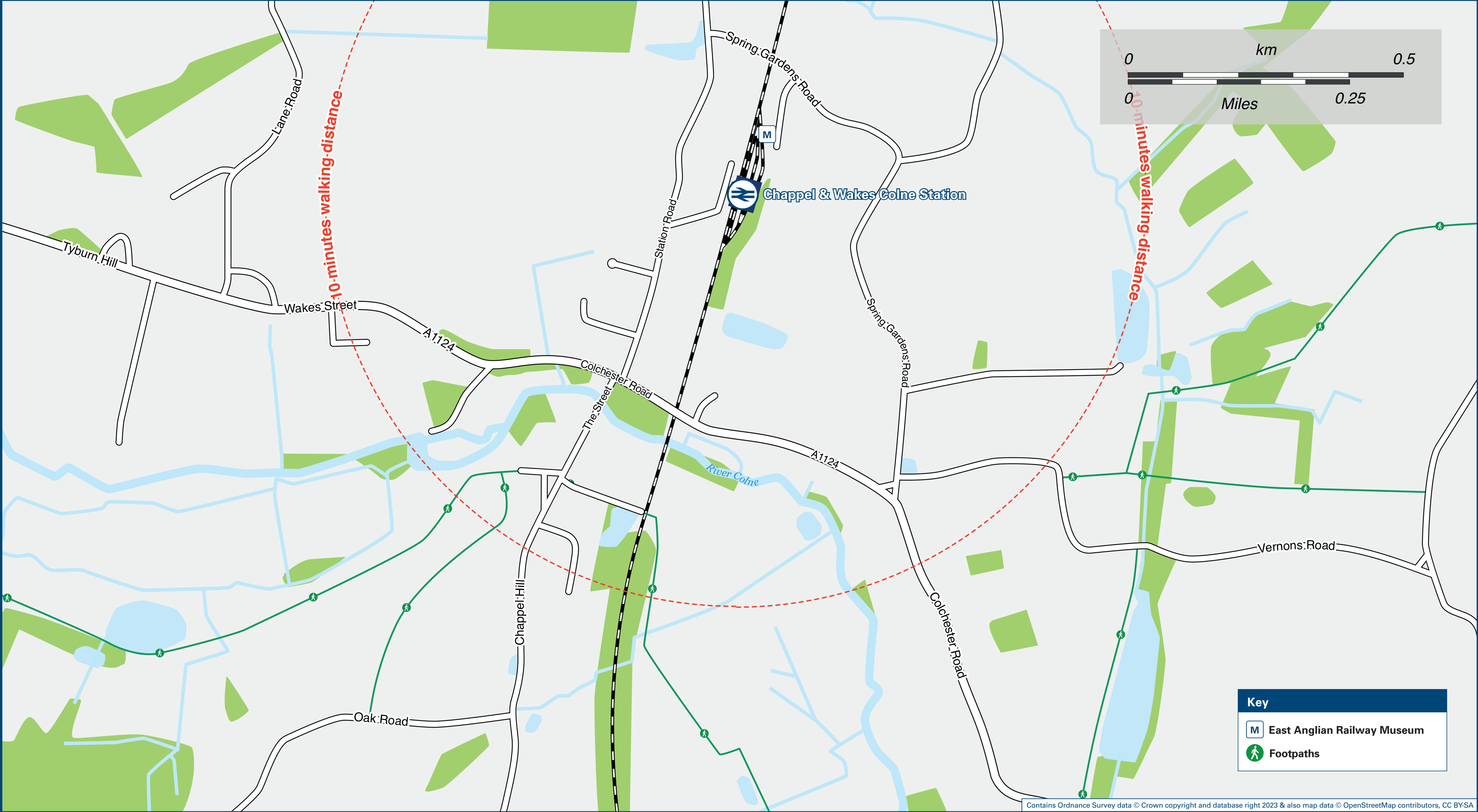




# Chappel & Wakes Colne Station
