Bus route 130 runs a limited services, Mondays to Saturdays, only. No Sunday service.

Bus route 253 runs a limited services, Mondays to Saturdays. No Sundays services.

Bus route 120 runs a limited daily service.

Bus route X7 runs a daily service, Mondays to Sundays.

Bus route 253 is operated by Borders Buses; bus routes 106 and X7 are operated by East Coast Buses; bus routes 120 and 130 are operated by Eve Coaches.

Direct trains operate to this destination from this station.

\* To this destination bus route 130 runs a very limited Mondays to Saturdays service, only. No Sunday service.

# Bus route 106 runs evening services every night, only. No daytime services.
