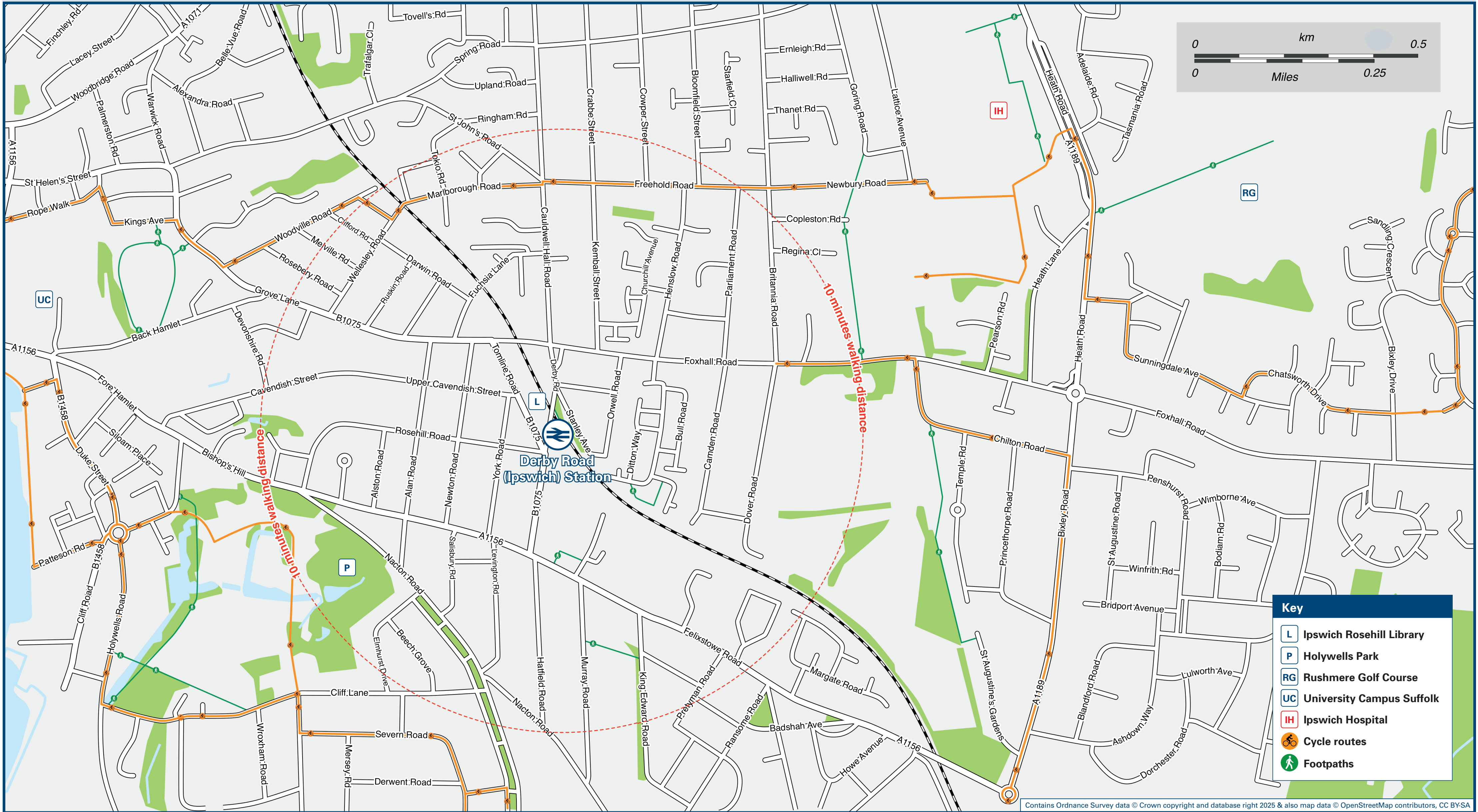




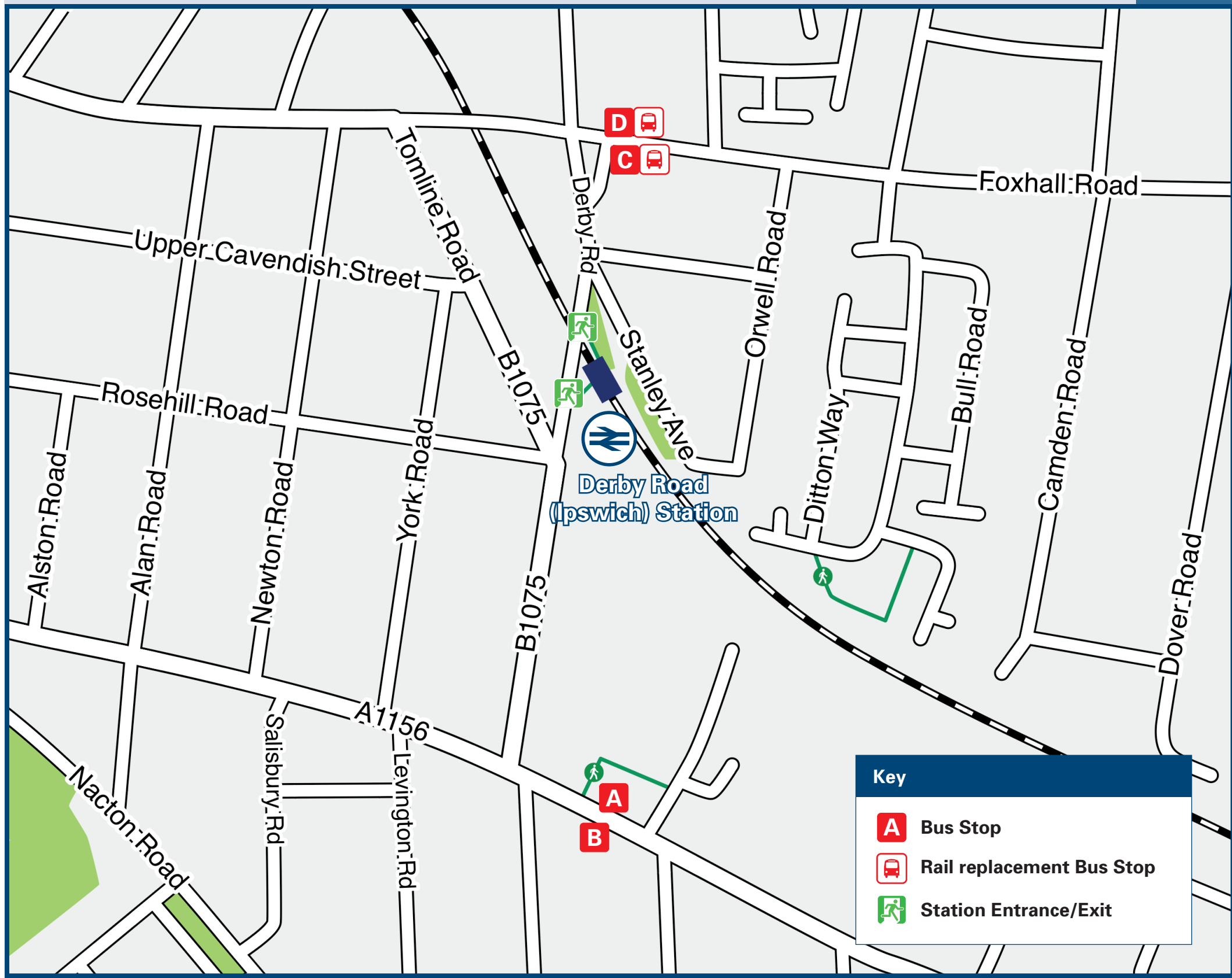
Derby Road (Ipswich) Station

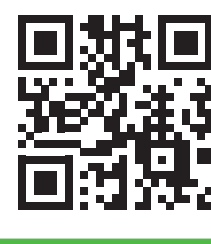
