


Buses and Taxis



Information (Data correct at May 2025)

Local Bus Information:

Nottsbus on Demand bus service must be booked in advance from East Midlands Parkway Station, buses depart from stop **A**.

Nottsbus On Demand is a bookable bus service that operates daily between 7am and midnight (excluding Bank Holidays) to local villages and towns in the West Rushcliffe Zone including:

Barton, Clifton Park & Ride (for trams towards Nottingham city centre), East Leake, East Midlands Airport, East Midlands Gateway, Gotham, Hathern, Kegworth, Kingston on Soar,

Normanton on Soar, Ratcliffe on Soar, Stanford on Soar, Sutton Bonington (including the University of Nottingham Sutton Bonington Campus), West Leake and Zouch.

To book a journey get the App available to download for free from the Apple or Google Play Stores or by calling: 0115 804 0404 between 8.30am and 5pm Mondays to Thursdays (8:30am and 4.30pm on Fridays). Cycling info sustrans.org.uk

Rail replacement buses and coaches depart from directly outside the front of the station.
