- Direct trains operate to this destination from this station.
- Bus route 13X runs daily (June to August) and Sundays and Public Holidays only throughout the year.
- Bus route 25 runs a limited daytime service on Saturdays, only.
- Bus routes 26 & 53A run limited daytime services on Sundays and Public Holidays, only.
- Bus route 54A runs limited early mornings on Mondays to Saturdays, and a limited daytime Sundays service, only.
- Eastbourne Sightseeing Tour Bus runs daily from April until October also Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays until December. Tour Bus starts from Eastbourne Pier.
