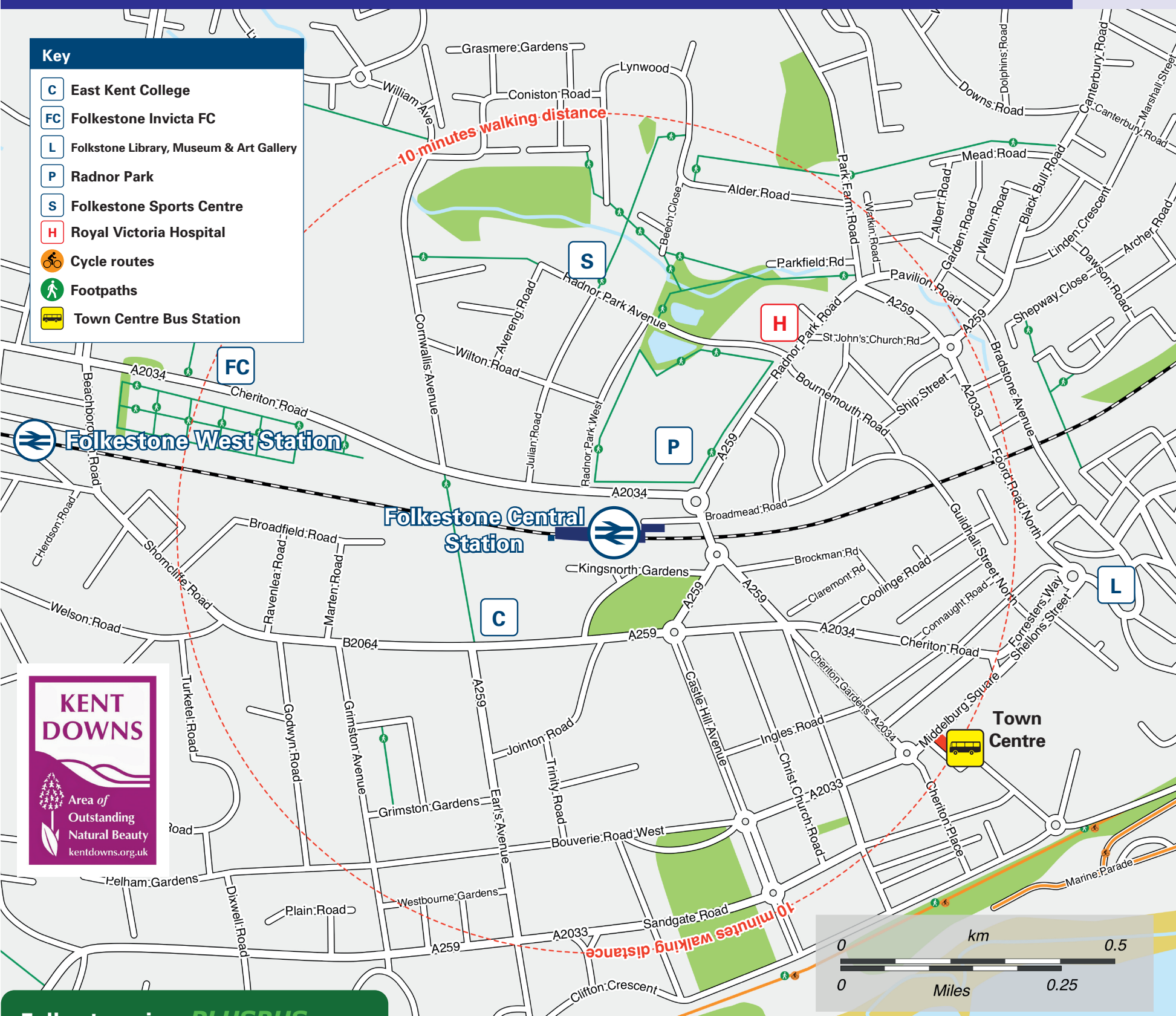




Rail replacement buses depart from bus stop outside of the station (exit station, walk down the slope and turn right. Bus stop is just beyond the bridge.

Further bus services are available from Folkestone Bus Station, 12-15 minutes walk from Folkestone Central Railway Station, or please see connecting buses from stop **A**.

- Direct trains operate to this destination from this station.
- Change trains at Dover Priory for Canterbury East or Ashford International for Canterbury West stations.
- Buses stop outside or near to the Romney, Hythe & Dymchurch Railway Station.
- It's a 10 minutes walk from this station to Folkestone town centre and bus station, see Local area map for walking route.
- # Bus routes 73 and 74 operate services on Mondays to Fridays, only.
- * Bus route 91 operates limited daytime services on Mondays to Saturdays, only. No evenings or Sundays service.
