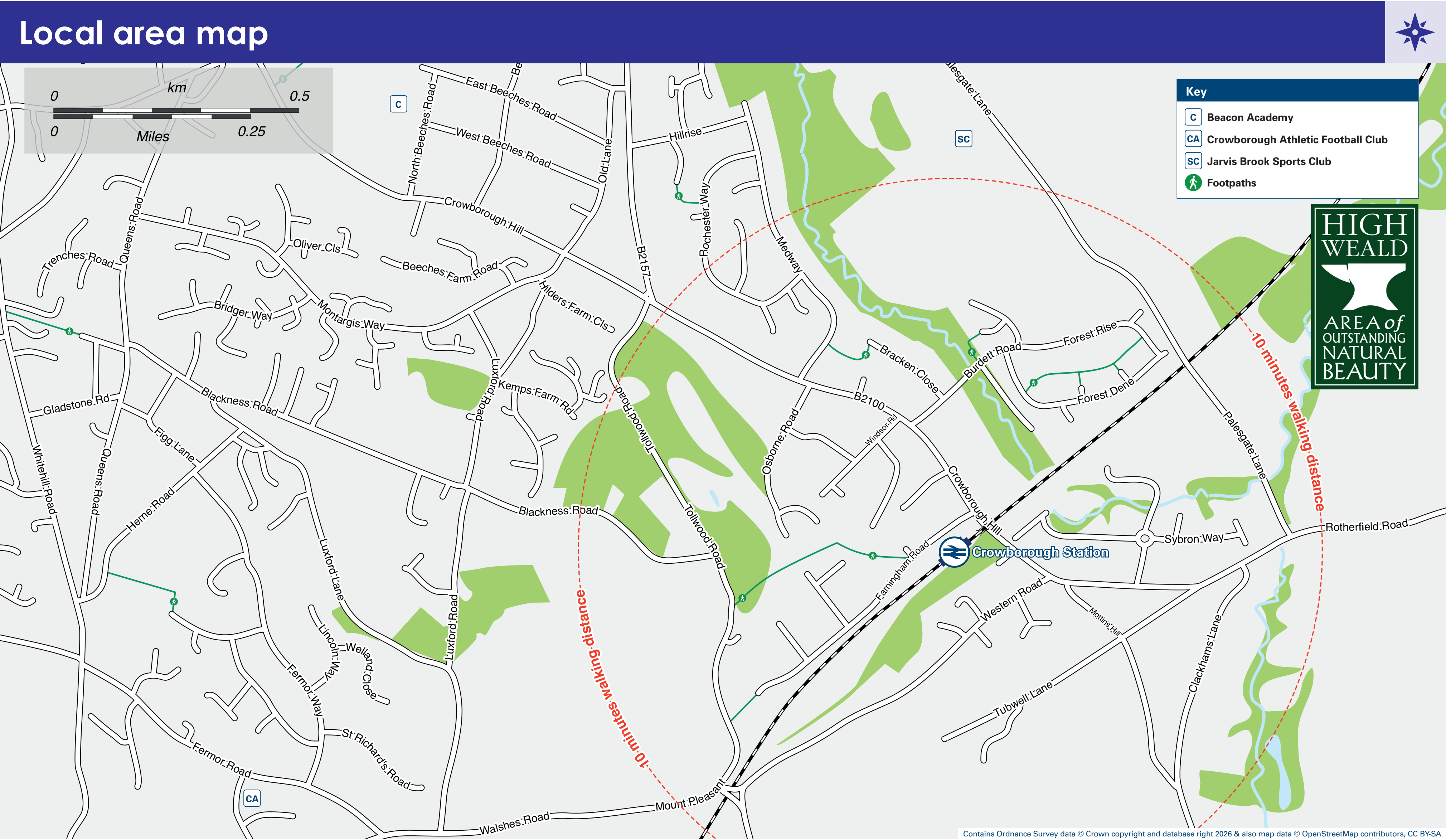




Onward Travel Information

Bus services from Crowborough Railway Station (Stop **A** on the map):

Bus route 224 runs a limited daytime service on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, only, to Crowborough Town Centre, and to Town Row and Wadhurst.

Bus route 228 runs an hourly daytime service on Mondays to Saturdays to most parts of Crowborough including Crowborough Broadway. No Sunday service.

Further bus services run from Crowborough Broadway and Crowborough High Street. From the High Street bus route 29 runs a regular daily service to Eridge, Showfields, Tunbridge Wells, and to Uckfield, Lewes and Brighton.

Flexibus is a local on-demand ride-share service. Call 01273 335080 or scan the QR code for more information and to book.
