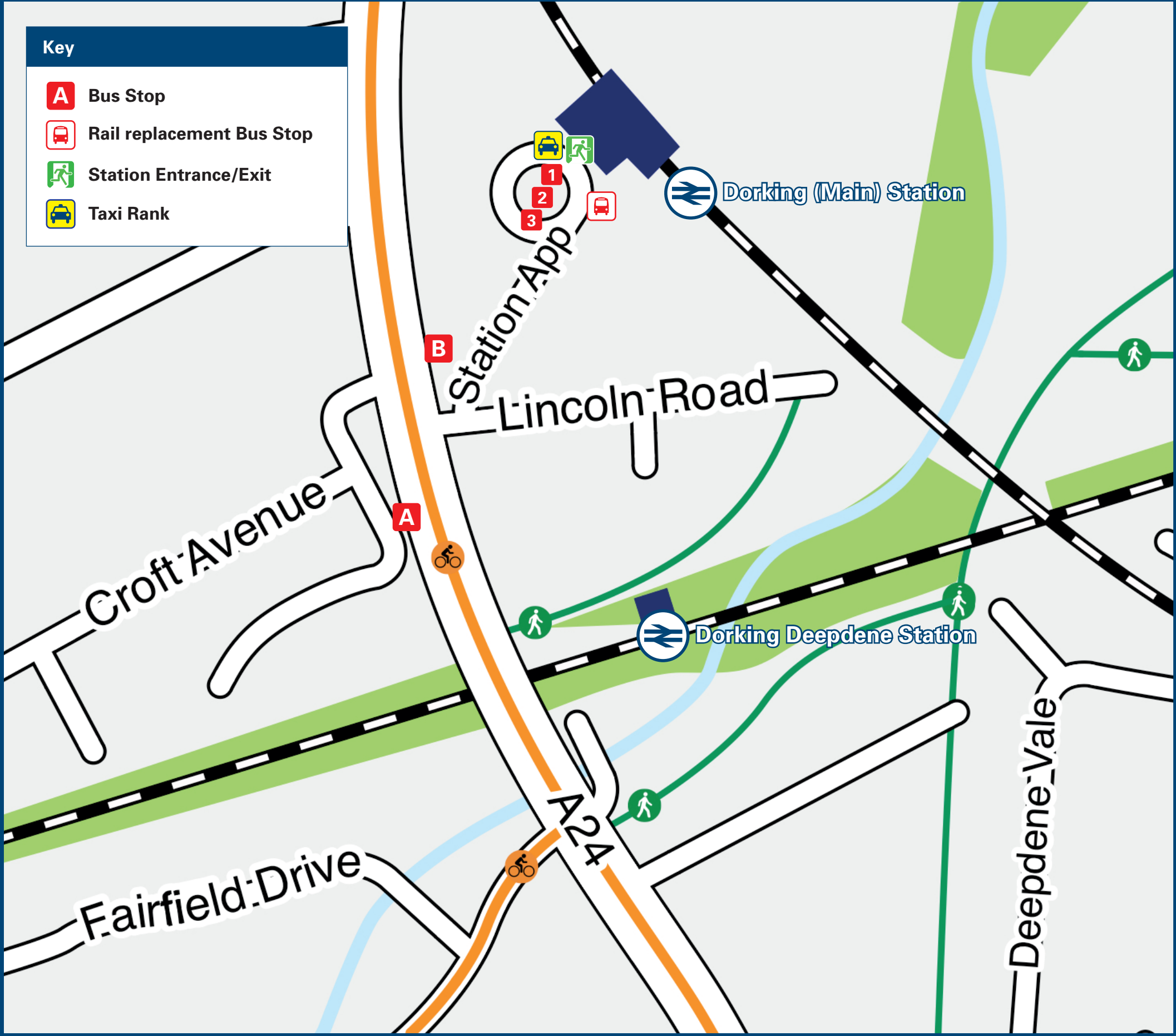

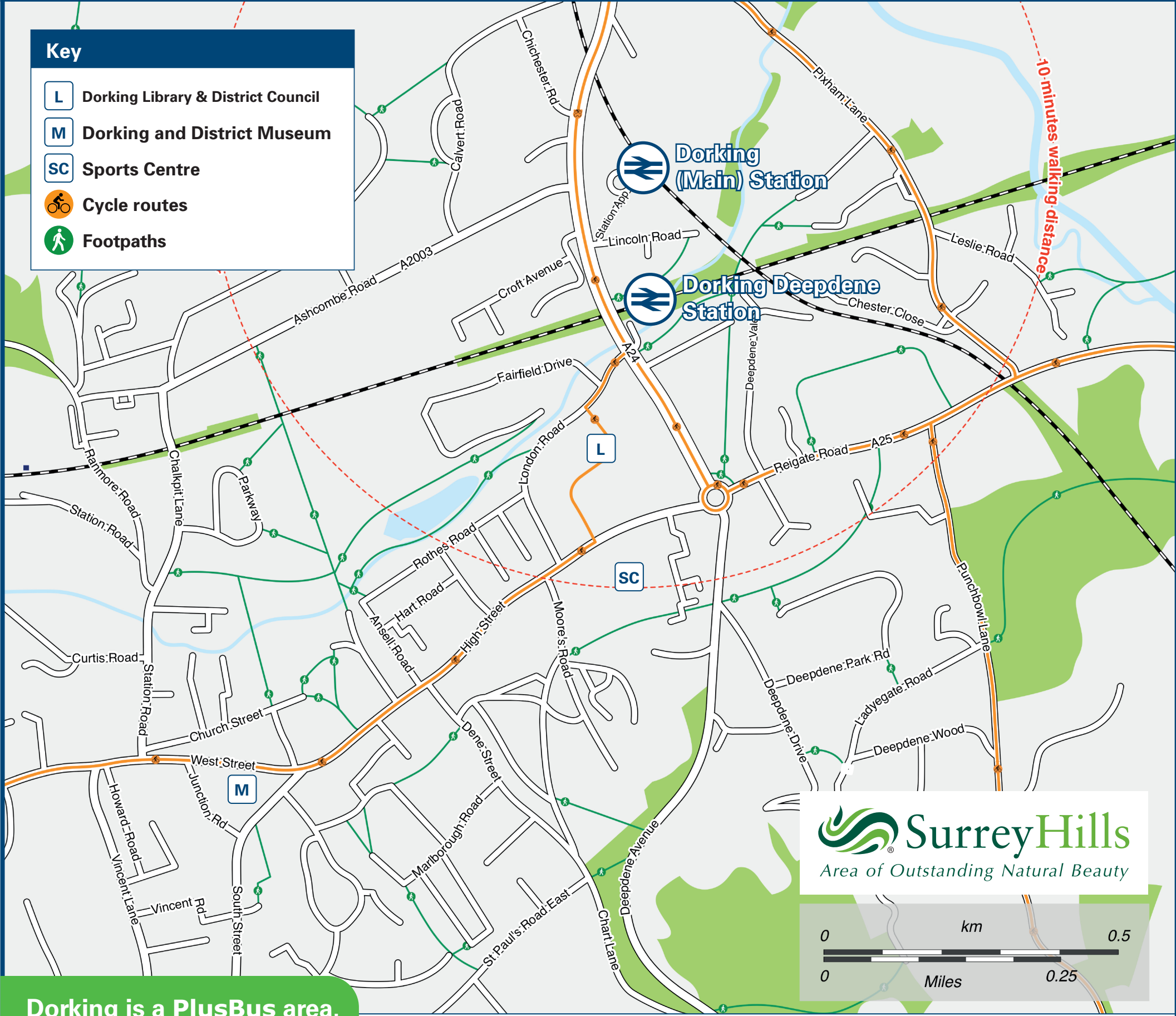

- Alternatively take the train from this station to Horsham and change for the train, or take the train from Dorking (Deepdene) station and change at Redhill for this destination.
