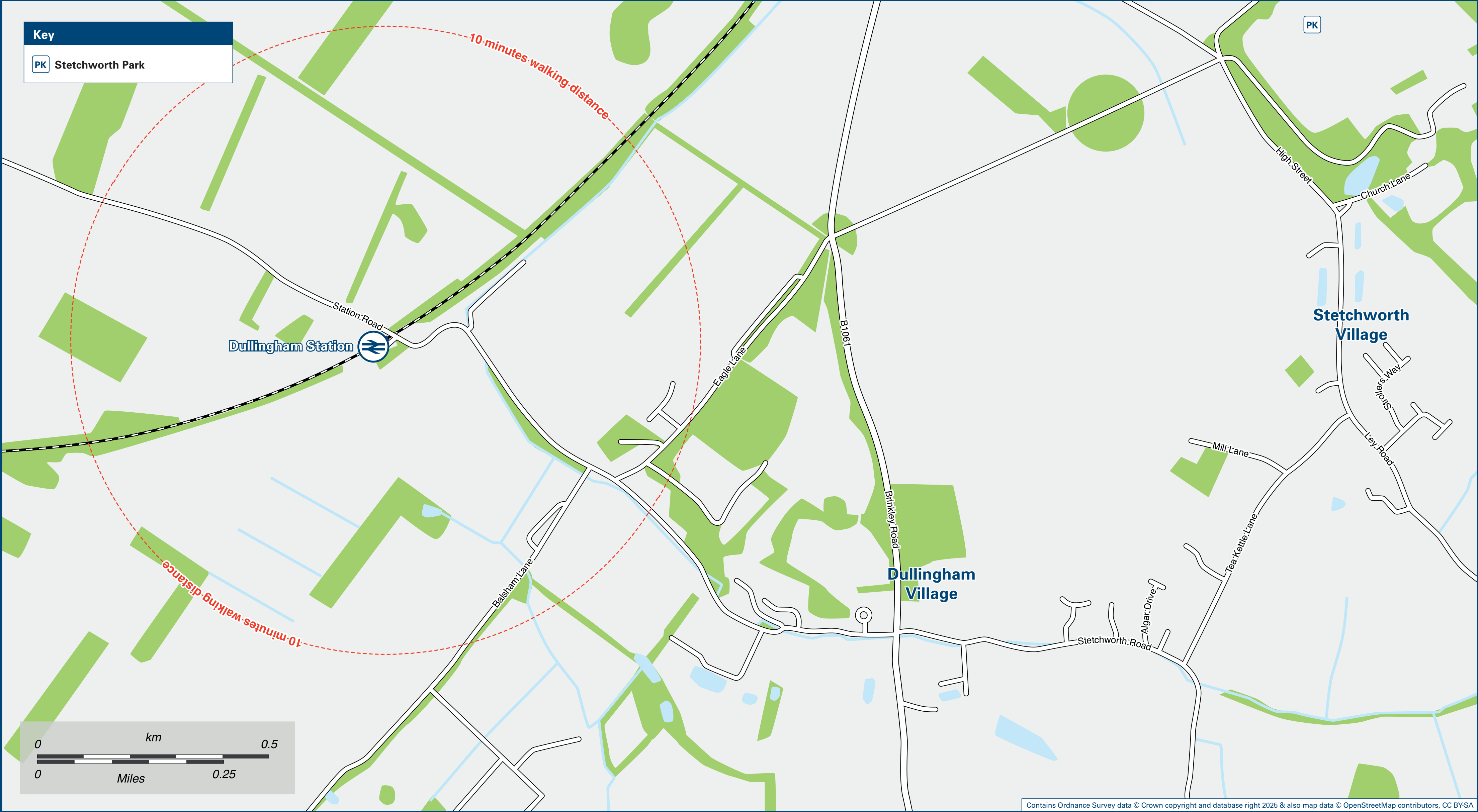




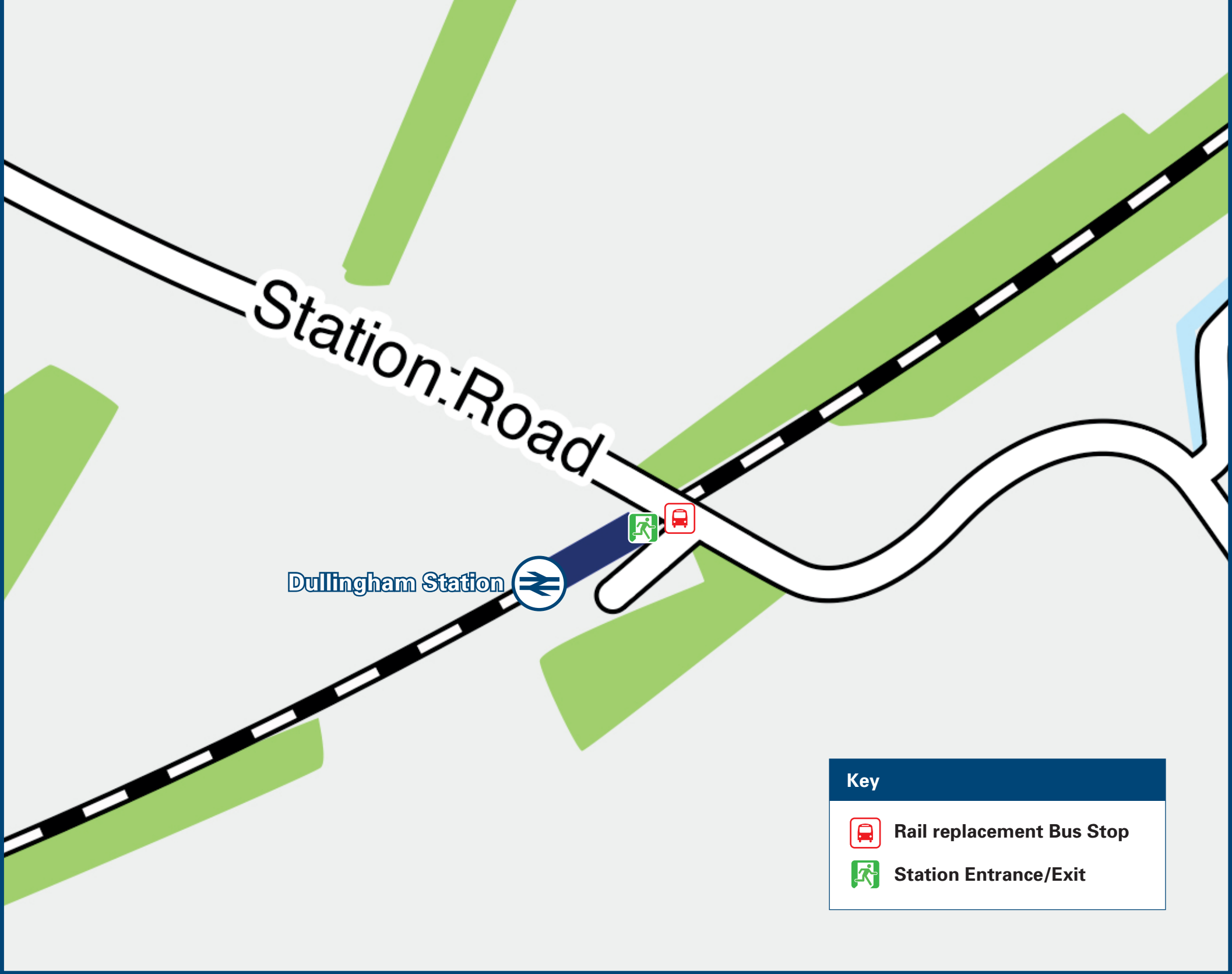

THERE ARE NO FREQUENT BUS SERVICES SERVING DULLINGHAM RAILWAY STATION

Bus route PR2 (Park&Ride) runs a very limited daytime service from this station on Mondays to Saturdays, only, and at the following times:

06:48 on Mondays to Fridays and 07:48 on Saturdays to Newmarket Road Park & Ride and Cambridge City Centre, and 18:36 on Mondays to Saturdays to Dullingham and Stetchworth villages.

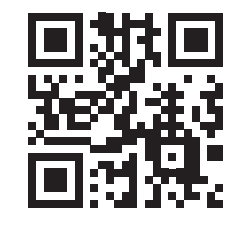
