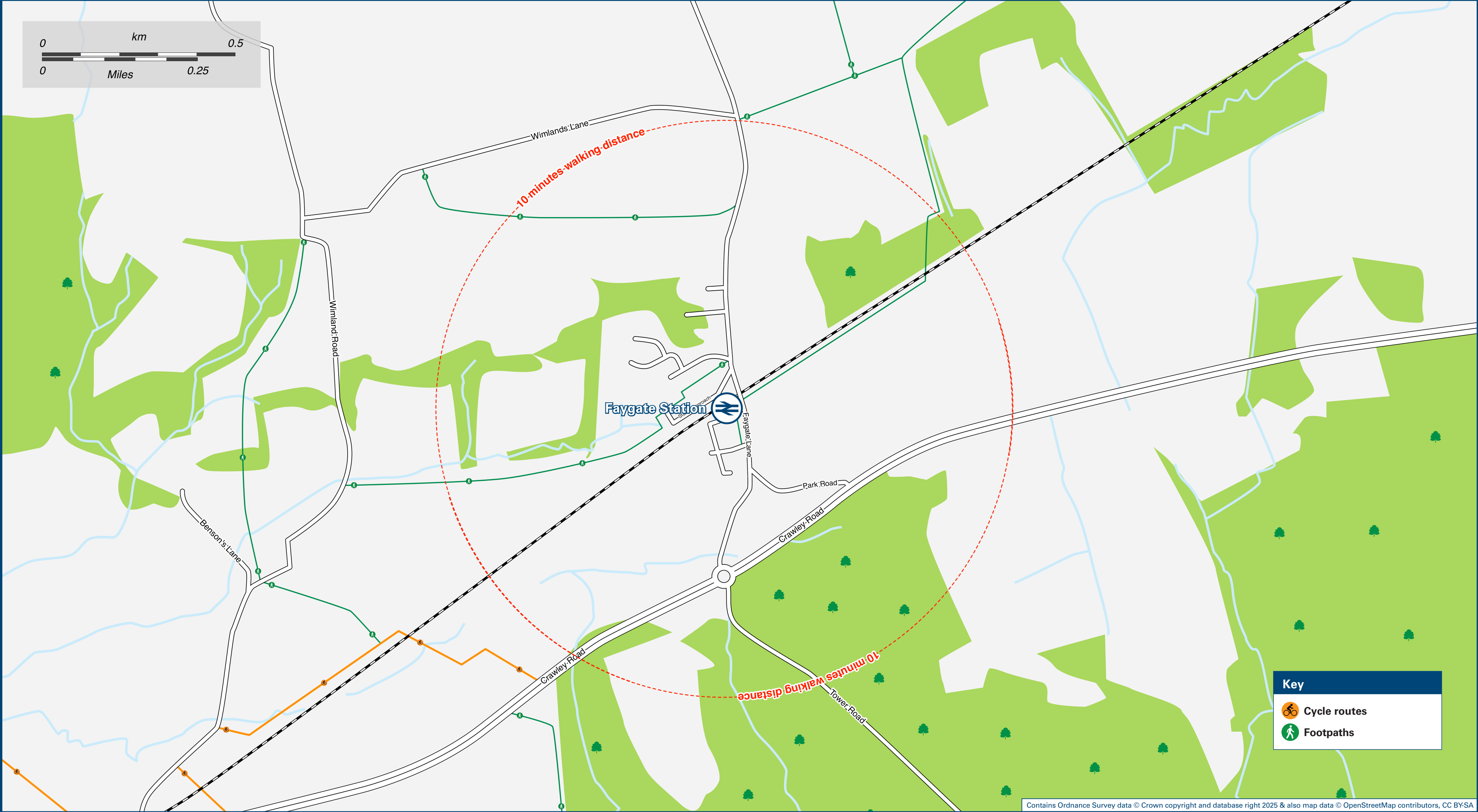




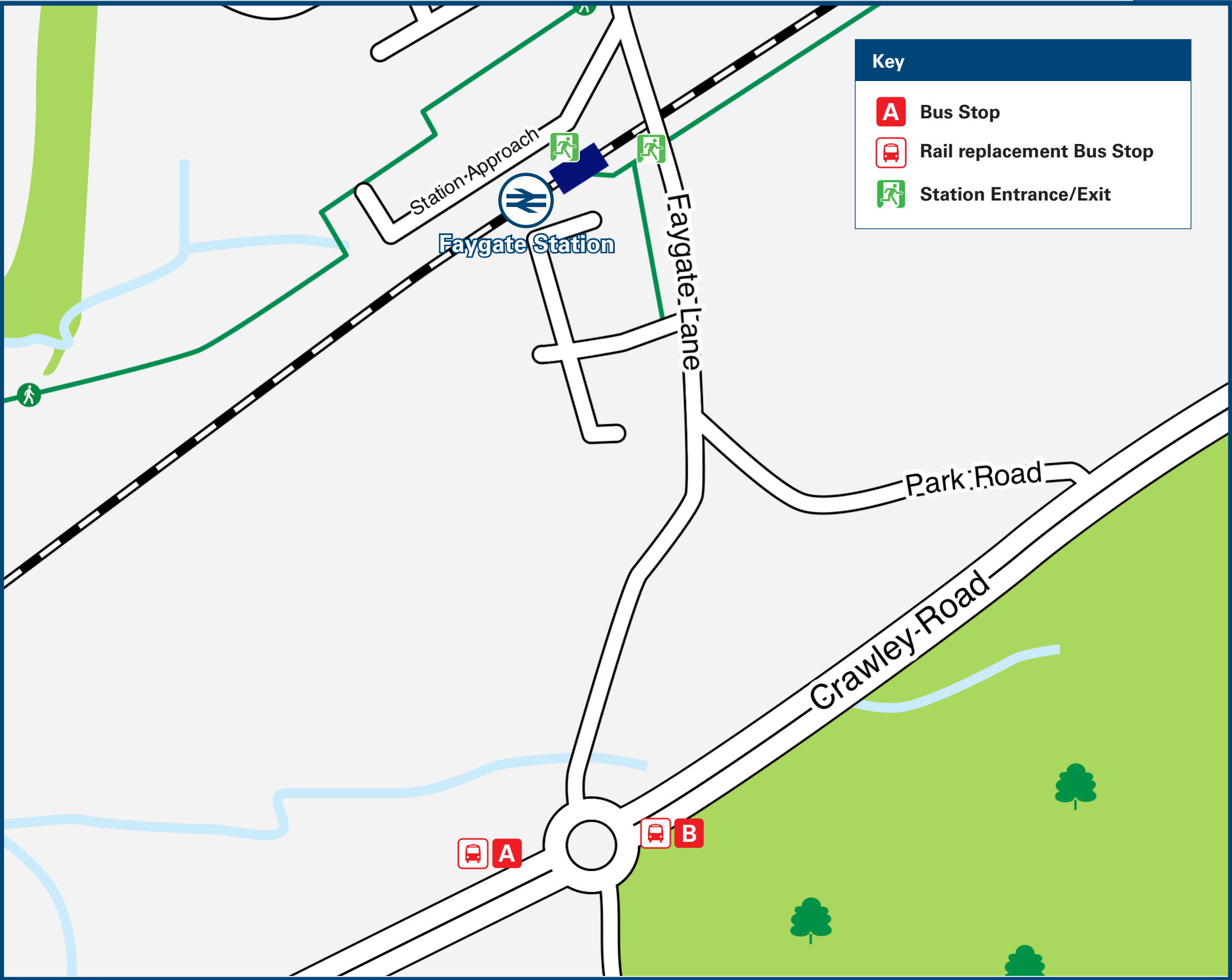

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING FAYGATE RAILWAY STATION.

The nearest bus stops for regular services are on the main road A264/Crawley Road, near to the roundabout, which are approximately 10 minutes walk from this Station.

Bus routes 23 and 200 to Crawley and Gatwick operate daily services from stop **A**. Bus routes 23 and 200 to Horsham and Worthing from stop **B**
