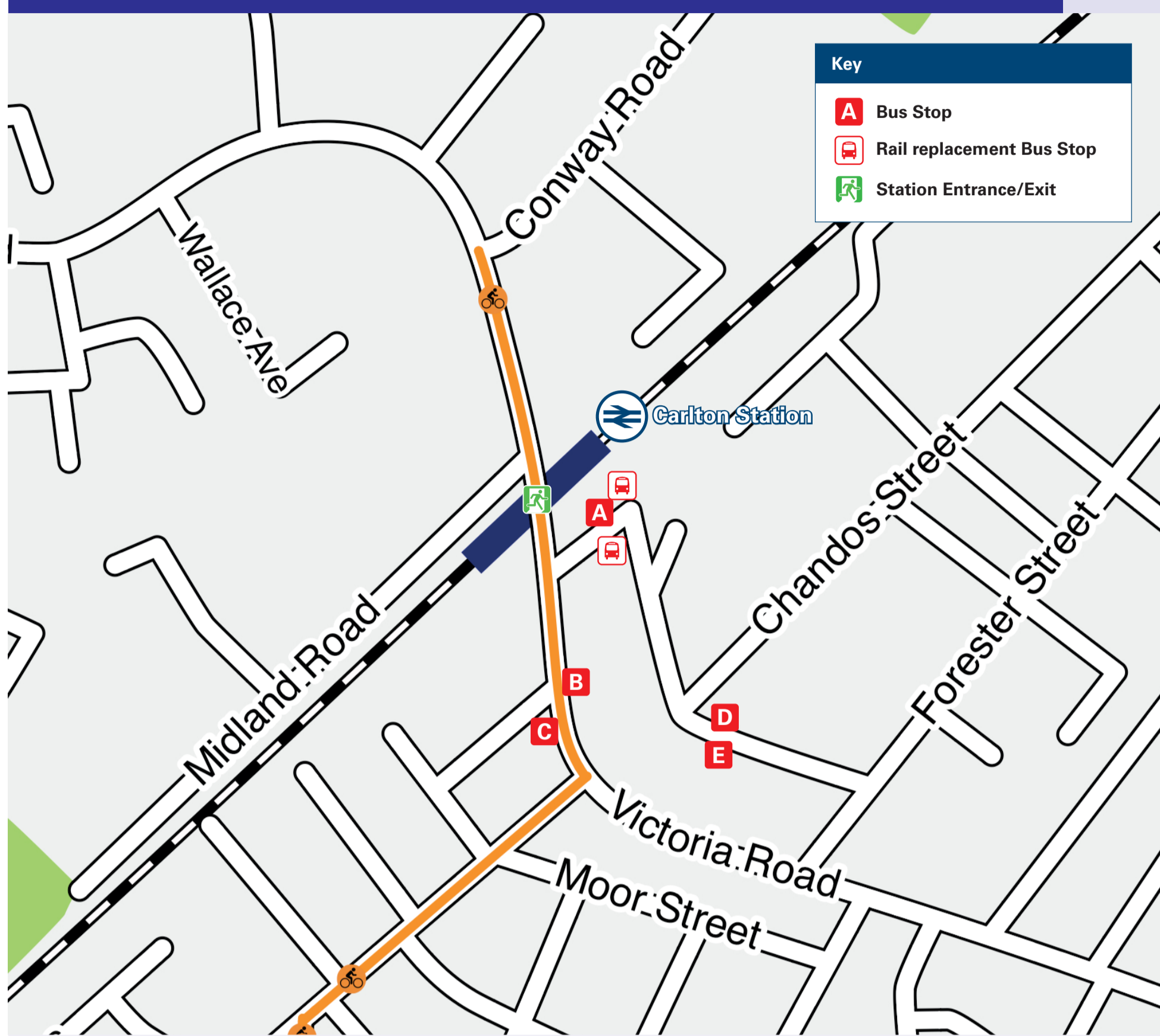

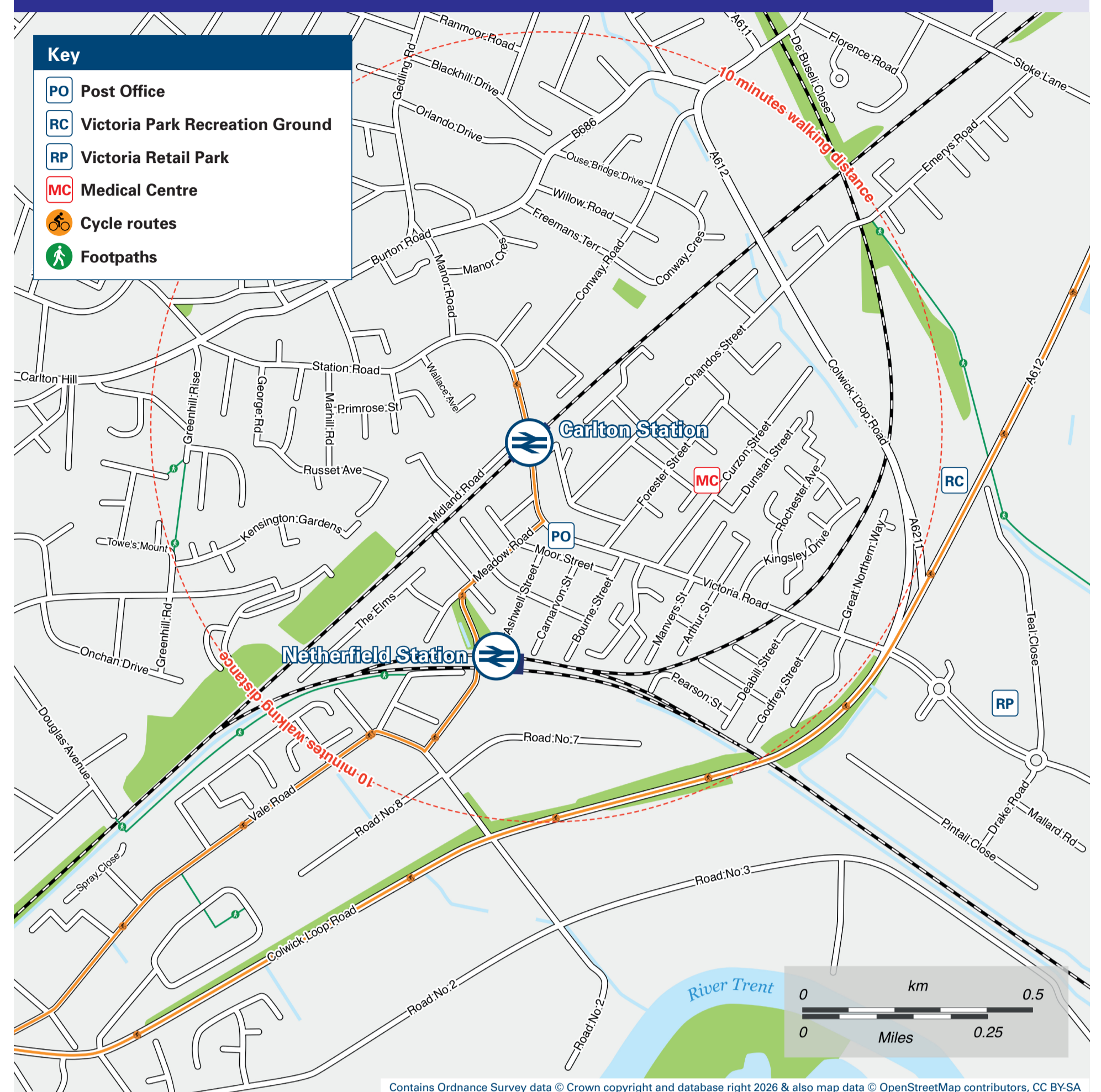
## Carlton Station
