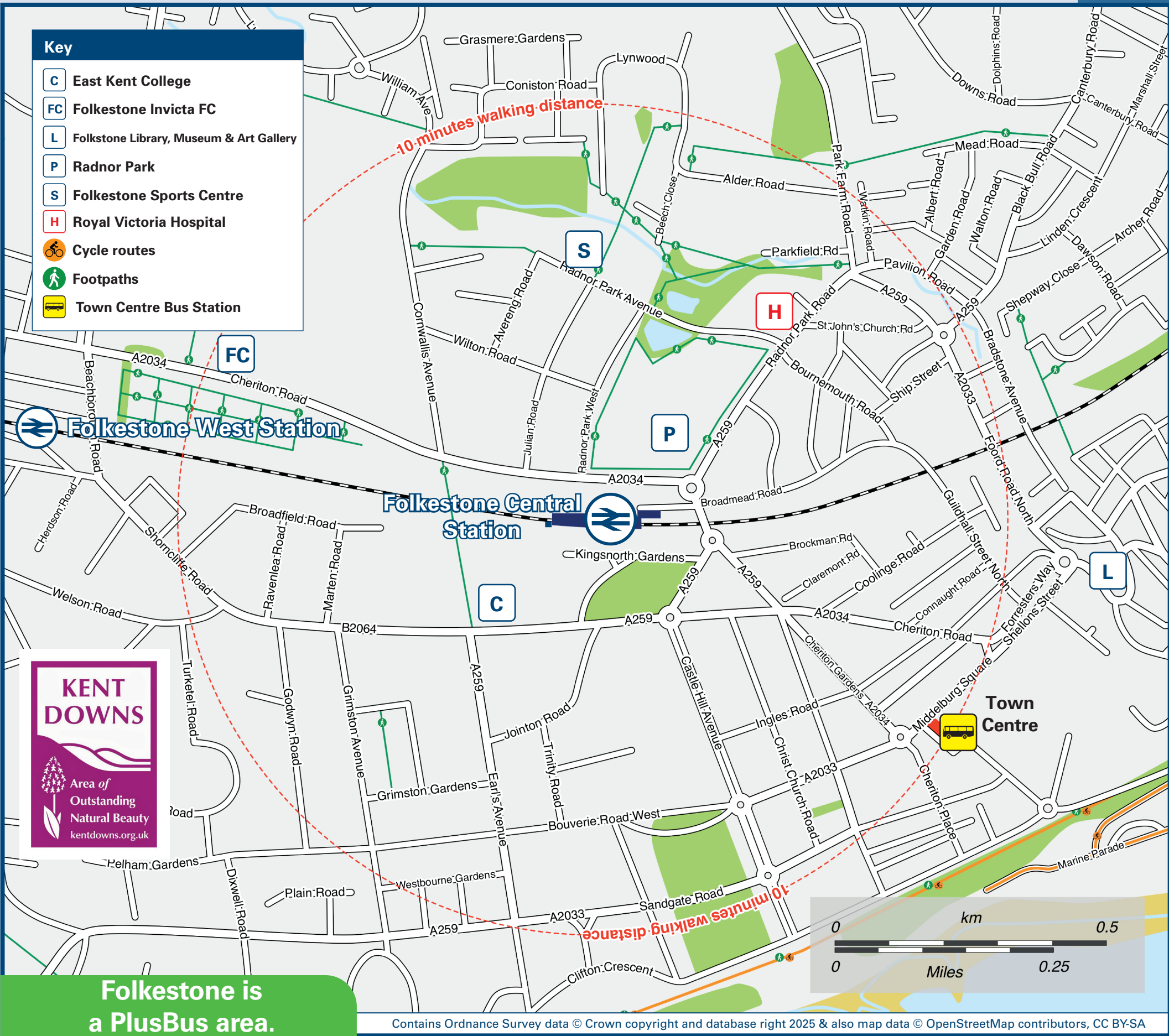
## Onward Travel Information
