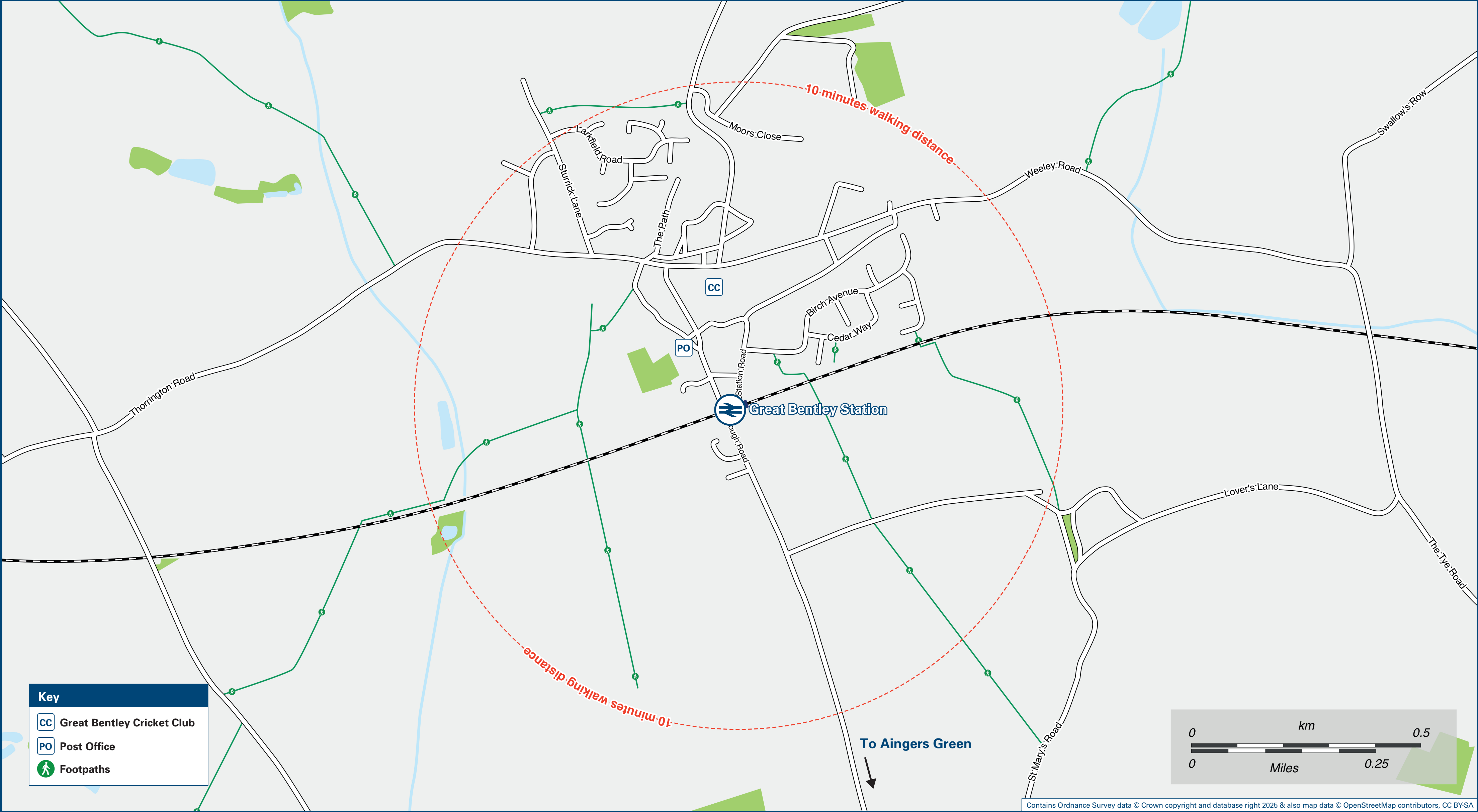




Great Bentley Station

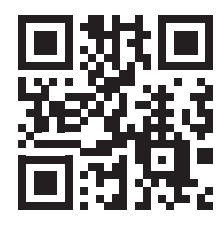
