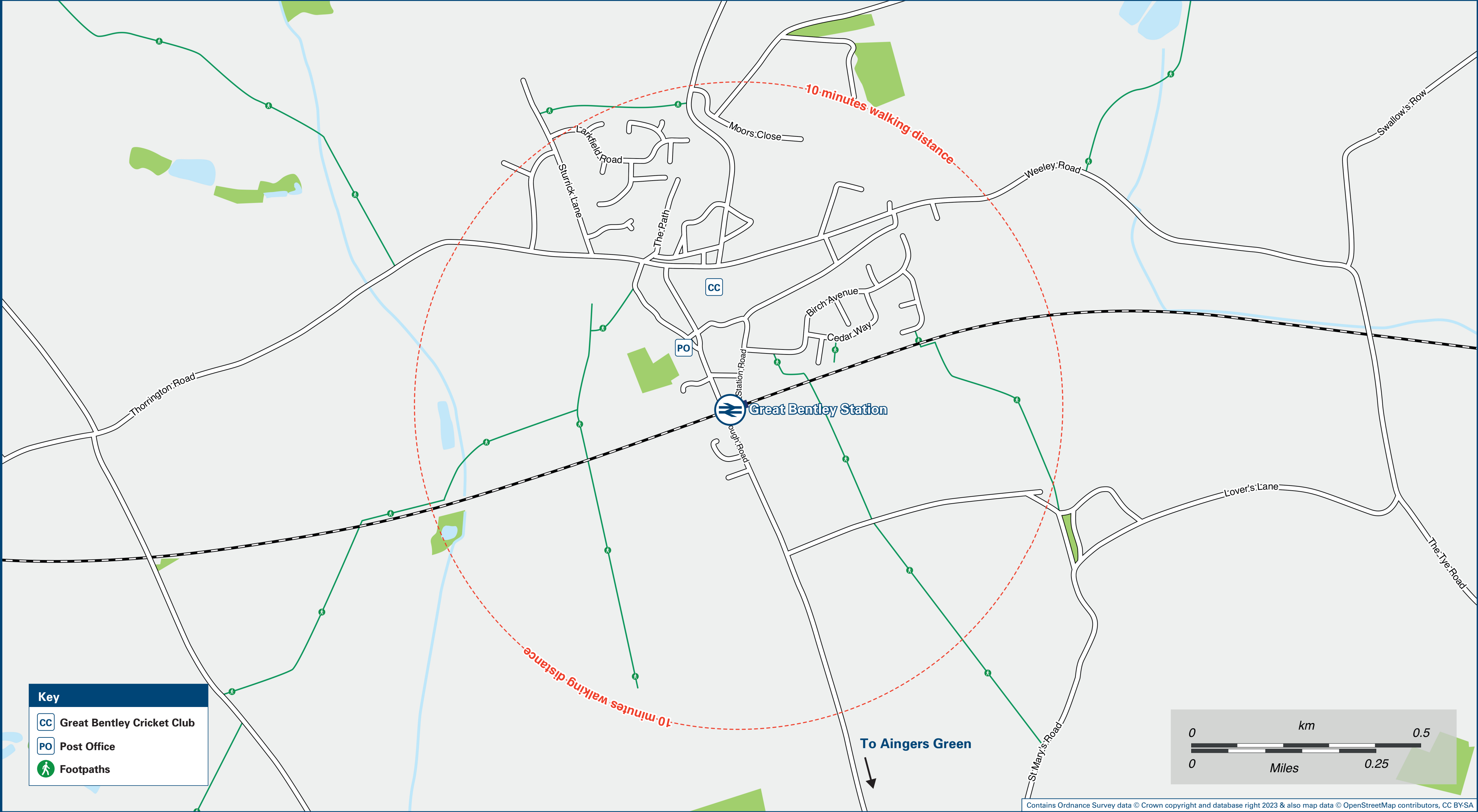




Great Bentley Station
